- India remained the world's top arms importer, but its imports declined by 11 per cent between 2013-17 and 2018-22, according to a report released by Stockholmbased defence think-tank SIPRI.
- The decline was linked to a complex procurement process, efforts to diversify arms suppliers and attempts to replace imports with local designs.
- The Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) said the five largest arms importers in the world during 2018-22 were India, Saudi Arabia, **Qatar, Australia and China.**
- The five largest arms exporters were the United States, Russia, France, China and Germany.








- Leading public sector lender **Punjab National Bank and Warehousing Development & Regulatory Authority (WDRA) have entered into a** memorandum of understanding to promote financing against electronic negotiable warehousing receipt (e-NWR).
- The partnership is aimed to provide information to farmers or depositors of agriculture produce about the benefits of e-NWR besides doing further outreach activities to improve agricultural pledge finance in India.
- The main objective of WDRA is to implement Negotiable Warehouse Receipt (NWR) system in the country that would help farmers to store their produce in scientific storage godowns near their farms and to seek loans from banks against their NWR.
- The e-NWR financing is being envisaged to be a game changer in shaping the rural economy by preventing distress sale by farmers and helping them in realising better price for their produce.


Explanation

- PNB Housing Finance, an arm of state-owned Punjab National Bank, has received capital markets regulator Sebi's go ahead to raise up to Rs 2,500 crore through rights issue of shares.
- The housing finance firm, which had filed draft papers with Sebi in December 2022 regarding the rights issue, obtained its 'observations' on March 6, which is necessary for any company to launch the issue, an update the markets regulator showed.
- Going by the draft papers, PNB Housing will issue fully paid-up equity shares of the company by way of a rights issue to its existing shareholders for an amount not exceeding Rs 2,500 crore.









Explanation

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) granted an 'Infrastructure Finance Company (IFC)' status to Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency (IREDA).
- It was earlier classified as an 'Investment and Credit Company (ICC)'.
- With the IFC status, IREDA can now take higher exposure in RE financing.
- The IFC status will also help the company access a wider investor base for fund mobilisation, resulting in competitive rates for fundraising.
- The recognition of IREDA as an IFC will increase investors' confidence, enhance brand value, and generate a positive outlook in the market.
- The grant of IFC status is a recognition of IREDA's 36 years of infrastructure financing and development with focused development of Renewable Energy, the release stated further, adding that with the IFC status, IREDA will keep contributing towards the government's target of 500 GW installed capacity of non-fossil fuels by 2030.





- India's wholesale inflation dipped to 3.85 per cent in February 2023 from 4.73 per cent in the previous month, data released by Commerce Ministry showed.
- "Decline in the rate of inflation in February, 2023 is primarily contributed by fall in prices of crude petroleum and natural gas, non-food articles, food products, minerals, computer, electronic and optical products, chemicals and chemical products, electrical equipment and motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers,".
- The month over month change in WPI for the month of February 2023 stood at 0.20 pc as compared to January 2023, the data showed.

- The exercise also aims at deepening military-to-military relations between India and France, Russia and the United States.
















- Personnel, ships and integral helicopters of the Royal Australian Navy, French Navy, Indian Navy, Japanese
 Maritime Self-Defence Force, Royal Navy and the United States Navy will participate in Exercise La Perouse.
- The third edition of the multilateral exercise La Perouse will be conducted in the Indian Ocean Region from March 13-14.
- The biennial exercise La Perouse is conducted by the French Navy and aims to enhance maritime domain awareness and optimise maritime coordination amongst the participating navies in the Indo-Pacific region.
- The two-day exercise provides an opportunity for like-minded navies to develop closer links in planning, coordination and information sharing for seamless maritime operations, according to the press release.
- Exercise La Perouse will include complex and advanced naval operations, including surface warfare, anti-air warfare, air defence exercises, cross-deck landings and tactical manoeuvres.
- Indian Navy's indigenously built guided missile frigate INS Sahyadri and fleet tanker INS Jyoti will participate in the third edition of the multilateral exercise.
- Participation of the Indian Navy in the exercise demonstrates the high levels of synergy, coordination and inter-operability between the friendly navies, and their commitment to a rules-based international order in the Indo-Pacific region.
















- The Defence Ministry has signed a contract of over 900 crore rupees for the Normal Refit of Sindhukirti Submarine at Hindustan Shipyard Limited, Visakhapatnam to achieve Aatmanirbhar Bharat.
- Sindhukirti is Diesel Electric Submarine.
- The Ministry said, after completion of the refit, Sindhukirti will be combat-worthy and will join the active submarine fleet of the Indian Navy.
- This refit has been offloaded to develop an alternate repair facility for submarines and is a further step towards undertaking Medium refit with Life Certification at Hindustan Shipyard Limited.
- The project involves more than 20 Micro Small and Medium Enterprises and will lead to employment generation of one thousand man-days per day for the project duration.










- The Goa cabinet gave nod to extend the scheme providing government jobs to children of freedom fighters for a year.






Asia's first woman loco pilot operated Vande Bharat Express and she is ___

- Asia's first woman loco pilot Surekha Yadav has added another feather to her cap as she became the first female to operate the newly-introduced semi-high speed Vande Bharat Express train.
- She piloted the semi-high speed train between Solapur station and Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) in Mumbai.
- The train departed Solapur station at right time on March 13 and reached CSMT five minutes before the scheduled arrival, adding that on completion of a more than 450-km long journey, Yadav was felicitated at platform number 8 at CSMT.

- A total of 22 languages of India are included in the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution of India. In a written reply in Lok Sabha, Minister of State of Home Affairs Nityanand Rai that 14 languages were initially included in the Constitution on 26th January 1950.
- He said Bodo, Dogri, Maithili, and Santhali were included in the list of languages in the Eighth Schedule on 7 January 2004.
- There have been demands from time to time for the inclusion of 38 languages in the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution, including Sambalpuri/Kosali, Garhwali and Kumaoni.
- The minister informed that many of these languages are spoken in several states; therefore, their use is not restricted by State boundaries.
- He said at present there are no fixed criteria for any language to be considered for inclusion in the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution.










- The first international conference on Shared Buddhist Heritage will commence in New Delhi.
