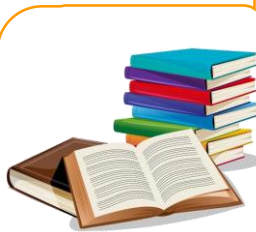

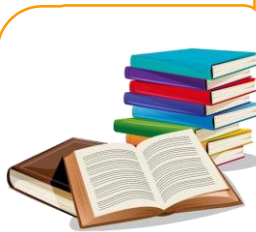

- The banks on which restrictions or Directions under the **Banking Regulation Act, 1949** have been imposed are **Ramgarhia Co-operative Bank, New Delhi; Sahebrao Deshmukh Co-operative Bank, Mumbai; Sangli Sahakari Bank, Mumbai; and Sharada Mahila Co-operative Bank Limited, Tumkur, Karnataka.**
- In the case of Ramgarhia Co-operative Bank and Sahebrao Deshmukh Cooperative Bank, the cap is **Rs 50,000 per depositor**, while it is **Rs 45,000** in the case of Sangli Sahakari Bank.
- A depositor in Sharada Mahila Co-operative Bank can withdraw a maximum of **Rs 7,000**.
