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



Date of National Legal Services Day:

- The Legal Services Authorities Act was enacted in 1987 to provide a “statutory base to legal aid programmes” in India on a uniform pattern, according to the website of the National Legal Services Authority of India (NALSA).
- After a lot of deliberation and some amendments, the Legacy Services Authorities Act came into existence on 9 November 1995.
- The purpose of the Act is to provide competent and free legal aid to people who belonged to marginalised socio-economic communities in the country.
- The Act also mentions the setting up of Lok Adalats for the settlement of disputes amicably.
- Since then, the passing of the Act has been every year through awareness programmes and camps about the provisions of the Legal Services Authorities Act.

- Ali beat Bangladesh's Shakib Al Hasan and Namibia's David Wiese to the men's award, and Delany prevailed over teammate Gaby Lewis and Zimbabwe's Mary-Anne Musonda for the women's prize.
- Ali scored 52 runs without defeat across three matches for Pakistan in October at the ongoing ICC Men's T20 World Cup, scoring at a strike rate of 273.68.



Explanation

- He first grabbed headlines at the tournament by blasting 27 not out from 12 balls to help Pakistan beat New Zealand, but it was what he did in the next game that made him the talk of the town.
- With Pakistan needing 24 runs off the final two overs against Afghanistan, Ali hit four sixes in the 19th over to lead his side to victory.

- Before the problem occurred in her pistol, Sarnobat was going great guns, finding the target three times on the trot towards the end of the final.
- The other Indian in the final, Manu Bhaker was eliminated in the sixth place.
- Germany's Vennekamp won gold with a score of 33. Mathilde Lamolle settled for the bronze medal with 27.



Kashmiri girl Tajamul Islam wins world kickboxing gold

- Tajamul Islam, 13, is the first Kashmiri girl to have represented India and won the gold medal – in the under-14 age category – in World Kickboxing Championship held at Cairo in Egypt on October 22 .
- She was born in Tarkpora, a remote village in north Kashmir's Bandipora district, 56km from Srinagar.
- A Class 7th student of Army Goodwill School in Bandipora, Tajamul defeated Argentina's Lalina in the final



Chess: Indian GM Arjun Erigaisi impresses in Lindores Abbey Blitz event, finishes third

- Young Indian Grandmaster Arjun Erigaisi came up with an impressive performance to finish third in the Lindores Abbey Blitz tournament, organised to mark the 85th birth anniversary of legendary chess player Mikhail Tal.
- The 18-year-old Erigaisi started in a brilliant manner and won all of his first nine games before slipping up.
- He gained over 107.2 blitz rating points to enter the world top 30 at 2723 Elo with his performance in the tournament late.
- The Indian GM scored 9.5 points out of 10 games, crushing along the way the likes of Levon Aronian, David Howell and Rauf Mamedov with 2-0 margins, and convincingly beating American ace Fabiano Caruana in the first game of their match.

- However, towards the final rounds, it was Ukrainian GM Kirill Shevchenko who took the spotlight, delivering a 2-0 blow to the Indian in their direct duel.
- Erigaisi finished on 13.5 points, equal with Caruana but took third prize on the basis of the tie-break score.
- He earned USD 6,000 for his efforts.
- The teenager scored 13 wins from 18 games, apart from one draw and lost four.
- The 19-year-old Shevchenko scored 14 points out of 18 games in a nine-double-round tournament to emerge champion.



Chess: Indian GM Arjun Erigaisi impresses in Lindores Abbey Blitz event, finishes third

- In the final round, it was a three-way race between Caruana, Erigaisi and Shevchenko.
- Caruana drew his game with Levon Aronian to finish on 13.5 points, hoping to be first on tie-breaks.
- Erigaisi also scored a victory, meaning that he was on 13.5/18 as well.
- Shevchenko had to win to take first place.
- In a wild game with many ups and downs, he defeated Armenian GM Martirosyan (who blundered a checkmate in one in a drawn position) and finished half a point ahead of the field.

- The Ukraine GM came out on top in a field of 120 Grandmasters which included the likes of world No.3 Caruana, world number 10 Maxime Vachier-Lagrave, Levon Aronian, Peter Svidler, David Navara as well as former contender for the title of World Champion Boris Gelfand and former women's World Champion Alexandra Kosteniuk.
- Another young GM, the 17-year-old Nihal Sarin, was the next best Indian performer in the event, taking the 17th place with 11.5 points.

- B Adhiban (10 points) finished 30th while the experienced K Sasikiran was a distant 50th (9.5 points).
- Among the Indian women, Dronavalli Harika was the best finisher, taking the 88th place with 7.5 points.
- The others in the fray were Padmini Rout (6.5), who finished 103rd followed by Vantika Agrawal and Divya Deshmukh (108th and 109th respectively).

- Indian skipper Virat Kohli is at the top of the tally with 3227 runs, which is followed by New Zealand's Martin Guptill and India's Rohit Sharma with 3115 and 3008 runs respectively.



Explanation

- Ravichandran Ashwin and Ravindra Jadeja were picks of the bowlers as they scalped three wickets each for India.
- For Namibia, David Wiese and Stephan Baard played knocks of 26 and 21 runs respectively and no batter from their side crossed the 30-run mark.



T20 World Cup: Rashid Khan becomes fastest bowler to scalp 400 T20 wickets

- Rashid Khan graced the title of the youngest bowler to pick 400 T20 wickets when he scalped the wicket of Martin Guptill during Afghanistan's Super 12 Group 2 match of the T20 World Cup against New Zealand in Abu Dhabi.
- The 23-year-old achieved the feat in his 289th T20 match.
- Adding his name to the elite panel, Rashid became the fourth bowler after Dwayne Bravo (553 wickets), Sunil Narine (425 wickets), Imran Tahir (420 wickets) to enter the 400-wicket club.



T20 World Cup: Rashid Khan becomes fastest bowler to scalp 400 T20 wickets

- Earlier, Rashid had also become the quickest bowler to register 100 wickets in T20Is in the ongoing T20 World Cup
- Rashid also holds the record for most T20 scalps in a calendar year, having picked a staggering 96 wickets in 2018.
- Rashid is only the fourth man, after Tim Southee, Shakib Al Hasan and Lasith Malinga, to achieve the milestone of 100 wickets in T20Is.
- Rashid picked his 100th wicket in only his 53rd match, surpassing Sri Lankan pace legend Lasith Malinga's previous record of reaching the landmark in his 76th game.

- The Video KYC facility, developed in conjunction with Geom Business Solutions, further simplifies the subsequent steps and would deliver the cheque book and ATM card to the registered address of a customer.



Explanation

- Customers can proceed to deposit the minimum balance through offline or online route and transact seamlessly using the ATM card and mobile banking after completing the initiation procedures.
- The pre-requisites to avail the Video KYC facility are a valid mobile number, e-mail, PAN Card, Aadhaar number (linked with mobile number) and access to a computer equipped with camera and a microphone facility.
- The process validates the applicant's credentials from multiple sources like a bank representative initiated video-call, information from UIDAI, and OTP for registration of the mobile number, the statement added.

- Under the scheme the awardees are facilitated by the Department of Science & Technology, GOI with support for all the requirements for performing the research including a fellowship of Rs. 25,000/- per month for five years.
- In addition, DST supports the awardees by giving them a research grant of 5 lakh Rupees for 5 years.
- The fellowship is provided in addition to the salary they draw from their parent Institution.
