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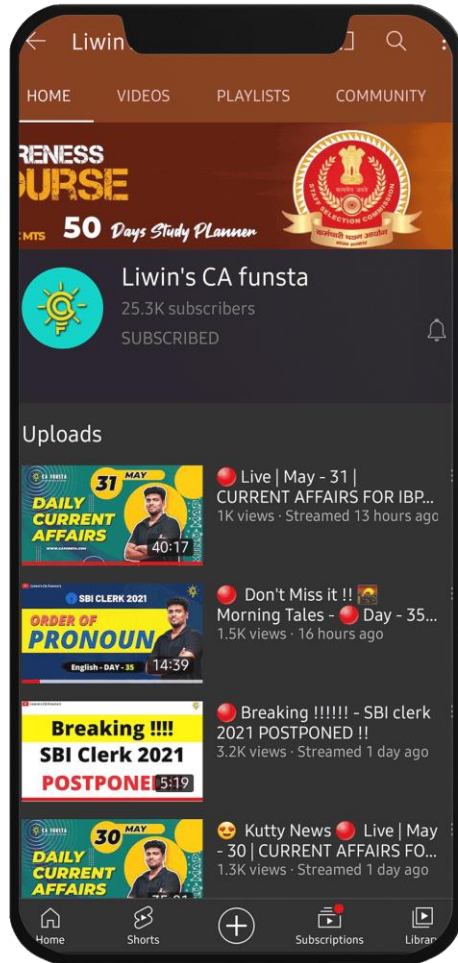
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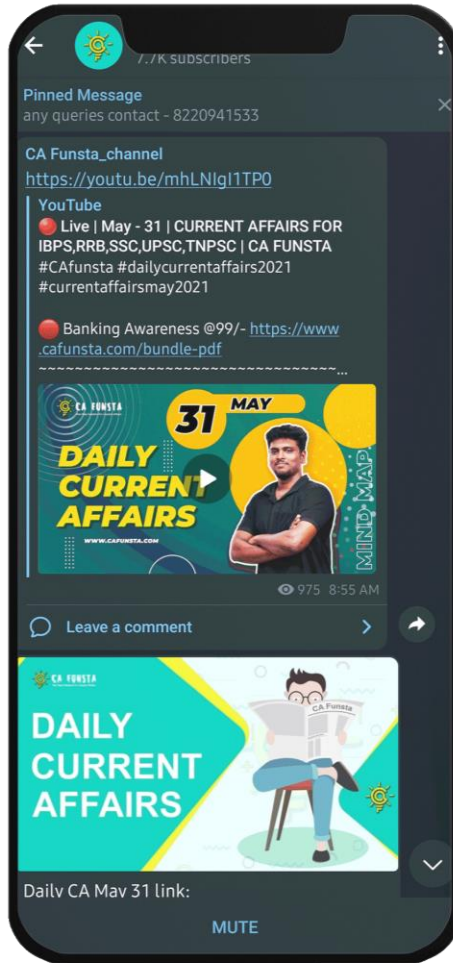

- **The Tropospheric Emissions Monitoring of Pollution (TEMPO)** instrument will allow scientists to monitor air pollutants and their emission sources from space more comprehensively than ever before, down to the neighborhood level.
- The data will be used by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) and other agencies responsible for tackling atmospheric pollution.

Explanation

- **ISRO** said it had completed the final long-duration hot test of **human-rated L110-G Vikas engine** for the planned qualification duration of **240 seconds**, marking a major milestone in the journey towards the launch of the Gaganyaan human spaceflight programme.
- The test was carried out at the ISRO Propulsion Complex (IPRC), **Mahendragiri, Tamil Nadu**.
- The air-lit liquid core stage of the human-rated launch vehicle (LVM3-G) uses two L110-G Vikas engines in clustered configuration. The design and realisation of L110 stage for Gaganyaan was carried out at the Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre (LPSC), and assembly and integration and testing were done at IPRC. The Engine Gimbal Control system was developed by Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC).
- Nine engines had undergone 14 hot tests with a cumulative duration of 1,215 seconds, including four long-duration tests of 240 seconds each.

ISRO's SDM tests for Gaganyaan Crew Module Propulsion system success

- In yet another milestone, the **Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)** announced the successful completion of **System Demonstration Model (SDM) tests** for Crew Module Propulsion System for the **Gaganyaan mission**.
- The crew module of Gaganyaan has got a bipropellant-based Propulsion System for providing 3-axis control (Pitch, Yaw & Roll) to Crew Module following Service Module separation during re-entry i.e from an altitude of **170 km to 7 km** till the deployment of the parachute-based deceleration system.
- It also provides attitude control in the ascent phase abort, if any, from 3 km to 70 km.
- The crew module propulsion system hardware consists of 12 nos. of 100-N thrusters and associated flow control components. On April 5, 2023, the hot test of the Crew Module Propulsion System for demonstrating the nominal re-entry for the duration of 650 s secs was successfully conducted at ISRO Propulsion Complex, Mahendragiri.

ISRO's SDM tests for Gaganyaan Crew Module Propulsion system success

- Prior to this, a series of tests were carried out with six nos. of Thrusters. This system was designed, developed, and realized by Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre, Valiamala. Completing this test is a major step in qualifying the Crew Module Propulsion System for the Gaganyaan Programme

- Normally, it takes **two years** for a Finance Commission to give its recommendations. The 15th FC award period is valid **till FY26**
- The 16th FC has to submit its report by October 30, 2025 so that it is deliberated on and factored in the Budget for FY27 to be presented on February 1, 2026.

Explanation

- The Finance Commission's award consists of two main categories: Tax devolution is made to states from the divisible pool of the central taxes under **Article 280** of the Constitution and no condition can be attached to its release.
- The other component is grants, including revenue deficit grants, that are paid out of the Consolidated Fund of India under **Article 275** of the Constitution
- In its final report in November 2020, the 15th FC allocated Rs 2.95 trillion to 17 states to eliminate their revenue deficit between FY21 and FY26

- the Union home ministry said the ceasefire agreements are in operation between the government of India and the **National Socialist Council of Nagaland/NK (NSCN/NK), National Socialist Council of Nagaland/ Reformation (NSCN/R) and National Socialist Council of Nagaland/K-Khango (NSCN/K-Khango)**.
- It was decided to extend the ceasefire agreements for a further period of **one year** with effect from **April 28, 2023 to April 27, 2024** with NSCN/NK and NSCN/R and from **April 18, 2023 to April 17, 2024** with NSCN/K-Khango. These agreements were signed on **April 6, 2023**.

Explanation

- On **September 8, 2021**, the central government had signed a ceasefire agreement with a faction of the Naga insurgent led by dreaded militant Niki Sumi, on whom the National Investigation Agency (NIA) had announced a reward of Rs 10 lakh for allegedly killing 18 Indian Army soldiers in Manipur in 2015.
