RBI To Develop Web Portal For Public To Search Unclaimed Deposits Across Banks

- The Reserve Bank said a centralised portal 'PRAVAAH' (Platform for Regulatory Application, Validation And AutHorisation) will be developed to access details of unclaimed deposits by depositors or their beneficiaries across various banks.
- About Rs 35,000 crore unclaimed deposits as of February 2023 were transferred to RBI by public sector banks (PSBs) in respect of deposits which were not operated for 10 years or more





RBI allows banks to offer pre-approved credit on UPI

- In a move that will expand the consumer credit market in India, the RBI has permitted banks to transfer pre-sanctioned credit lines through the UPI network. The measure will enable UPI services to mimic credit cards and provide low-value credit to nearly 30 crore users of the payment platform.
- The RBI has already allowed banks to provide overdrafts to customers, which they can access through UPI. The permission now to transfer funds from a credit line would enable banks to structure the loans like credit cards



- Various departments of the Tripura government or working transparently through e-procurement in the state.
- Notably, the Tripura government has made e-procurement mandatory in the delegation of financial rules of Tripura for the purchase of goods and services above rupees 25000. The procurement benefits in bringing transparency in government sales and there is no opportunity for vendors to form alliances. Eprocurement system helps small and medium industrialists in procurement.

- India was elected by the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) as a member of the UN Statistical Commission, the **Commission on Narcotic Drugs and the Programme Coordinating Board of the Joint UN Programme on HIV/AIDS** (UNAIDS), an important subsidiary body of the UN organ focussed on economic, social and environmental issues.
- India, along with South Korea, UAE and China were in the fray for two seats from the Asia Pacific States category
- Argentina, Sierra Leone, Slovenia, Ukraine, the United Republic of Tanzania and the US were elected by acclamation to the Statistical Commission for a four-year term of office beginning January 1, 2024.





- India was elected by acclamation to the Commission on Narcotic Drugs along with Argentina, Burundi, Chile, China, the Dominican Republic, Guatemala, Indonesia, Japan, Kenya, Mexico, Morocco, Nigeria, Peru, Qatar, Singapore, South Africa, Thailand, the United Republic of Tanzania, Uruguay and Zimbabwe for a **four-year term** of office, beginning January 1, 2024.
- Austria, Armenia, Finland, Hungary, Italy, Malta, the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Spain, the United Kingdom and the United States were elected for the same term of office by secret ballot.
- **India** was also elected by acclamation to the Committee for Programme and Coordination along with Armenia, Brazil, Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, Germany, Iran, Israel, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Pakistan, Rwanda, South Africa, the United Kingdom, the United States and Uruguay for a three-year term of office beginning January 1, 2024.

- ECOSOC elected India and Cambodia for a term of office beginning on April 5, 2023, and expiring on December 31, 2025, to fill outstanding vacancies from the Asia-Pacific States in the Programme Coordinating Board of the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS).
- The Council was elected by acclamation Australia, Burundi, Finland and Iran for a three-year term of office, beginning January 2024.
- The Commission on Narcotic Drugs supervises the application of international drug control treaties, while the Programme Coordinating Board of UNAIDS supports and provides strategic direction for an international response to HIV/AIDS.

- The Union Cabinet gave its nod to a project to construct and set up a
 Laser Interferometer Gravitational Wave Observatory- India (LIGO-India)
 at an estimated cost of Rs 2,600 crore which is likely to be completed by
 2030.
- The gravitational wave observatory will come up in Hingoli in Maharashtra.
- The observatory will help in better understanding of astronomical objects like neutron stars and black holes and for in-depth study of gravitational waves.
- There are already two such LIGO observatories in the US. LIGO-India will be the third such advanced gravitational-wave observatory as part of the worldwide network. It is envisaged as a collaborative project between a consortium of Indian research institutions and the LIGO Laboratory in USA, along with its international partners.





- The US will provide key components for the lab worth \$ 80 million, which amounts to Rs 560 crore.
- LIGO-India had received the government's in-principle approval in February 2016.
- The LIGO-India project will be built by the **Department of Atomic Energy** and the Department of Science and Technology, with a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the National Science Foundation, the US, along with several national and international research and academic institutions.

The 100-passenger capacity air-conditioned vessel with upper and lower deck offer travellers to cruise along the backwaters, where KSINC proposed to introduce packages.
- The ₹3.95 crore vessel was built at a yard in Sri Lanka
- This is probably the first solar-powered tourist vessel in Kerala and the biggest of its kind in the State
- The solar panels have the capacity to produce 27 kw of energy. The hybrid model boat has generators to operate the air conditioner and a passenger lift system to help differently abled and aged people to go to the upper deck.
