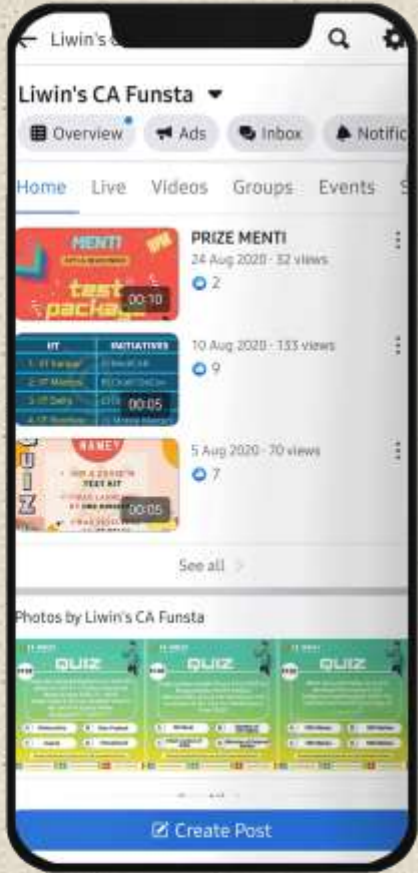
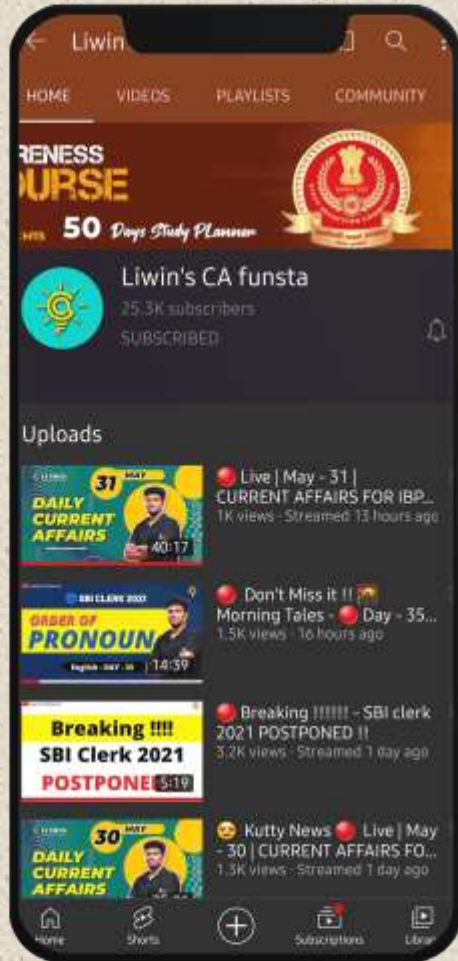

A) Mithali Raj



Explanation

- India captain Mithali Raj became the highest run-getter in women's cricket across formats, overtaking former England skipper Charlotte Edwards .
- Mithali achieved the feat during the third and final inconsequential ODI against hosts England while chasing 220 for a consolation win.
- The talismanic India batter got to the milestone with a boundary down the ground off Nat Schiver in the 23rd over. Mithali now became the world's most prolific batter in women's internationals, overtaking Edwards' 10,273 runs.
- India Women had already lost the three-match ODI series to England Women after losing the first two WODIs.

- The BCCI announced the schedule for the 2021-22 domestic cricket season in India.
- The season will commence on September 21 with the Senior Women's One Day League and will be followed by the Senior Women's One Day Challenger Trophy, which will take place from October 27.
- The Syed Mushtaq Ali T20 Trophy will be the first event of the men's competitions and will be played from October 20 to November 12.
- The coveted Ranji Trophy, which was cancelled last season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, will be played in a three-month window from November 16, 2021 to February 19, 2022.



Explanation

- The Vijay Hazare Trophy - India's 50-over tournament for men - will take place from February 23, 2022 to March 26, 2022.
- A total of 2127 domestic games will be played this season across various age groups in the men's & women's category.

Explanation

- The process of obtaining a trademark registration with the Intellectual Property India, Trademarks Registry (IN TMR) can run up to as long as 18-24 months.
- The IP Accelerator Program helps them navigate this process by connecting businesses with trusted IP law firms that are subject matter experts in this field with experience in drafting trademark and other IP registration applications.

- The UNESCO also provided \$30,000 to the Afghan government to use for gathering data regarding the the city.
- Government numbers claim that the city, which lies in western Afghanistan has a total of 830 cultural sites.
- The Afghan government wrote to UNESCO in 2020 requesting that Herat city be put on the world cultural heritage list.
- Herat boasts of several historical sites and heritages, and has always been one of the main destinations for foreign tourists in Afghanistan.
- Prominent sites of the city include the shrine of saint Khawja Abdullah Ansari, also known as Qal'ah-i Ikhtiyaruddin fort.

Explanation

- To reduce land desertification and provide livelihood, Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) initiated a project by planting 5,000 saplings of special bamboo species in Rajasthan.
- the project named 'Bamboo Oasis on Lands in Drought' (BOLD) was launched on Sunday from the tribal village Nichla Mandwa in Udaipur, Rajasthan, by KVIC Chairman Vinai Kumar Saxena in presence of local MP Arjun Lal Meena and over 2000 local villagers.
- Project BOLD, which seeks to create bamboo-based green patches in arid and semi-arid land zones, is aligned with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's call for reducing land degradation and preventing desertification in the country.



Explanation

- Under the project, 5,000 saplings of special bamboo species – Bambusa Tulda and Bambusa Polymorpha brought from Assam – have been planted over 25 bigha (16 acres) of vacant arid Gram Panchayat land.
- The initiative has been launched as part of KVIC's 'Khadi Bamboo Festival' to celebrate 75 years of independence “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav”.
- KVIC is set to replicate the project at Dholera village in Ahmedabad district in Gujarat and Leh-Ladakh region by August this year.
- India is a signatory to the UN Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD).
