- **World Malaria Day** is celebrated on **April 25** every year across the country.
- World Malaria Day 2023 will be marked under the theme "Time to deliver zero malaria: invest, innovate, implement", as per World Health Organization (WHO).
- The idea of World Malaria Day was developed from Africa Malaria Day. Africa Malaria Day is basically an event that has been observed by African governments since 2001, first held in 2008.
- In 2007, at the 60th session of the World Health Assembly, a meeting sponsored by the World Health Organisation (WHO) proposed that **Africa** Malaria Day be changed to World Malaria Day.
- The WHO launched the Global Technical Strategy for Malaria 2016-2030, focusing on reducing malaria cases and deaths by 90% by 2030.





International Delegate's Day

- 25 April marks International Delegate's Day in order to raise awareness of the role of the representatives and delegates of Member States to the United Nations.
- This day commemorates The San Francisco Conference which Delegates from 50 countries come together in San Francisco on **April 25, 1945**.

- 2023 Edition: 4th





World Penguin Day

- **World Penguin Day** on **April 25** aims to raise awareness about these flightless birds to preserve their species so that future generations get to see these elegant and remarkable creatures.
- According to the Antarctic and Southern Ocean Coalition, April 25th was chosen for the observance, as this day "coincides with the annual northern migration of Adelie penguins."
- Penguins, 18 known living species, 10 have been listed as endangered.
- Penguin Awareness Day is observed every year on January 20. Penguin Awareness Day was created to increase public awareness about penguins and their habitats.
- 2022 will mark 50 years of the official celebration of the Penguins.





World Day for Laboratory Animals

- World Day for Laboratory Animals, which is observed annually on April 24.
- This day was created to call attention to animal suffering, and killings undertaken in laboratories across the world.
- In 1979, NAVS established World Day for Laboratory Animals (also referred to as Lab Animal Day) on **April 24** – Lord Hugh Dowding's birthday.
- In 1980, People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA), led by PETA Founder, Ingrid Newkirk, organized the first World Day for Laboratory Animals protest in the U.S.



- Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) patriarch and five-time former chief minister of Punjab Parkash Singh Badal passed away at the age of 95.
- Parkash Singh Badal was born on December 8, 1927, in Punjab's Abul Khurana near Malout.
- In 1957, Parkash Singh Badal was elected as an MLA for the first time from the Malout seat which he contested on Congress party ticket.
- Parkash Singh Badal has served as the chief minister of Punjab for five terms first term from March 27, 1970 to June 14, 1971, second term from June 20, 1977 to February 17, 1980, third term from February 12, 1997 to February 26, 2002, fourth and fifth consecutive terms from March 2, 2007 to March 16, 2017.





- Badal served as the leader of the opposition in Punjab assembly from October 2, 1972 to April 30, 1977. He also held the position of union minister for agriculture and irrigation during the Morarji Desai government.
- He is also the patron of Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) a Sikh-centered regional political party. He served as the president of the party from 1995 to 2008.
- In 2015, the government of India awarded Parkash Singh Badal the second-highest civilian award -Padma Vibhushan.



- Harry Belafonte, who stormed the pop charts and smashed racial barriers in the 1950s with his highly personal brand of folk music, and who went on to become a dynamic force in the civil rights movement, died.
- Belafonte was dubbed the "King of Calypso" after the groundbreaking success of his 1956 hit, "The Banana Boat Song (Day-O)." He also became a movie star after acting in the film adaption of the Broadway musical, "Carmen Jones."
- He was a key strategist, fundraiser and mediator for the civil rights movement.
- He mobilized support for the fight against HIV/AIDS and became a UNICEF Goodwill Ambassador.





Explanation

- He also came up with the idea for recording the 1985 hit song, "We Are the World," which assembled a constellation of pop and rock stars, including Bob Dylan, Michael Jackson and Bruce Springsteen, to raise money for famine relief in Africa.
- He won a Tony Award for his acting on Broadway and was the first African American to win an Emmy award for his 1959 variety show.
- Belafonte also was a recipient of a Kennedy Center Honor in 1989, the National Medal of Arts in 1994 and a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award in **2000**.





- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has cancelled the banking licence of Kerala-based Adoor Co-operative Urban Bank and has allowed it to function as a non-banking institution.
- The cancellation of licence is with effect from the close of business on **April 24, 2023**, according to a notification issued by the RBI.
- The central bank said that it has cancelled the banking licence dated
 January 3, 1987, granted to The Adoor Co-operative Urban Bank Ltd, Adoor,
 Kerala to carry on banking business in India under Section 22 read with
 Section 56 of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949, with effect from the close
 of business on April 24, 2023.
- This makes it obligatory on the part of The Adoor Co-operative Urban Bank Ltd, Adoor, to stop conducting the business of 'banking' within the meaning of section 5(b) of the Act ibid, including acceptance of deposits from nonmembers with immediate effect.


RBI cancelled the licence of eight lenders in FY 2023. In 2022, the central bank cancelled the licence of 12 banks. 2021, three banks were ripped off the licence. In 2020, two cooperative banks were told to shut shop.

- The US Space Force said that Elon Musk's SpaceX was granted approval to lease a second rocket launch complex at a military base in California, setting the space company up for its fifth launch site in the United States.
- Under the lease, SpaceX will launch its workhorse Falcon rockets from Space
 Launch Complex-6 at Vandenberg Space Force Base, a military launch site north
 of Los Angeles where the space company operates another launchpad. It has
 two others in Florida and its private Starbase site in south Texas.
- Vandenberg Space Force Base allows for launches in a southern trajectory over the Pacific ocean, which is often used for weather-monitoring, military or spy satellites that commonly rely on polar Earth orbits.
- SpaceX's grant of Space Launch Complex-6 comes as rocket companies
 prepare to compete for the Pentagon's Phase 3 National Security Space Launch
 program, a watershed military launch procurement effort expected to begin in
 the next year or so.



- Vande Bharat, the semi-high-speed train from Thiruvananthapuram to Kasaragod, will cover the distance between the two places in about eight hours, thereby reducing the average travel time by almost three hours.
- Prime Minister Modi laid the foundation stone and inaugurate various projects worth more than Rs 3,200 crore. Apart from Kochi Water Metro, rail electrification of the **Dindigul-Palani-Palakkad section** will also be dedicated by PM Modi.

India's first water metro

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged off India's first water metro that connects 10 islands around Kochi through battery-operated electric hybrid boats for seamless connectivity with the city
- The metro project will start with eight electric hybrid boats developed under Cochin Shipyard Limited. The Kerala government and the German company KfW are funding this dream project. It consists of 38 terminals and 78 electric boats.
- The KWM service will launch in the first phase from the **High Court-Vypin** and Vyttila-Kakkanad terminals. The tickets for the boat trip start at Rs **20**. For frequent travellers, there are weekly and monthly passes available.





Digital Science Park

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for India's first third generation Digital Science Park being developed by the Kerala government.
- Amount: Rs 1500 crore project coming up at Technopark Phase IV-Technocity.
- The park is coming up at a 13.93 acre site as part of the **Technopark** Phase IV-Technocity and is located close to the Kerala University of Digital Sciences Innovation and Technology.
- The Kerala government has already allocated **Rs 200 crore** for the initial work on the park.
