- The signatories for the Himachal Pradesh Rural Drinking Water Improvement and Livelihood Project were **Rajat Kumar Mishra**, Additional Secretary, Department of Economic Affairs, who signed on behalf of the Government of India, and **Takeo Konishi**, Country Director for ADB in India, who signed for ADB.
- The project is aligned with the objectives of the Government of **India's Jal Jeevan Mission** which aims to provide piped water to all rural households by **2024** and it will upgrade water supply infrastructure and strengthen institutional capacity to ensure safe, sustainable, and inclusive **rural water supply and sanitation services**.






- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has imposed a monetary penalty on **Swagatam Marketing Private Limited, Kolkata**, for non-compliance with **NBFC-related norms**.
- The RBI has imposed **Rs 1 lakh monetary penalty** through an order dated August 16, 2022.
- The central bank has imposed the penalty for contravention of/ non-compliance with the directions issued by RBI to Non-Banking Financial Company (**Non-Systemically Important, Non-Deposit taking**) regarding **Change in Management**.
- This penalty has been imposed in exercise of powers vested in RBI under **clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 58G read with clause (aa) of sub-section (5) of section 58B of the Reserve Bank of the India Act, 1934**, taking into account the failure of the company to adhere to the aforesaid directions issued by RBI.


- India's electric vehicle market is expected to expand at a compounded annual growth rate of **49 percent between 2021-2030**, with the segment's volumes set to cross annual sales of **17 million by 2030**.
- This projected growth is expected to be driven by factors such as rising fuel prices, entry of new players, advancement in EV technology, continued subsidy support from both the central and state governments as well as the anticipated implementation of emission standards.
- The EV industry in India experienced one of the quickest recoveries from the pandemic-induced slowdown in 2020, the report observed, noting that the electric two-wheeler segment, accounted for **50 percent of the total over 4.67 lakh EV** sales in the domestic market followed by the low-speed e-three-wheelers in 2021.





- He stressed that this can only be achieved with active participation of all the stakeholders in the **biotechnology Sector**.
- During the announcement of **75 "Amrit" Grants for Biotech initiatives** involving StartUps, industry, academia and research bodies in integrated collaboration.
- Dr. Singh described that the Biotechnology sector has been recognized as one of the key drivers growing exponentially and it will be the main torch bearer of the country's developed economic status in the Amrit Kaal period of **next 25 years**.
- Highlighting the 75 Amrit grants Dr. Singh said, 75 inter-disciplinary, multi-institutional grants would be supported for **high-risk, ambitious research ideas, milestones-driven collaborative research** in all domain-specific areas of the biotech sector in **Public-Private Partnership mode**.






- The hydrocarbon-onshore division of **L&T's** energy business has secured a large contract from **Indian Oil Corporation**.
- According to the company, the contract is valued between **Rs 2,500 and Rs 5,000 crore**.
- The company said the contract is awarded through international competitive bidding on a **lump sum turnkey (LSTK) basis**.
- IOCL is implementing the **Panipat Refinery Expansion (P-25) project** to enhance refining capacity from **15 MMTPA to 25 MMTPA** to meet the growth in demand of petroleum products and to increase profitability and competitiveness in the long run.
- The **engineering, procurement, construction, and commissioning (EPCC) contract** is for setting up a **residue hydrocracker unit (RHCU)** for this P-25 project.
- The RHCU is licensed by Axens (France) with a capacity of 2.5 MMTPA and will upgrade the vacuum residue (VR) to high-value commercial products (mainly diesel).


- India's first commercial **space situational awareness** observatory, to **track objects as small as 10 cm in size** orbiting the earth, will be set up in the **Garhwal region of Uttarakhand by Digantara**, a space sector start-up.
- The **space situational awareness (SSA) observatory** will help India track any activity in space including that of space debris and military satellites hovering over the region.
- Currently, the **United States is a dominant player** in monitoring space debris with observatories in multiple locations and commercial companies providing additional inputs from across the world.
- The observatory in Uttarakhand will fill the crucial gap in SSA observations in the region as there is a lack of such facilities between **Australia and southern Africa**.






- **NHPC** signed an initial pact with **Bharat Electronics Ltd (BEL)** to set up a large capacity solar equipment manufacturing facility.
- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed between NHPC and BEL for setting up of **gigawatt-scale vertically integrated solar manufacturing unit**.
- The MoU was signed by **Biswajit Basu**, Director (Projects), NHPC, and **Vinay Kumar Katyal**, Director (Bangalore Complex), BEL.
- State-owned hydro power giant NHPC has an installation base of **7071.2 MW from 24 power stations** including two projects in JV mode.
- It is engaged in the construction of **11 projects** aggregating to a total installed capacity of **7,539 MW**.
- During 2021-22, NHPC power stations achieved generation of **24,855 MU (million units)**.
- Last fiscal, NHPC reported **Rs 8,181 crore** as income from sale of power with a net profit of **Rs 3,538 crore**.

- **Indian Institute of Millets Research (IIMR)** and the **Akshaya Patra Foundation** have signed an MoU to **integrate millets** under the **PM POSHAN scheme** to increase the consumption of millets and thereby help improving children's nutritional status.
- The collaboration is an initiative towards the run-up for **2023 as the International Year of Millets** led by the Government of India.
- With an aim to further research and promote diversified, balanced and healthy diets through the sustainable production and consumption of climate-resilient and nutritious millet in various feeding programmes and integration of millets in PM POSHAN scheme (**formerly known as the Mid-Day Meal Scheme**) in various states, the Akshaya Patra Foundation joined hands with the Nutrihub incubator of IIMR.



Explanation

- The partnership aims to collaborate on menu development and study efficacy, coordinate to assess the feasibility of millet products or grains through mid-day meals in various states and look at possible **PPP (private-public partnerships)** for scaling up on a national level.






Explanation

- The **Uttar Pradesh** government has bagged **93** investment proposals worth more than **Rs 11,250 crore** for the flagship defence corridor project.
- The nodal agency, the **UP Expressway Industrial Development Authority (UPEIDA)**, has signed memorandums of understanding (MoUs) with these private companies.
- The process of attracting more defence industry firms is underway.
- While the government has so far acquired **1,600 hectares**, about **30 companies** have been allocated land for setting up their plants as part of the corridor.
- The UP-Defence Corridor, which constitutes a vital cog in the country's defence and strategic matrix, spans six nodes in the state — **Lucknow, Kanpur, Jhansi, Aligarh, Chitrakoot, and Agra.**
