


Explanation

- During the five-match series against India, the 25-yearold took seven wickets, which tied for the highest. She also scored 115 runs at an above-average pace while taking seven wickets.
- It came as little surprise when Gardner was chosen Player of the Series for her achievements in India, and she added to her joy by receiving the monthly ICC award.



- Public sector lender Bank of Baroda (BoB) announced an increase in its marginal cost of funds-based lending rate (MCLR) by up to 35 basis points (bps) across tenors with effect from January 12.
- MCLR is the minimum interest rate below which a bank cannot lend, except in certain cases.
- According to the announcement, the benchmark MCLR for one year has been updated by 20 basis points from 8.3 per cent to 8.5 per cent.
- The overnight MCLR has been hiked by 35 bps from 7.5 per cent to 7.85 per cent.
- The MCLR for a tenor of one month has been raised from 7.95 per cent to 8.15 per cent.
- For three months and six months, the MCLR has been changed from 8.05 per cent and 8.15 per cent to 8.25 per cent and 8.35 per cent respectively.

- Capital markets regulator Sebi has amended the rules governing Alternative **Investment Funds (AIFs)**, Registrars to an Issue and Share Transfer Agents.
- Under the new rules, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) said Category I AIFS may engage in hedging, including credit default swaps.
- Further, Category II and Category III AIFs may buy or sell credit default instruments.
- The sponsor or manager of the Category I and Category I AIF transacting in credit default swaps will have to appoint a custodian registered with the Sebi, according to a notification.
- AIFs, in market parlance, refers to a privately-pooled investment vehicle which collects funds from investors whether Indian or foreign for investing these funds in the country.
- Broadly, AIF rules govern venture capital funds, private equity funds, SME funds, hedge funds among others.








- Public sector Indian Overseas Bank has revised interest rates on rupee retail term deposits up to 45 basis points with immediate effect, the city-headquartered bank said.
- Accordingly, depositors of domestic, NRO (non-resident ordinary) and NRE (non-resident external) would receive interest rate up to 7.75 per cent by opening term deposits for a period of 444 days, Indian Overseas Bank said in a statement, here.
- Indian Overseas Bank said the interest rate on foreign currency deposits have also fincreased by up to 100 basis points with effect.
- Foreign currency non-resident banking depositors would receive interest rate up to 5 per cent by opening term deposits, the bank said.



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



- The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has instructed members of the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) ecosystem to allow non-resident account types such as non-resident external (NRE)/ non-resident ordinary (NRO) accounts having international mobile numbers to get onboarded and transact through UPI.
- This is subject to the fact that the member banks have to ensure such types of accounts are only allowed as per extant Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) **regulations** and adherence to the guidelines issued by the concerned regulatory departments of RBI from time to time.
- The UPI ecosystem members have to comply with NPCI's directions by April 30, 2023.






Explanation

- Aadhaar-issuing body UIDAI has issued a set of guidelines to Offline Verification Seeking Entities (OVSEs) with several usage hygiene protocols, stronger safety mechanisms at user level and ways to enhance residents' trust while using Aadhaar voluntarily.
- Notably, entities have been told to perform verification of Aadhaar after explicit consent of a Aadhaar holder.
- Also, entities must maintain the log or record of the explicit consent received from residents for any future audit by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) or any other legal agency.
- "These entities need to be courteous to residents and assure them about the security and confidentiality of their Aadhaar while conducting offline verification," UIDAI said in a statement.
- The authority has also asked OVSEs to verify Aadhaar via the QR Code present on all four forms of Aadhaar (Aadhaar letter, e-Aadhaar, m-Aadhaar and Aadhaar PVC card) instead of accepting Aadhaar in physical or electronic form as a proof of identity.







- The 3-part show will be showcased at different monuments inside Red Fort starting with Naubatkhana to Deewan–e- Aam to Deewan-e-Khas.




