- Asian cities face the greatest risk from environmental issues including air pollution and natural disasters, according to a report by research firm Verisk Maplecroft.
- Of the 100 most vulnerable cities, 99 are in Asia.
- Of those, 37 are in China and 43 are in India, the world's first and third biggest emitters of greenhouse gases respectively.
- Globally, 1.5 billion people live in 414 cities that are at high risk from pollution, water shortages, extreme heat, natural hazards and the physical impacts of climate change.

- The Reserve Bank of India has cancelled the licence of United Cooperative Bank Ltd of West Bengal as the bank does not have adequate capital and earning prospects.
- All the depositors of the bank will receive the full amount of their deposits from the Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC).
- The bank ceases to carry on banking business with effect from the close of business on May 13, 2021 and the process of liquidation will now begin.
- On liquidation, every depositor is entitled to receive deposit insurance claims up to Rs 5 lakh.



- India received over USD83 billion in remittances in 2020, a drop of just 0.2 per cent from the previous year, despite a pandemic that devastated the world economy, according to a World Bank report.
- China, which received USD59.5 billion in remittances in 2020 against USD68.3 billion the previous year, is a distant second in terms of global remittances.
- India and China are followed by Mexico (USD42.8 billion), the Philippines (USD34.9 billion), Egypt (USD29.6 billion), Pakistan (USD26 billion), France (USD24.4 billion) and Bangladesh (USD21 billion).



- Indian Institute of Technology Madras and Rice University, U.S., have developed algorithms for lensless, miniature cameras.
- Such lensless cameras have numerous vision applications in areas such as Augmented Reality (AR)/ Virtual Reality (VR), security, smart wearables and robotics where cost, form-factor, and weight are major constraints.
- Lensless cameras do not have a lens which, in a conventional camera, acts as a focusing element allowing the sensor to capture a sharp photograph of the scene.
- Due to the absence of this focusing element, the lensless camera captures a multiplexed or globally blurred measurement of the scene.

- Indian Institute of Technology, Ropar has developed a prototype of a moveable electric cremation system which claims to be using first of its kind technology that involves smokeless cremation despite using wood.
- It uses half of the wood otherwise required for the cremation and still is eco-friendly because of the technology that uses a combustion air system.
- It is based on wick-stove technology in which the wick when lighted glows yellow.
- This is converted into a smokeless blue flame with the help of a combustion air system installed over the wicks.













- IIT Professor Dr Harpreet Singh, Dean, Industrial Consultancy and Sponsored Research and Industry Interaction (ICSR&II) who has developed the system said that the cremation system or incinerator heats up at 1044 degree Celsius which ensures complete sterilization.
- The disposal of the body is completed within 12 hrs including cooling time as against 48 hours required in the normal wood-based cremation



Explanation

- The Maharashtra cabinet approved a proposal to make the state selfsufficient in oxygen production under which special incentives will be offered to manufacturers.
- The `Maharashtra Mission Oxygen' aims to ensure a production of 3,000 metric tons of life-saving gas per day.
- At present the production capacity in the state is 1,300 metric tons per day while the demand is 1,800 metric tons on account of coronavirus pandemic.
- Under the scheme, incentives will be given to industrial units for producing oxygen including 150 per cent waiver in GST inMarathwada and Vidarbha and 100 percent in rest of the state.
- There will be similar waiver in stamp duty and electricity duty too.








Explanation

- The Mumbai-based Megalab, set up last April by the council to drive the fight against the pandemic with ideas and money, will also be importing available vaccines from the West to be distributed first in Mumbai and then elsewhere.
- Sharma said the seed funding is part of the emergency funds lying with Social Fund, the financing arm of the council and forms part of the Rs 21,000 crore fund raising announced last April in the peak of the first wave of the pandemic.
