





Important Days

For over 40 years, Convention 108 has influenced and shaped privacy and data protection. - The theme for this year is 'Think Privacy First'.





- Sabalenka defeated Rybakina 4-6, 6-3, 6-4 to claim her maiden singles Grand Slam.








Czech pair wins Australian Open doubles for 7th major title

- Katerina Siniakova and Barbora Krejcikova have extended their Grand Slam tournament winning streak to 24 matches with a 6-4, 6-3 win over Japan's Shuko Aoyama and Ena Shibahara to win the Australian Open women's doubles title.
- It was the **seventh Grand Slam doubles** title by the Czech pair, who broke their Japanese opponents' serve in each of the first games of the sets.
- The Czech players won last year's Australian Open, Wimbledon and U.S. Open doubles titles.









Novak Djokovic wins his 10th Australian Open title, equaling Rafael Nadal's record 22 Grand Slam

- In Tennis, Novak Djokovic beats Stefanos Tsitsipas 6-3 7-6 (7-4) 7-6 (7-5) to win his 10th Australian Open.
- Djokovic equals Rafael Nadal's men's record of 22 Grand Slam titles and the Serb will now be world number one in ranking. Tsitsipas is still waiting for first major title.
- Djokovic won his first Grand Slam in **2008** on Rod Laver Arena.
- His 22 major championships which include seven from Wimbledon, three from the U.S. Open and two from the French Open — are tied with Rafael Nadal for the most by a man in the history of tennis.
- This was also the **93rd ATP tour-level title** for Djokovic, allowing him to break a tie with Nadal for the fourth-most. Jimmy Connors holds that mark, at 109.









- Germany won its third Hockey World Cup title after defeating Belgium in penalty shootouts 5-4 at the Kalinga Stadium in Bhubaneswar.












OBITUARY








- The Jammu and Kashmir government has approved a project worth Rs 146 crore to promote niche crops as unique heritage of the Union Territory, which will be implemented in the next five years.
- The project aims at diversifying and expanding the area of niche crops over an area of 11,100 hectare, thus ensuring livelihood security for 1,11,000 targeted beneficiaries with a revenue realisation of **Rs 2,238 crore.**
- These crops are grown on 32,000 hectares, with a total annual production of 24,000 metric tonnes, making a substantial contribution of Rs 945 crore to the Union Territory's GDP.
- Additionally, the project will take up creation of one mini spice park, two modern rice mills, and eleven grading and processing units in target clusters, which will be linked with available NABL laboratories and e-trading centres of UT.
- Promotion of niche crops is one of the 29 projects, which were approved by the Jammu and Kashmir administration after being recommended by the UT level apex committee for holistic development of agriculture and allied sectors in J&K.





J&K Lt Guv launches QR code-based labels of 13 GI, non-GI registered crafts

- Jammu and Kashmir Lt Governor Manoj Sinha launched QR code-based labels of **13 GI** and non-GI registered crafts here, terming the move as a landmark in preserving and promoting priceless artistic and cultural heritage of the Union Territory.
- This is an important landmark in preserving and promoting priceless artistic and cultural heritage of J&K UT. QR code-based mechanism would help in ensuring product quality, genuineness and boost global demand for J&K handmade products.
- the products for which the QR code-based labels were launched included Kashmir pashmina, Kashmir sozni, kani shawl, paper machie, khatamband, Kashmir walnut wood carving (GI-registered crafts), and namdah, crewel, chain-stitch, silverware, filigree, copperware and willow wicker (non-GI crafts).
- J&K has become the first region in the country to issue QR (Quick Response) based labels for all its crafts. The process of getting GI registration for 10 other crafts is under process.











- A two-day inception meeting of the **Startup-20**, the new engagement group of G20 initiated by India, has begun in **Hyderabad**.
- Union Tourism Minister G Kishan Reddy, G-20 Sherpa Amitabh Kant, Startup-20 Chair Chintan Vaishnav, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, DIPTYCH secretary Anurag Jain, G-20 Secretariat JS Asish Sinha JS participated while about 180 delegates from G-20 member countries and nine special invitee countries besides stakeholders including Startups, investors and innovators attended the inaugural meeting.
- Startup-20 Engagement Group will work to harmonise the global startup ecosystem through consensus-based definitions and promote a global community of knowledge sharing among startup ecosystems to explore opportunities.
- Three meetings will be held in Sikkim, Bangalore and Andaman before the Summit to be held in Gurugram in July.





- This time India (current President), Indonesia (previous President), and Brazil (upcoming President) form the Troika.

















- The Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways launched the national logistics portal-marine (NLP-M), which is a single-window platform aimed at bringing all trade stakeholders together and reducing the cost of logistics through real-time mapping and provisioning.
- The platform aims to minimise regulatory complexities by centralising all necessary documentation, compliance certifications, and formal procedures necessary for the EXIM trade. The commerce ministry had also launched a **similar single window portal** for establishing businesses in **2021**.
- The NLP-M is based **on four core tenets carrier, cargo, banking and finance, and regulatory bodies** and **Participating Government Agencies (PGAs)**. The United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) said digitisation in trade can help eliminate many logistics obstacles.
- The portal will now replace **the port community system (PCS)** being used by ports for logistics mapping.
- NLP-M has been developed by Portall Infosystems, with Ernst & Young as the project management consulting firm.











- A glass igloo restaurant in the middle of the snow-covered mountains in Gulmarg has become the centre of attraction for tourists in the hill station in Kashmir.



- These engines, which are at present imported, are used for fast patrol vessels, interceptor boats and fast attack crafts built by GRSE and other shipyards in the country












- The **Sports Ministry** has launched a **mobile application** for the athletes taking part in the upcoming **Khelo India Youth Games**.













- An official statement claimed that, the Uttar Pradesh cabinet approved a plan to promote the production, processing, and consumption of millets in the state.


- The iconic '**Mughal Gardens' in Rashtrapati Bhavan** has been renamed as 'Amrit Udyan', the President House announced.
- Spreading over 15 acres, the lawns boast of more than 150 rose varieties besides several seasonal and winter flowering plants including tulips, Asiatic lilies, daffodils, and hyacinth. This year, visitors will see specially cultivated tulips of 12 unique varieties, which are expected to bloom in phases.
- Edwin Lutyens, the architect of New Delhi, designed the Mughal Gardens and William R Mostoe, who was the coadjutor and son of a professional gardener developed it. The design was inspired by Char Bagh pattern, the four-part garden laid out with axial paths that intersect at the centre, introduced to India by the Mughals. Hence, it was being called Mughal Gardens though it was never officially named so, said individuals aware of the matter.








- Sir Edwin Lutyens submitted the scheme of a formal garden for the Viceroy's House in 1918 and from the beginning.

 - Udyan Utsav 2023. The gardens will open for the general public on January 31 2023 and will remain open till March 26 except on Mondays.



















- The Ministry of Education, Government of India has released All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) 2020-2021.
- The Ministry has been conducting All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) since 2011, covering all higher educational institutions located in Indian Territory and imparting higher education in the country.
- The survey collects detailed information on different parameters such as student enrollment, teacher's data, infrastructural information, financial information etc.
- For the first time, in AISHE 2020-21, HEIs have filled data using entirely online data collection platform through the Web Data Capture Format (DCF) developed by Department of Higher Education through the National Informatics Centre (NIC).








Key points

- Enrollment in higher education increases to 4.14 crore, crossing the 4 crore mark for first time; increase of 7.5% from 2019-20 and 21% from 2014-15
- Female enrollment reaches 2 crore mark, increase of 13 Lakh from 2019-20
