



### Assets

**Definition**

- For a bank, the assets are the financial instruments that either the bank is holding (its reserves) or those instruments where other parties owe money to the bank.

**Example**

- Cash, Account Receivable, Goodwill, Investments, Building, etc.

### Liabilities

**Definition**

- Liabilities are what the bank owes to others.

**Example**

- Accounts payable, Interest payable, Deferred revenue etc.

### Net Interest Margin

**Definition**

- Net interest margin is the difference between the interest income generated and the amount of interest paid out to lenders.
- It is an industry-specific profitability ratio.

### Net Interest Margin

**Definition**

- They show how well a company utilizes its assets to produce profit for banks and other financial institutions that lend out interest-earning assets.
- Meanwhile, a higher NIM would increase the profitability of the lender.

### Net Interest Margin

**Example**

- The bank charges 10% interest rate for loans and it gives 5% interest for the deposits that lie with the banks.
- Now  $10\% - 5\% = 5\%$  will be the profit for the banks.
- The 5% is a net interest margin for that bank.

## Explanation

- Falguni Nayar, who founded Nykaa in April 2012 at the age of 50, became one of India's 20 richest people on Wednesday after FSN E-commerce Ventures, Nykaa's parent firm, made a blockbuster debut on the stock exchanges.
- Nayar, only the second Indian self-made woman billionaire after Biocon founder Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw, was worth around Rs 55.6 lakh crore (\$7.48 billion) as of 3.10 pm, when FSN's stock was at Rs 2,206 a share. She owns 53.5% of the company through two promoter trusts and seven other promoter entities.
- This made her the 17th richest person in India, ahead of Ashwin Dani, non-executive chairman of Asian Paints Ltd (\$7.05 billion), and behind Nusli Wadia, chairman of the Wadia Group (\$8.4 billion), according to the Bloomberg Billionaires Index.

## Explanation

- Scandinavian countries lead the way in climate protection, together with Morocco and the United Kingdom.
- Leaders Denmark, Sweden, and Norway occupy ranks four through six in the new Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI) 2022.
- Places one to three again remain vacant because no country's measures thus far have been sufficient to achieve an overall 'very high' rating – none are following a path necessary to keep global warming within the 1.5°C limit.
- In the overall ranking, Australia, Kazakhstan, Russia, Saudi Arabia and South Korea are among the worst performers.



## Explanation

- Australia receives 'very low' ratings in every CCPI category and slips four places in the overall ranking.
- The Netherlands and Greece are the biggest climbers, while Croatia, Belarus and Algeria fall in most of the category rankings.
- From the G20 countries, only the EU, along with the UK and India, rank among the high performers, while six G20 countries are very low performers.
- Hungary and Slovenia are this year's worst-performing EU countries.

- According to the statement, HARBINGER 2021 invites innovative ideas for several problem statements in the payment and settlement systems landscape, including, context-based retail payments to remove the physical act of payment.
- Ideas have also been sought for innovative, easy-to-use, non-mobile digital payment solutions for converting small-ticket cash transactions to digital mode; alternative authentication mechanism for digital payments; and social media analysis monitoring tool for detection of digital payment fraud and disruption.
- The prize for winner is Rs 40 lakh, and Rs 20 lakh for runner-up.

- E-Amrit is a one-stop destination for all information on electric vehicles—busting myths around the adoption of EVs, their purchase, investment opportunities, policies, subsidies, etc.
- The portal has been developed and hosted by NITI Aayog under a collaborative knowledge exchange programme with the UK government and as part of the UK–India Joint Roadmap 2030, signed by the Prime Ministers of the two countries.



## Explanation

- E-Amrit intends to complement initiatives of the government on raising awareness on EVs and sensitizing consumers on the benefits of switching to electric vehicles. In the recent past, India has taken many initiatives to accelerate the decarbonisation of transport and adoption of electric mobility in the country.
- Schemes such as FAME and PLI are especially important in creating an ecosystem for the early adoption of EVs.



## Explanation

- NITI Aayog intends to add more features and introduce innovative tools to make the portal more interactive and user-friendly.

- The Bilateral Innovation Agreement (BIA) was firmed up between Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Israel's Directorate of Defence Research and Development (DDR&D).
- The pact will provide for promoting innovation as well as research and development in startups and MSMEs to develop dual-use technologies, the officials said.



## Explanation

- The defence ministry described the BIA as a "tangible demonstration" of the growing Indo–Israeli technological cooperation.
- The agreement was signed between DRDO Chairman G Satheesh Reddy and head of DDR&D Daniel Gold here.
- India is a major buyer of Israel's military hardware.
- Israel has been supplying various weapon systems, missiles and unmanned aerial vehicles to India over the last few years but the transactions have largely remained behind the curtains.

## Explanation

- In a big boost to accelerate global adoption of solar energy, John Kerry, U.S. Special Presidential Envoy for Climate announced at the UNFCCC COP26 that the United States of America (USA) has joined the International Solar Alliance (ISA) as a member country.
- U.S becomes the 101st country to sign the framework agreement of the ISA to catalyze global energy transition through a solar-led approach.
- Signing the framework agreement, U.S. Special Presidential Envoy for Climate John Kerry, said, “It has long been coming, and we are happy to join the International Solar Alliance, which Prime Minister Narendra Modi took the lead in making.



## Explanation

- We worked out the details and this is a process we are pleased to be a part of.
- This will be an important contribution to more rapid deployment of solar globally.
- It will be particularly important for developing countries.”
- The launch of the International Solar Alliance (ISA) was announced by H.E. Mr. Narendra Modi, the Hon’ble Prime Minister of India and H.E. Mr. Francois Hollande, former Hon’ble President of France on 30th November 2015, at the 21st session of United Nations Climate Change Conference of the Parties (COP-21) in Paris, France.



## Explanation

- Former UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon attended the launch, alongside the Heads of about 120 nations who affirmed their participation in the Alliance to dedicate efforts for promotion of solar energy.
- The framework was first circulated for countries' support in 2016.
- The framework emphasizes delivering global relevance and local benefit to all countries through collaborations, with ISA's key interventions focusing on readiness & enabling activities, risk mitigation & innovative financing instruments to facilitate the promotion and deployment of solar technologies in target markets.



## Explanation

- The approach and methods detailed in the framework have already delivered results, with ISA building a solar project pipeline of nearly 5 GW installed capacity.
- The approach detailed in this framework will culminate in a vision for interconnected global grids, which was formalized and jointly launched as the 'Green Grids Initiative – One Sun One World One Grid' (GGI-OSOWOG), during the World Leaders Summit of the COP26 in Glasgow on 2nd November 2021 by the UK Presidency of COP26 and India Presidency of International Solar Alliance (ISA).



## About The International Solar Alliance

- The ISA is an inter-governmental treaty-based international organization with a global mandate to catalyze global solar growth by helping to reduce the cost of financing and technology for solar.
- In fulfilling this mandate, the ISA is committed to establishing solar as a shared solution that simultaneously addresses climate, energy, and economic priorities across geographies, facilitating Energy Transition at a global level, Energy Security at national levels, while also ensuring Energy Access at the local level.



## About The International Solar Alliance

- The ISA is helping large nations scale global commitments, thereby serving the planet's needs for reduced carbon emissions, while also helping economically more vulnerable nations establish a self-sustaining energy alternative that reduces trade dependency and drives job creation.
- Universal, affordable, and reliable last-mile electricity connectivity across socio-economic strata is a crucial pillar and targeted, tangible outcome of these combined efforts towards facilitating economic development and environmental impact.

## Explanation

- The government approved a Rs 17,408.85 crore 'committed price support' to the Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) for seven cotton seasons from 2014-15 to 2020-21.
- The decision was taken at the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- The CCEA has approved incurring expenditure for reimbursing losses under MSP operations for cotton during the cotton season (October-September) 2014-15 to 2020-21.
- The CCEA has given its approval for committed price support of Rs 17,408.85 crore to the CCI for the cotton seasons from 2014-15 to 2020-21 (up to September 30, 2021), an official release said.



## Explanation

- In order to safeguard the interests of the cotton farmers, the government said the CCI procured cotton in large quantity during 2014-15 to 2020-21 as cotton prices touched the MSP prices.
- The procurement of cotton at MSP helped stabilise the cotton prices and alleviate farmer's distress.
- Briefing media on the Cabinet decisions, I&B Minister Anurag Thakur said the CCI and authorised agencies procured 123 lakh cotton bales in 2019-20 and 100 lakh bales in 2020-21.
- The annual production is estimated at 350-360 lakh bales.



## Explanation

- During cotton season 2020-21, area under cotton cultivation was 133 lakh hectares with estimated production of 360 lakh bales, which accounted for around 25 per cent of total global cotton production.
- The government fixes the MSP for seed cotton (kapas) on the basis of the recommendations of CACP.
- In another decision, the Cabinet approved reservation norms for Jute Packaging Materials for Jute Year 2021-22.



## Explanation

- As per the reservation norms, Thakur said, 100 per cent foodgrains and 20 per cent of sugar will be packed in jute bags during Jute Year 2021-22 under JPM Act, 1987.
- The decision is likely to bring relief to 3,70,000 workers employed in jute mills and ancillary units.

- The centre would further help in achieving the target of agriculture diversification of the state government by increasing the potato acreage with the production of 4 LMT of potato from 1 lakh hectare, the cabinet said.
- With this decision, Punjab has become the first state in the country to have the facility of tissue culture-based certification, which would further lead to developing the Jalandhar-Kapurthala belt as the export hub of potato.
- Meanwhile, the Cabinet also approved to introduce the 'Punjab Horticulture Nursery Bill-2021' in Vidhan Sabha Session by amending 'Punjab Fruit Nursery Act-1961'.
