- To celebrate the forthcoming World Press Freedom Day on May 3.
















History

- There are ten nations China, North Korea, Vietnam, Laos, Eritrea, Djibouti, Turkmenistan, Saudi Arabia, Syria, Iran and Cuba - where press freedom is severely limited.
- World Press Day remind us that many publications and their editors and reporters are often prevented from doing their jobs, censored and banned.



Explanation

- The 32-year-old made his debut for Sri Lanka in an ODI against India in Kolkata in December 2009.
- Since then, he has been a white-ball regular for Sri Lanka.
- He represented Sri Lanka in 166 ODIs (2338 runs, 175 wickets) and 84 T20Is (1204 runs, 51 wickets).
- He played the last of his six Tests back in 2016.
- Perera was an important part of some of Sri Lanka's prominent highs in white-ball cricket over the last decade, like the T20 World Cup win in 2014 where he knocked off the winning runs against India in the final in Dhaka.

- India retained the second place in the ICC Twenty20 team rankings but dropped a rung to third in the ODI chart following the annual update carried out.
- India is trailing top-ranked England (277) by five rating points in the T20 team rankings.
- During this period, England drew a three-match series against Pakistan 1-1, defeated Australia 2-1 and South Africa 3-0 before losing an away series to India by a 2-3 margin.



Explanation

- State Bank of India (SBI) has allocated Rs 71 crore to support various initiatives in combating the second wave of Covid-19 and is in talks with various designated authorities to explore partnerships for setting up makeshift hospitals.
- The country's largest commercial bank has dedicated Rs 30 crore to set up 1,000 bed makeshift hospitals, 250 bed ICU facilities and 1,000 bed isolation facilities across some of the worst-hit states.
- These facilities will be set up in collaboration with government hospitals and municipal corporations of respective cities, the SBI said.















Explanation

- SBI will also contribute Rs 10 crore for genome-sequencing equipment, lab and vaccine research equipment to the government.
- Besides, SBI has allocated Rs 21 crore to all its 17 local head offices to address urgent medical needs of citizens including procuring life-saving healthcare equipment and enhancing oxygen supply to hospitals.
- It will continue to provide PPE kits, masks, rations and cooked meals.
- The bank will also spend Rs 10 crore in partnering with NGOs to undertake community-based testing, strengthening vaccination drives, creating helpline for Covid-19 related matters, providing oxygen supply and other critical activities.

Explanation

- Treating the current coronavirus wave like a war, the armed forces have launched operation "CO-JEET" to aid anti-COVID-19 efforts, like strengthening medical infrastructure and oxygen supply chains, as well as take measures to ensure mental wellbeing of people.
- Besides medical therapy, patients need the reassurance that they will be fine and "in times of stress, if you have someone to talk to, it makes a huge difference", said Deputy Chief of Integrated Defence Staff (Medical) Lieutenant General Dr Madhuri Kanitkar.
- Lt Gen Kanitkar, who is the third woman to become a three-star general in the armed forces, is working round the clock to strategise and monitor steps to provide relief to COVID-19 patients.

Explanation

- PepsiCo Foundation, the philanthropic arm of PepsiCo, said it has partnered with not-for-profit organisation, Sustainable Environment and Ecological Development Society (SEEDS) to launch a community COVID-19 vaccination drive and set up COVID care centres.
- Under the partnership, over 1 lakh vaccines doses will be provided to communities, to be administered through the local healthcare system, while five COVID care centres will be set up for three months that will be equipped with beds and medical facilities, including oxygen cylinders, PepsiCo India said.
- Moreover, over 100 oxygen concentrators will be provided to the Central government for distribution to various government hospitals across states.











Explanation

- "The entire community relief program will be rolled out across the country with a special focus on five states -- Maharashtra, Punjab, West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh and Telangana," the foundation.
- As part of the initiative, extensive awareness drives will also be organised across various states to promote vaccination amongst the population at large.
- These sessions will be conducted in partnership with NGOs, including SEEDS along with the local government authorities

- Trinamool Congress (TMC) supremo Mamata Banerjee will meet West Bengal governor Jagdeep Dhankhar and stake claim to form the state government, after her party's stupendous win in the assembly elections, Raj Bhavan.
- The ruling TMC has won 213 seats in West Bengal, where polling was held in eight phases in March and April, and is leading in one where counting is still in progress. The BJP emerged as the main opposition party with 77 seats under its belt.
- It is for the second time in succession that Mamata Banerjee powered her party to a two-thirds majority in the state assembly.
