- Yuliar Rojas (Venezuela) Triple jump-Gole medal in triple jump after setting world record 15.67m
- Emma Mckeon (Australia) Swimmer- 1st female Swimmer & 2nd woman in any sport to win 7 medals (4 gold, 3 bronze) at one Olympics
- Flora Duffy (Bermuda) Triathlon –Bermuda became small country win gold medal
- Loa Dika Toua (Papua New Guinea) Weightlifter-1st weightlifter to participate 5 Olympics
- An San (South Korea) Archer-1st woman since 1904 to win 3 Golds in Archery at same Olympics



 Canada 1st gold in Women's Olympic




