








- **Rupal Chaudhary** created history by becoming the first Indian athlete to win **two medals** at the **World U20 Athletics Championship** as she followed up her **4x400m** relay silver with a bronze medal in the women's 400m.
- Hailing from a family with modest means, her father being a farmer in **Shahpur Jainpur village in UP's Meerut** district, the 17-year-old has been in incredible form having run as many as four 400m races in just three days.
- Earlier this year, Rupal stunned pre-race favourite Priya Mohan of Karnataka to clinch the **gold medal** in the women's 400m at the National U-20 Federation Cup **Athletics Championships.**










- Rupal is the second Indian to have won a medal in the women's 400m after Hima Das clinched a historic gold in the 2018 edition of the championships in Finland with a time of 51.46s.
- Olympic champion javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra was the first Indian to win a gold in the championships in 2016 in Poland.
- Rupal's bronze is India's ninth medal overall from the championships, which was earlier known as World Junior Championships.
- In the last edition in Nairobi in 2021, India had won three medals -- 2 silver, 1 bronze.




BOOKS AND AUTHORS












- The indigenously developed Laser-Guided Anti-Tank Guided Missiles ATGM
 were successfully test-fired from Main Battle Tank MBT Arjun by Defence
 Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Army at KK
 Ranges with support of Armoured Corps Centre and School Ahmednagar in
 Maharashtra.
- The missiles hit with precision and successfully destroyed the targets at two different ranges.
- Telemetry systems have recorded the satisfactory flight performance of the missiles.
- The all-indigenous Laser Guided ATGM employs a tandem High Explosive Anti-Tank HEAT warhead to defeat Explosive Reactive Armour ERA protected armoured vehicles.
- The ATGM has been developed with multi-platform launch capability and is currently undergoing technical evaluation trials from **120 mm rifled gun of MBT Arjun.**









Explanation

- Indian Navy's women officers have created history after they completed the first-ever all-women independent maritime reconnaissance and surveillance mission in the North Arabian Sea onboard a Dornier 228 aircraft.
- The mission was carried out by five officers of the Indian Navy Air Squadron (INAS) 314 based at Naval Air Enclave at Gujarat's Porbandar.
- The aircraft was captained by the Mission Commander, Lt Cdr Aanchal Sharma, who had pilots, Lt Shivangi and Lt Apurva Gite, and Tactical and Sensor Officers, Lt Pooja Panda and SLt Pooja Shekhawat in her team.
- The INAS 314 is a frontline Naval Air Squadron based at Porbandar, **Gujarat.**
- This "first-of-its-kind military flying mission" is expected to pave the way for women officers in the aviation cadre to assume greater responsibility and aspire for more challenging roles.

- **South Korea** joined the stampede to the moon with the launch of a lunar orbiter that will scout out future landing spots.
- The satellite launched by **SpaceX** is taking a long, roundabout path to conserve fuel and will arrive in December.
- If successful, it will join spacecraft from the US and India already operating around the moon, and a Chinese rover exploring the moon's far side.
- India, Russia and Japan have new moon missions launching later this year or next, as do a slew of private companies in the US and elsewhere.
- And NASA is next up with the debut of its mega moon rocket in late August.
- South Korea's **USD 180 million mission** the country's first step in lunar exploration — features a boxy, solar-powered satellite designed to skim just **100 km** above the lunar surface.


















- As on 30th July 2022, of the corpus of Rs. 945 crores, Rs.
 375.25 crore have been approved to 102 incubators under the Startup India Seed Fund Scheme (SISFS).
- Also, 378 DPIIT recognised startups have been approved a total sum of Rs. 81.45 crore by the approved incubators under the Scheme.
- Specifically, from the North Eastern States (Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura), as on 30th July 2022, two incubators (one each from Sikkim and Assam) have been approved a total sum of Rs. 5 crores under the Scheme.
- Also, 9 DPIIT recognised startups from North Eastern
 States have been approved a total sum of Rs. 1.15 crore
 by the approved incubators under the Scheme.







- The **Startup India Seed Fund Scheme (SISFS)** is being implemented by the Government with effect from 1st April 2021.
- It provides financial assistance to eligible **Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT)** recognised startups for proof of concept, prototype development, product trials, market entry and commercialization.
- This enables the startups to graduate to a level where they will be able to raise investments from angel investors or venture capitalists, or seek loans from commercial banks or financial institutions.
- SISFS is disbursed to eligible startups through eligible incubators across India.





- To increase the Natural Gas usage, Mr. Teli said initiatives like the expansion of National Gas Grid to 33 thousand 500 kilometers, expansion of City Gas Distribution network, setting up of Liquefied Natural Gas terminals and allocation of domestic gas to CNG for transport and PNG for domestic purposes are taken.

 CNG stations have been established by the authorised entities.







- The provision of **35 crore rupees** has been made for the scheme in the current financial year.
- The Chief Minister added that spraying of urea with **25 liters** of water in one hectare of land can be completed within 20 minutes through the use of drone technology.
- The usage of drones will not only help to resolve the shortage of labour in agriculture but also save the energy and time of the farmers.





- A Himalayan spice garden, a first of its kind in the entire Indian Himalayan Region and country, was inaugurated by noted historian Shekhar Pathak in Uttarakhand's Ranikhet.
- It showcases major Himalayan spices ranging from Kesar from Kashmir to famed
 Tejpat, Timoor and Wild Heeng, found in the Bhairoghati area of Uttarkashi
 District.
- The garden has been established over an area of around 4 acres in Ranikhet, with funding from the Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA) over a period of two years.
- It has been developed by the research wing of the **Uttarakhand Forest Department.**
- It presently houses more than 30 different spices out of which there are 8 spices from the **Allium family (onion)** of the Himalayan region.
- The main objective of the establishment of this spice garden was to popularize and create awareness about various spices of the Indian Himalayan region.








 HCL Technologies to facilitate the employability of youths of Assam under
 various programs.
- The **HCL** in collaboration with **DECT** will provide training to the Class 12 passed students, aiming to reduce regional imbalance in terms of skilled people.
- Another MoU was inked between Assam Skill University (ASU) and HCL-TSS to help aspirants to join HCL-TSS skilling and employment programs and provide mutual support for counseling and conducting an assessment of eligible candidates in the university campus or any other campus provided by ASU.










- This is expected to help students from rural and remote areas to get employment opportunities.
- The third agreement was signed by Walmart Vriddhi with the Industries, Commerce, and Public Enterprises Department and Skill Employment Entrepreneurship Department.
- This tripartite MoU has been exchanged for the development of MSMEs in terms of showcasing and exporting their products and also exchanging ideas for successful commercialization of their products by providing them market access.
- As per the last MoU signed between Flipkart and Assam Skill
 Development Mission, Flipkart will provide opportunities to the










- The **Odisha government** has approved **11 investment proposals** worth **Rs 2,253 crore** that can provide direct employment opportunities for **3,817 people.**










- Himachal Pradesh chief minister Jai Ram Thakur said that the literacy rate in the state went up to 83 per cent from just 4.8 per cent in 1948.





- The Government has already started taking steps under Panchamrut Yojana to achieve this goal, and would initially select a total of 2028 farmers in the state ahead of the autumn season, to develop model plots so that more and more innovative farmers felt encouraged to join the programme for their own benefit.
- The minimum area of this plot will be 0.5 hectares, while at least 15 plots each will be selected in Sugarcane Development Councils of Central and Western Uttar Pradesh and 10 in Eastern Uttar Pradesh.
- Different goals have been set district-wise in terms of implementation of methods for maximum outcome under 'Panchamrut Yojana.



- The state was planning to expand the EV landscape at an intense pace while accelerating EV adoption and transitioning towards clean mobility.




