- World Refugee Day is an international day organised every year on 20 June by the United Nations.
- Hundreds of people across the globe become targets of unadministered migration either because of war or natural disasters like cyclones and earthquakes.
- These people are exposed to violence or harassment and are forced to leave the comfort of their homes due to "well-founded fear of persecution because of his/her race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group, or political opinion" as per the definition given by the United Nations.
- World Refugee Day was **first** established on **20 June 2001**. It was created in recognition of the **50th anniversary of the 1951**
- Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees.








- **SEBI** had imposed a fine of ₹30 lakh on Reliance Industries (RIL) and its compliance officers, Savithri Parekh and K. Sethuraman, for failing to clarify on news or promptly disclose information with regard to stake purchases in the company's subsidiary Jio Platforms by FaceBook, Silver **Lake and Vista** equity partners.
- SEBI said the three noticees did not comply with the provision of principles of fair disclosure of **UPSI** (unpublished price sensitive information), which states that there should be prompt dissemination of unpublished price sensitive information that gets disclosed selectively, inadvertently or otherwise to make such information generally available.
- RIL and its compliance officers did not issue any clarification on the same, as required under **Regulation 30(11)** of SEBI (**LODR**) Regulations, 2015 which states that "The listed entity may on its own initiative also, confirm or deny any reported event or information to stock exchange(s)".






- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced on June 18 that Millath Cooperative Bank Ltd., Davangere, Karnataka, had its license suspended leading to a **shortage of capital**.
- As a result, the bank will cease to conduct banking operations on June 18, 2022, at the **close** of business.
- "The Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Karnataka has also been requested to issue an order for winding up the bank and appoint a liquidator for the bank.
- The bank does not have adequate capital and earning prospects.
- As such, it does not comply with the provisions of **Section 11(1)** and Section 22 (3) (d) read with Section 56 of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.










- RBI has further added that on liquidation, every depositor would be entitled to receive deposit insurance claim amount of his/her deposits up to a monetary ceiling of ₹5,00,000/- from Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC) subject to the provisions of DICGC Act, 1961.
- As per the data submitted by the bank, all the depositors will receive full amount of their deposits from Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC).
- As on May 18, 2022, DICGC has already paid ₹10.38 crore of the total insured deposits under the provisions of Section 18A of the DICGC Act, 1961 based on the willingness received from the concerned depositors of the bank.

- **DBS Bank** India Ltd (DBIL) had acquired a **9.9 per cent** stake in **Svakarma** Finance, a non-banking finance company, to deliver financial solutions to micro enterprises through a combination of direct lending and co-lending.
- However, the bank, which is a wholly owned subsidiary of DBS Bank Ltd., **Singapore**, did not disclose the transaction value.
- DBIL's strategy for its expanded franchise across 300 plus locations and 500 plus branches envisages significant growth in SME and consumer businesses, per the bank's statement.
- DBS will continue to identify opportunities to support lending to micro enterprises in a cost-efficient manner through its own expanded franchise as well as through partners.


Explanation

- Australian High Commissioner in Sri Lanka **David Holly** said that Sri Lanka currently faces its worst economic crisis in seventy years, leading to shortages of food, medicine and fuel.
- He further said that Australia will contribute an immediate 22 million dollars to the World Food **Programme** for emergency food assistance to help three million people in Sri Lanka meet their daily nutritional needs.

Australia will also provide 23 million dollars in development assistance to Sri Lanka in 2022-23.







- On other hand, the **United Nations World Food Programme** (WFP) said that nearly **five million people** are food insecure and in need of assistance in **Sri Lanka**.
- It said, Nutritious foods, such as vegetables, fruits and protein-rich products are now out of reach for many lowincome families.
- According to media reports, WFP's recent surveys indicated **86 per cent** of families are resorting to at least one coping mechanism, including eating less, eating less nutritious food and even skipping meals altogether.












- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the new campus of Dr. B R
 Ambedkar School of Economics (BASE) University here and also unveiled a statue of the architect of the Indian Constitution installed at the campus.
- At the event, he also unveiled 150 'Technology Hubs' that have been developed by transforming the Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) across Karnataka.
- Developed at a cost of over **Rs 4,700 crore**, the **Technology Hubs** initiative is supported by many industry partners and aims to create a skilled workforce to address **Industry 4.0** manpower needs.
- Out of the total cost, the state government has contributed Rs 657 crore
 while Tata Technologies Limited (TTL) and its industry partners contributed
 Rs 4,080 crore.







- The state has also spent an additional Rs 220 crore to create dedicated workshops and technology labs at these **150 ITIs**.
- The **BASE** was planned in line with the **London School of Economics** and is built on 43.35 acres of land at the Jnana Bharati campus of Bangalore **University** here.
- It has 13 blocks built at an approximate cost of Rs 250 crore.

- The Ministry of Education initiative to use ICT under the "PM eVidya" scheme during the Covid pandemic has won UNESCO's recognition.
- The PM eVIDYA programme was initiated as part of the 'Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan' by the ministry in May 2020 which unifies all efforts related to digital, online, on-air education to enable multi-mode access for imparting education by using technology to minimise learning losses.
- The **Central Institute of Educational Technology** (CIET), a constituent unit of the NCERT has been awarded with the UNESCO's King Hamad Bin Isa Al-Khalifa Prize for the use of ICT (Information And Communication Technology) in Education for the year **2021**.
- This award recognises innovative approaches in **leveraging** new technologies to expand educational and lifelong learning opportunities for all, in line with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and its Goal 4 on **Education**.







Explanation

- Established in **2005** with the support of the **Kingdom of Bahrain**, the prize rewards individuals and organisations that are implementing outstanding projects and promoting creative use of technologies to enhance learning, teaching and overall educational performance in the digital age.
- An international jury selects two best projects annually.
- Each prize winner receives USD 25,000, a medal and a diploma during a ceremony at **UNESCO Headquarters** in **Paris** on June 24.









Explanation






Explanation
