- Indian Oil Corporation (IOCL) is planning to set up a joint venture (JV) with US-based clean energy technology company LanzaJet Inc, and domestic airlines for production of sustainable aviation fuel (SAF).
- Through the proposed venture, a plant will be set up to make SAF with alcohol-to-jet technology at IOCL's Panipat refinery in Haryana at a cost of Rs 3,000 crore. The proposed plant will convert corn-based, cellulosic, or sugar-based ethanol into SAF, and would have an inital capacity to produce 85,000 tonne of fuel annually. SAF is a biofuel with properties similar to conventional jet fuel, but has a smaller carbon footprint.





Explanation

In accordance with the devised structure of the new company, IOCL will hold 50 percent stake while LanzaJet Inc will hold 25 percent, while the remaining 25 percent stake is reserved for airline companies, wherein multiple airline companies could be offered between two to five percent stake. Further, the airlines are being roped in to ensure fuel offtake

- the Army and the Indian Air Force (IAF) jointly conducted a multi-domain exercise in the eastern sector to validate joint plans for strategic airlift of specialised forces employing IAF aircraft and helicopters by landing and dropping in designated areas for undertaking kinetic actions to provide surge to ongoing operations by regular land forces
- As part of this, C-17 Globemasters, Chinooks and Mi-17 helicopters undertook multimode insertion into designated greenfield landing zones with surgical precision, the source stated.
- Paratroopers from the Army's Shatrujeet Brigade conducted special heliborne operations with the aim of validating their ability to rapidly deploy into hostile environment using Chinooks and Mi-17 helicopters to augment the capability of the regular ground forces

- Under this program trained A-HELPs will give their vital contribution in preventing various infectious diseases of animals, artificial insemination under Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM), tagging of animals and animal insurance
- The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD) has launched the novel initiative through an MoU signed between DAHD and the National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) under the Department of Rural Development (DoRD), Govt. of India. The primary responsibility of an A-HELP worker is to address the healthcare needs of the livestock population in a village. The programme was successfully piloted in State of Madhya Pradesh and J&K (UT).

- A millet food festival will be held in Mumbai from April 13-19 where chefs from four of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) member countries -- Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan and Russia - will showcase their various cuisines
- The SCO Millet Food Festival will be organised at the Taj Mahal Palace hotel by the Ministry of Tourism
- The SCO is an intergovernmental organisation comprising eight member states, China, India, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russia, Pakistan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan, four observer states and fourteen dialogue partners.
- India is hosting presidency of SCO for the year 2023.
- The Ministry of Tourism has successfully completed SCO Tourism Mart from February 9-11, SCO Expert Level Tourism Working Group Meeting and SCO Tourism Minister's Meeting in Kashi (Varanasi) from March 13-18.






