



International No Diet Day

- International No Diet Day is observed on May 6 every year and was first started by Mary Evans in 1992.
- The purpose of the day was to help men and women around the world to appreciate their own. The day aims to tackle tough issues regarding diet and body awareness.





Border Roads Organisation (BRO) Raising Day

- **Edition**: 64th
- The BRO was formed on 7 May 1960 to secure India's borders and develop infrastructure in remote areas of the north and north-east states of the country.
- BRO has constructed over 61,218 km of roads, over 915 bridges, four tunnels, and 19 airfields along India's borders and in friendly foreign countries, including Bhutan, Myanmar, Afghanistan, and Tajikistan.
- As part of BRO Day, the Hon'ble Defence Minister flagged in the "Ekta Avam Shradhanjali Abhiyaan," a multi-modal expedition that commenced on 10 April 2023 from Daulat Beg Oldie (DBO) in Ladakh and Kibithu in Arunachal Pradesh and culminated on 07 May 2023 at Pune.
- The Hon'ble Minister inaugurated BRO Technical Training Complex and Drive-through Automated Driving Track.
- He also released BRO-centric software created as part of the Digital India initiative to automate various aspects of the functioning of the BRO.







World Athletics Day

- World Athletics Day is observed on May 7 to encourage sports activities throughout the world.
- The primary aim of this day is to inculcate athleticism in youngsters.

World Athletics Day 2023: History

- World Athletics Day was established in **1996** by the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) president and Italian sports official Primo Nebiolo.
- The IAAF was founded in Stockholm, Sweden, on **July 17, 1912**. The organization changed its name to World Athletics in **2019**.
- It is currently headquartered in Monaco and serves as the international governing body for the sport of athletics, including track and field events.
- In addition to governing competitions and setting official world records, it also standardizes technical equipment used in athletics.
- IAAF president Primo Nebiolo founded World Athletics Day in 1996.

- South Indian Bank has introduced e-BG (Electronic Bank) Guarantee) facility for its customers in partnership with National E-Governance Service Ltd (NeSL). It facilitates API-based paperless issue of bank guarantees, eliminating the need for physical documentation and record maintenance.
- The bank issued its First e-BG favouring a leading public sector unit for an amount of Rs 4.57 crore through NeSL.
- South Indian Bank's customers can now procure e-BGs for beneficiaries on-board NeSL.
- Paper-based BGs involve stamping, signing and transferring the physical BGs, while e-BGs are stamped electronically, eliminating the need for purchasing physical stamp paper, printing the documents and physical signatures.




Explanation

- PhonePe announced that it has gone live with the UPI Lite feature on its app.
 The feature allows users to initiate low-value payments under Rs. 200, with a single tap from their UPI Lite account without entering a PIN.
- The transaction is processed directly by debiting the on-device UPI Lite balance without involving the customers' banks' (remitter bank) core banking systems in real-time.
- This makes transactions more seamless and even faster than the regular UPI transactions while also increasing the success probability of the transaction.
- The feature is designed by NPCI and was launched by the Reserve Bank of India in September last year.



- A memorandum of understanding (MoU) was signed between the Embassy of India, Kathmandu and Sushila Thakur Memorial Health Foundation (STMHF), for the distribution of LPG gas stoves and cylinders in Mahottari District, Nepal with the Indian grant assistance of Rs 50 million (approx) under India-Nepal Development Cooperation.
- This project will benefit nearly 8,000 underprivileged and marginalised families of five municipalities in Mahottari District, Madhesh Pradesh of Nepal.
- The project is inspired by the Government of India's Pradhan Mantri
 Ujjwala Yojana which is a flagship scheme with an objective to make
 clean cooking fuel such as LPG available to rural and deprived
 households which were otherwise using traditional cooking fuels such
 as firewood, coal, cow-dung cakes.





- Since **2003**, India has taken up over 535 High Impact Community Development Projects in Nepal and has completed 478 projects.
- Amongst these, 81 projects are in Mahdesh Pradesh including 6 projects in Mahottari District.

- The Russian-Jewish author, whose novel In Memory of Memory explores Stalinism and the fall of the Soviet Union, was nominated for the Booker Prize in 2021, was honored in Leipzig for her volume of poetry, Girls Without Clothes.
- It is described as a sensitive and highly poetic study of often hidden violence against the female body and the power imbalance that drives this oppression.
- The award ceremony took place on April 25, marking the opening of the 30th Leipzig Book Fair.





- The World Health Organization (WHO) has launched a new initiative to be better prepared for future outbreaks of a similar scale and devastation as the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Preparedness and Resilience for Emerging Threats (PRET) Initiative is aimed at providing "guidance on integrated planning for responding to any respiratory pathogen such as influenza or coronaviruses".
- While the current focus of PRET will be on respiratory viruses in the backdrop of the SARS-CoV-2 outbreak, possible threat of an avian influenza outbreak — work is already underway to assess what should be the next group of pathogens to be mitigated under this initiative.
- The initiative was announced at the **Global Meeting for Future Respiratory** Pathogen Pandemics held on 24-26 April 2023 in Geneva, Switzerland.
