Explanation

- The **Indian Space Research Organisation (Isro)** successfully placed **two Singaporean satellites, TeLEOS-2 and Lumelite-4**, in orbit aboard the trusted Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle.
- The **228-ton PSLV**, on its **57th flight**, lifted off from the Satish Dhawan Space in Sriharikota into an eastward low inclination orbit.
- Nearly 20 minutes after being launched, PSLV-C55 placed **TeLEOS-2** in an orbit 586km above earth
- The TeLEOS-2 satellite has been developed under a partnership between the **Defence Science and Technology Agency of Singapore and ST Engineering**, a Singaporean technology and engineering group.
- TeLEOS-2 carries a **Synthetic Aperture Radar (SAR) payload**. It will provide all-weather day and night coverage.

Explanation

- The **Lumelite-4 satellite** has been co-developed by the Institute for Infocomm Research of A*STAR and Satellite Technology and Research Centre of the National University of Singapore.
- Lumelite-4 is an advanced **12U satellite developed** for the technological demonstration of the high-performance space-borne VHF data exchange system. It aims to augment Singapore's electronic navigation maritime safety systems.
- India's maiden human space flight, **Gaganyaan**, was being targeted to be launched in the fourth quarter of **2024**.
- The **uncrewed G1 mission** is targeted to be launched in the last quarter of **2023**, followed by the **second uncrewed G2 mission** in the second quarter of **2024**, before the final **human space flight H1 mission** in the **fourth quarter of 2024**.

- Guyana has termed the ferry a “**game changer**” for travel and agri production.
- The 70-metre-long vessel, built with a **US\$12.77 million Grant/Line of Credit** from the Government of India, was commissioned on Friday as Indian External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar is visiting Guyana.

- The face of the coin will bear the symbol of the lion capital of the **Ashoka Pillar** in the centre, with the words '**satyameva jayate**' inscribed below it in the **Devanagari script**. This will further be flanked on the left periphery with the word 'Bharat' in Devanagari script, and the word 'India' in English, on the right.
- The coin face will also have the rupee symbol and the word '**100**' **below the lion capital**.
- The reverse face of the coin will bear the logo for the 100th episode of Mann Ki Baat, which consists of an image of a microphone "with sound waves and year '**2023**' written on the image of the microphone". The words '**Mann Ki Baat 100**' will be written in Devanagari script and in English above and below this image, respectively.
- The coin is to weigh 35 grams and is to be 50 per cent silver. The rest of its composition will include copper (40 per cent), Nickel (5 per cent), and Zinc (5 per cent)

- The total length of the pipeline in this single HDD crossing is **4,080 metre** across the main water channel of Brahmaputra river.
- This is the longest river crossing by any hydrocarbon pipeline of size **24-inch** diameter and above in Asia and the second longest in the world.
- Indradhanush Gas Grid Limited, is a joint venture company of five major Oil PSUs - **IOCL, ONGC, GAIL, OIL and NRL**. It is implementing the North East Gas Grid Project connecting the major cities and demand centres of North East India with the National Gas Grid.
- The **1656 km** long natural gas pipeline is constructed at a project cost of **Rs 9,265 crore**.
