


Former Pakistan President Pervez Musharraf passed away in _

- Musharraf was born on August 11, 1943, in Delhi and completed his early education at St Patrick's High School in Karachi.
- The former president pursued higher education at Forman Christian College in Lahore.














- The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras

- This training module will be created on the basis of Augmented Reality (AR)/ Virtual Reality (VR) / Mixed Reality (MR).











Explanation

- Six months after being stabbed, British author Salman Rushdie published his new novel "Victory City", an "epic tale" of a 14th-century woman who defies a patriarchal world to rule a city.
- Written before the US knife attack that nearly took the Indian-born author's life, the novel purports to be a translation of a historical epic originally written in Sanskrit.
- The much-anticipated work tells the tale of young orphan girl Pampa Kampana who is endowed by a goddess with magical powers and founds the city, in modern-day India, of Bisnaga, which translates as Victory City.
- Rushdie, 75, will not promote his 15th novel due to his physical condition, although his agent Andrew Wylie told The Guardian that his "recovery is progressing".
- He was attacked as he was about to speak at a conference in Chautauqua in upstate New York, near Lake Erie, on August 12.
- The author had lived in hiding for years after Iran's first supreme leader Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini ordered his killing for what he deemed the blasphemous nature of "The Satanic Verses".




DEFENCE



- LCA (Navy) is only a technology demonstrator but the development is significant as it showcases that India has developed niche technologies specific to deck-based fighter operations, and this will pave the way to develop and manufacture the twin-engine deck-based fighter (TEDBF).
- A prototype of the naval version of the locally made light combat aircraft (LCA) for the first time landed and took off from indigenous aircraft carrier INS Vikrant, which was commissioned into the navy last September, marking a pivotal point in the country's quest for self-reliance in the defence manufacturing sector, officials familiar with the matter said.
- "The development demonstrates India's capability to design, develop, construct and operate indigenous aircraft carrier with locally made fighter aircraft," said one of the officials cited above, on the condition of anonymity.
- The LCA (Navy) has operated from INS Vikrant deck at a time when the aircraft carrier is in the midst of critical flight trials to become fully operational this year, said another official.

INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS



- India, France and the United Arab Emirates unveiled an ambitious roadmap for cooperation in a plethora of areas including defence, energy and technology under a trilateral framework, a move that comes amid the geopolitical turmoil triggered by the conflict in Ukraine.
- The plan was finalised during a phone conversation among External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar, his French counterpart Catherine Colonna and UAE's Sheikh Abdullah bin Zayed Al Nahyan.
- A joint statement said it was acknowledged that defence is an area of close cooperation between the three countries.
- "Therefore, efforts will be undertaken to further promote compatibility, and joint development and co-production, whilst seeking out avenues for further collaboration and training between the three countries' defence forces,".














- Union Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs Hardeep Singh Puri has said that around 123 lakh houses were sanctioned under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) during the last fiscal, of which 68 lakh houses were completed and delivered till last month.
- In a written reply in the Rajya Sabha, he said the Centre has approved two lakh crore rupees under the scheme, out of which 1.36 lakh crore rupees have been released so far.
- The Minister said the PMAY-U scheme has been extended up to next year, to complete all the houses sanctioned during the last financial year.
- He said the demand survey undertaken by the states and Union Territories shows demand for 112 lakh houses under PMAY-U in the country.









- Seventy-five stalls and 10 food courts have been set up at the exhibition site showcasing crafts, handicrafts, handloom and cuisine.










- Guwahati is all set to host the first Youth20 (Y20) Inception Meeting 2023 from February 6 to 8, under G20.
