



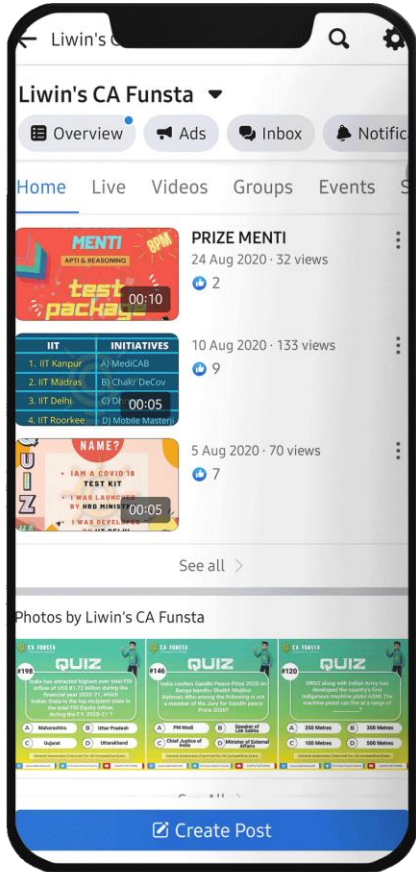
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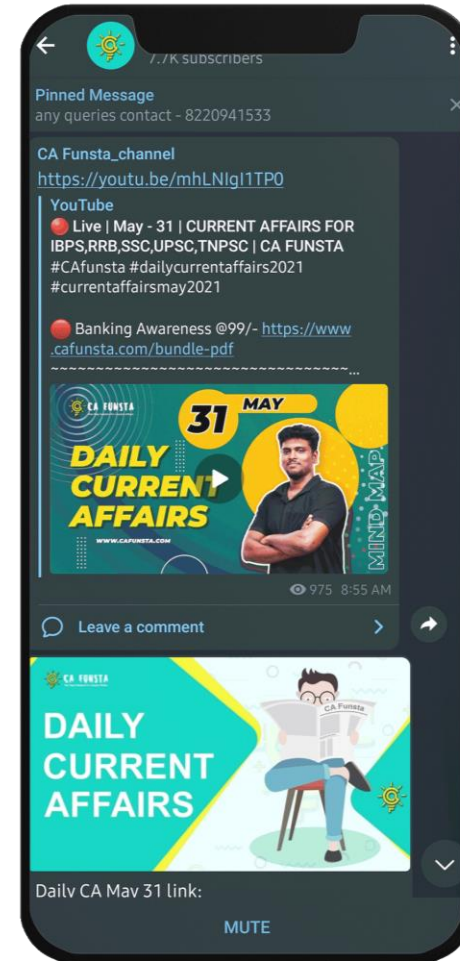
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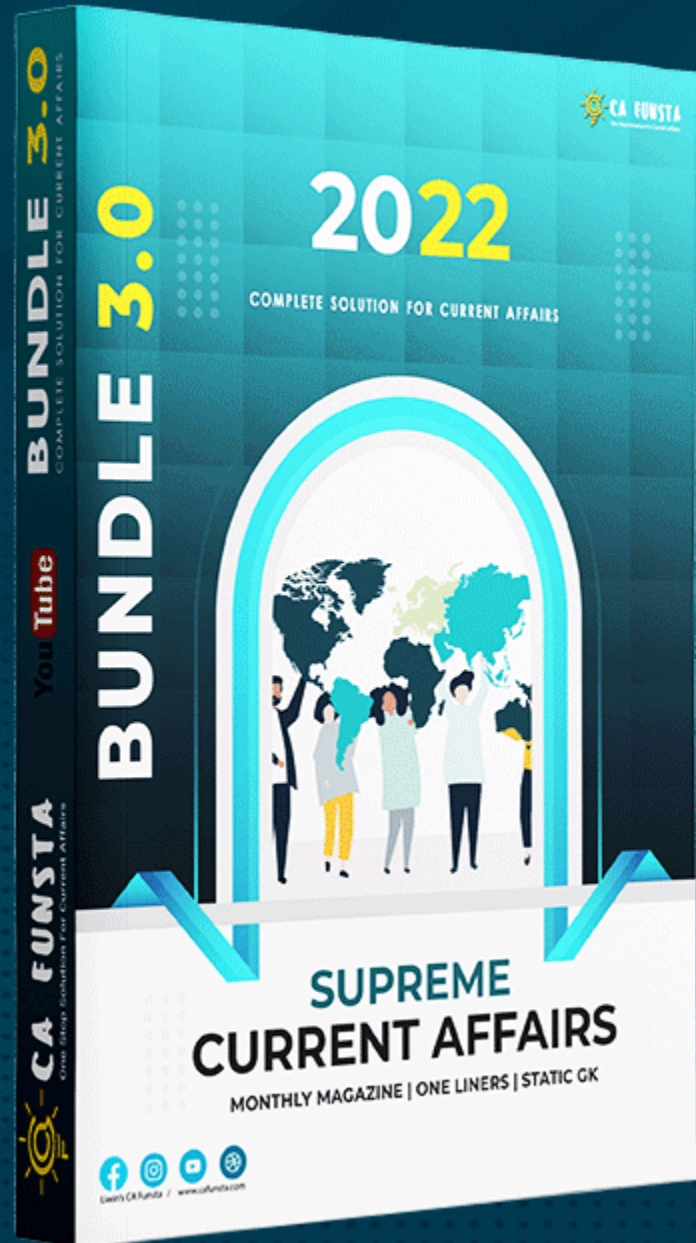

- Apart from Brazil, the United States of America, Portugal, and Argentina also marked the day. According to historical records, the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery began to mark the day in **2002**.
- The day was officially designated World Health Day in **2003**

Himachal Pradesh celebrates its 75th formation day

- The 75th anniversary of the formation of Himachal Pradesh is being celebrated across the State ON 15TH April.
- Himachal Pradesh came into existence on the 15th of April 1948 as a Chief Commissioner's State. With this, Himachal Pradesh was created as a province of India. Later on the 25th of January 1950,
- Himachal was made a 'C' category State.
- After this, on the 1st of November, 1956, Himachal Pradesh was declared a Union Territory.
- In 1966, the hilly areas of Punjab were included in Himachal Pradesh.
- On the 18th of December 1970, Parliament passed the Himachal Pradesh Act and on the 25th of January 1971, Himachal Pradesh came into existence as a full-fledged State and became the 18th State of the country.

- Earlier, the bank had launched this retail term deposit scheme with a specific duration and it was valid from February 15, 2023, to March 31, 2023
- **The Scheme will be valid till 30-June-2023**
- The interest rate - 7.10% for regular people and 7.60% for elderly citizens
- Amount: Domestic retail term deposits including NRI Rupee Term Deposits below **Rs 2 crore**
- Interest is paid on term deposits at monthly, quarterly, and semi-annual intervals

SBI Sarvottam (Non-Callable) domestic retail term deposits

- SBI 'Sarvottam' (Non-Callable) term deposits is a special scheme for deposits over **Rs 15 lakh** for resident people and non-resident individuals.
- This plan provides investors with 1 year and 2 year FDs with interest rates that are 30 basis points and 40 basis points higher than the card rate, respectively

Explanation

- **The Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** announced the framework for acceptance of Green Deposits of regulated entities (RE).
- The idea is to foster and develop a green finance ecosystem in the country, the central bank said.
- The framework shall come into effect from **June 1, 2023**
- The framework is applicable to Scheduled Commercial Banks including Small Finance Banks excluding Regional Rural Banks, Local Area Banks and Payments Banks and all deposit-taking Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs), including Housing Finance Companies.

Explanation

- A green deposit means an interest-bearing deposit, received by the RE for a fixed period and the proceeds of which are earmarked for being allocated towards green finance.
- The registered entities shall issue green deposits as cumulative or non-cumulative deposits
- On maturity, the green deposits would be renewed or withdrawn at the option of the depositor. The green deposits shall be denominated in Indian Rupees only.
- The tenor, size, interest rate and other terms and conditions (as applicable to the RE) are defined in the Master Direction of the Reserve Bank.

Explanation

- Backed by increasing economic ties, the **United States** has emerged as **India's biggest trading partner in 2022-23**. The bilateral trade between India and the US increased by 7.65 per cent to \$128.55 billion in 2022-23 as against \$119.5 billion in 2021-22, according to the provisional data of the commerce ministry.
- **It was \$80.51 billion in 2020-21.**
- Exports to the US rose by 2.81 per cent to \$78.31 billion in 2022-23 as against \$76.18 billion in 2021-22, while imports grew by about 16 per cent to \$50.24 billion
- Exports to China dipped by about 28 per cent to \$15.32 billion in 2022-23, while imports rose by 4.16 per cent to \$98.51 billion in the last fiscal. Trade gap widened to \$83.2 billion in the last fiscal as against \$72.91 billion in 2021-22

Explanation

- The data showed that **China was India's top trading partner since 2013-14 till 2017-18 and also in 2020-21**. Before China, the UAE was the country's largest trading partner.
- In **2022-23**, the **UAE with \$76.16 billion**, was the third largest trading partner of India. It was followed by Saudi Arabia (\$52.72 billion), and Singapore (USD 35.55 billion).

- **Elon Musk and Jared Birchall**, who operates Musk's family office, incorporated X.AI in March, according to a Nevada state filing with the Secretary of State
- He was also involved early on in the creation of OpenAI. Musk helped start the organisation in 2015 and served as as co-chair along with Sam Altman, the current CEO.
- Musk left OpenAI's board in 2018 and has since criticized the organisation, which created a for-profit arm in 2019
- Microsoft Corp. has invested \$10 billion into OpenAI.

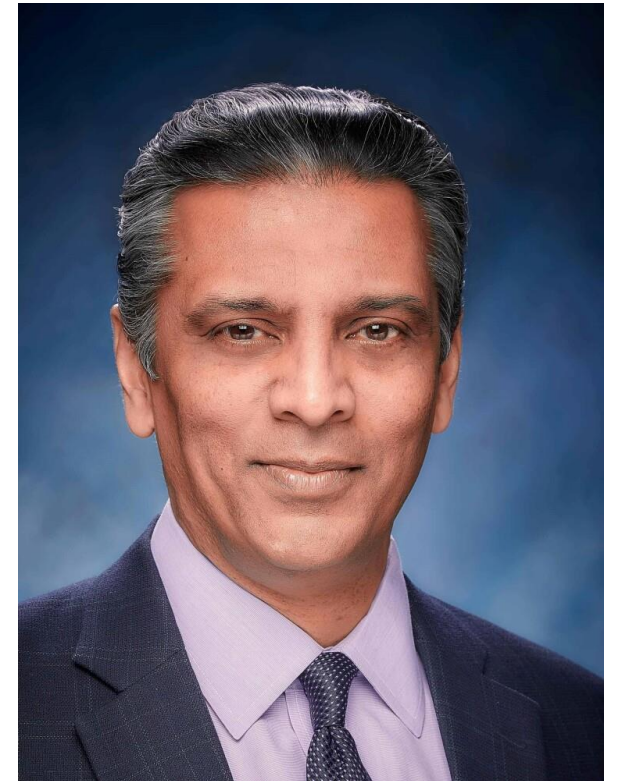

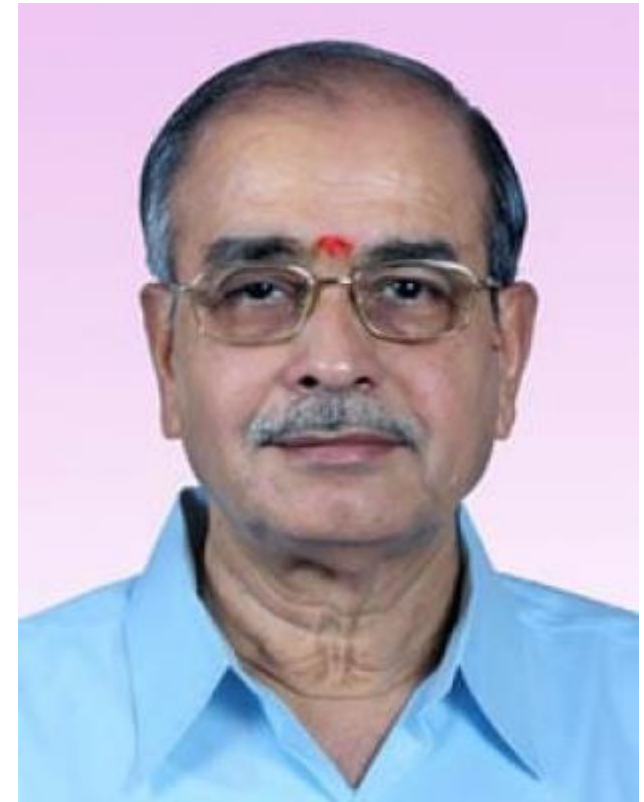

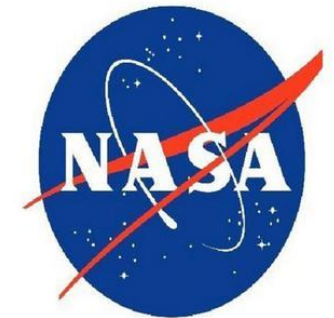

Explanation

- The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Indore in collaboration with the NASA-Caltech from the US and Sweden's University of Gothenburg has developed a low-cost camera setup which can provide multispectral imaging of four chemical species in a flame using single DSLR camera.
- It would come in handy for the study of combustion of fuels which in turn can lead to improvement in combustion engines to make them more efficient and reduce carbon emissions, researchers believe.
- the low-cost DSLR camera device 'CL-Flam' was developed after nearly three years of research in collaboration with the University of Gothenburg, Sweden, and NASA-Caltech, USA.
- The cost of developing the device, put together by a five-member team of researchers, was around Rs 50,000.

Explanation

- **Kenya** launched its first operational earth observation satellite onboard a SpaceX rocket from the United States, a live feed from Elon Musk's rocket company
- The satellite, developed by **nine Kenyan engineers**, will collect agricultural and environmental data, including on floods, drought and wildfires, that authorities plan to use for disaster management and to combat food insecurity.
- The Falcon 9 rocket carrying the **Taifa-1 satellite**, took off at about 0648 GMT without incident from Vandenberg Base in California, after three postponements due to bad weather
- The satellite was put together with the help of Bulgarian aerospace company Endurosat at a cost of 50 million Kenyan shillings (\$372,000) over two years
- The launch rocket had 50 payloads from other countries, including Turkey, under SpaceX's rideshare programme.

Turkey's first observation satellite launched into Orbit

- **Turkey's first observation satellite, IMECE**, was launched into orbit from the Vandenberg Space Force Base in the US state of California
- IMECE's orbit will be sun-synchronous at an altitude of 423 miles and will be used in the fields of defense, disaster management, environment and urbanization, as well as forestry and agriculture

- The initiative aims to provide FASTag based payment system at Forest entry points and will extend the benefit of collection of Ecosystem Management Coordination (EMC) fee via FASTag at various entrance points of the Tiger reserve.
- The FASTag system employs **Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) technology** to enable automatic toll payments at toll plazas and affixation of FASTag on all 4-wheelers & above vehicles have been mandated across India.
- By enabling FASTag - based payments at forest entry points, visitors can avoid long queues and delays, allowing them to savor the natural beauty and wildlife of these areas without any hassles

- The **924 meters long Tube 1** of the Peeda-Kunfer Tunnel would bypass **2.9 km** congested, zigzag, and the accident-prone area between Nashri and Ramban.
- The tunnel is a part of the ongoing four-lane project of the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) between Udhampur and Ramban on the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway.
- The tunnel will reduce the 2.9 km distance National Highway and it would provide huge relief to the passengers travelling in the Ramban district on the national highway.
- However, the work on the second tube, T-2, of the Peeda-Kunfer Tunnel was also in progress and only 50 to 100 meters of excavation work was pending on the second tube

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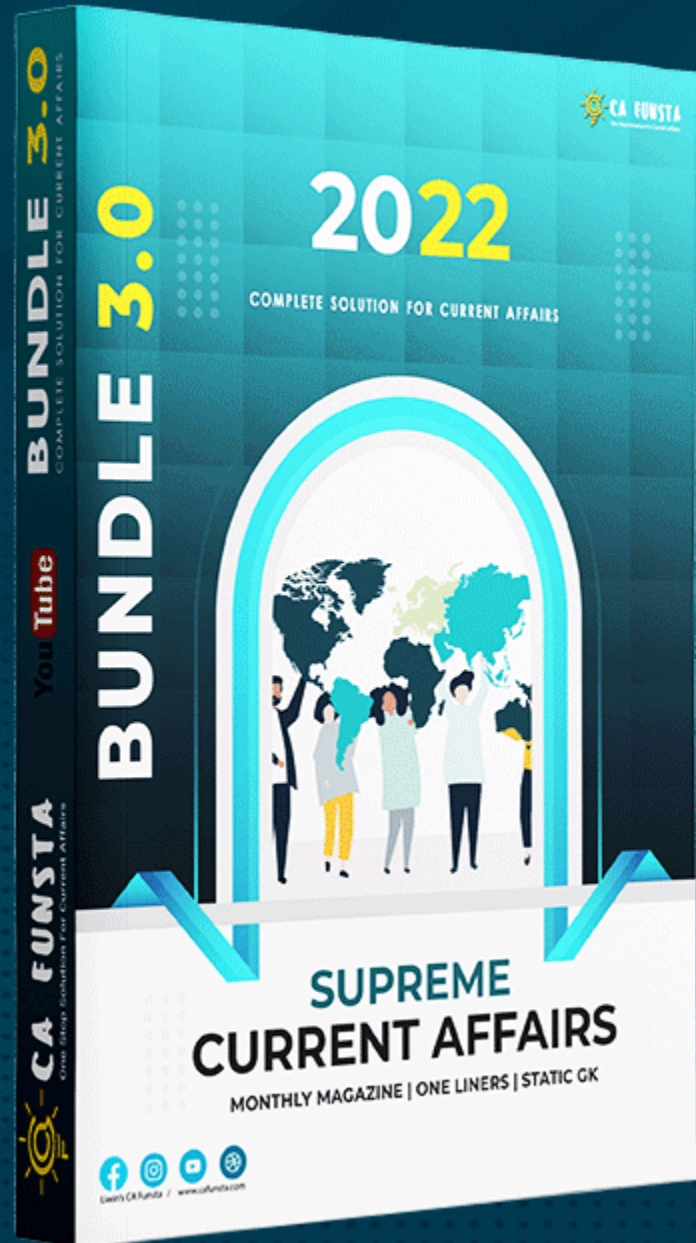
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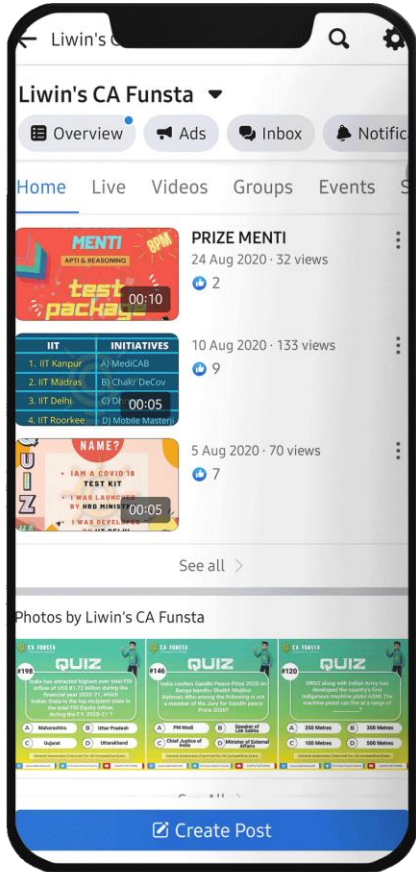
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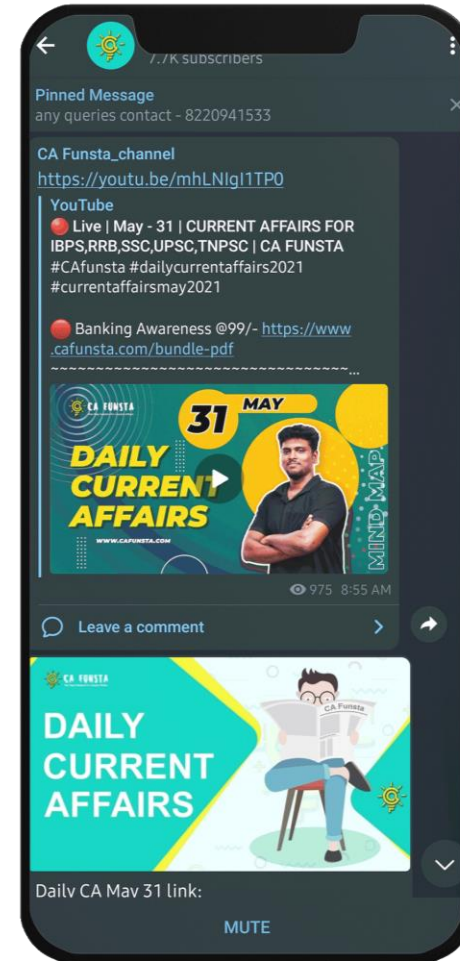
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
