
- The World Day for Cultural Diversity for Dialogue and Development is observed across the globe annually on May 21.
- The day celebrates the richness of the world's cultures and highlights the important role of intercultural dialogue in achieving world peace and sustainable development.
- The World Day for Cultural Diversity for Dialogue and Development was established by the United Nations General Assembly in the year 2002, following UNESCO's adoption of the 2001 Universal Declaration on Cultural Diversity.





International Tea Day

- The **International Tea Day** is observed across the globe annually on May 21.
- International Tea Day was established in 2005 by teaproducing countries including Sri Lanka, Nepal, Indonesia, Kenya, Malaysia, and Uganda.
- The date chosen for this celebration was May 21.
- In 2019, the Intergovernmental Group on Tea decided to officially observe International Tea Day on May 21.
- The United Nations approved the celebrations on **December** 21, 2019.
- Consequently, May 21, 2020 marked the first official United Nations International Tea Day.





World Metrology Day

- World Metrology Day is celebrated on 20 May each year.
- It is to commemorate the anniversary of the signing of the Metre Convention in 1875.
- Metre Convention was an international treaty signed in Paris which established the basis for international agreement on units of measurement. The World Metrology Day project is an idea jointly by the BIPM and the OIML.
- First Celebration: 2000
- The theme of this year is "Measurements supporting the global food system".





World Bee Day

- World Bee Day is an annual observance held on May 20th to raise awareness about the importance of bees and other pollinators for the environment, agriculture, and human well-being.
- The United Nations designated this day for December 2017, with the first celebration taking place on May 20th, 2018.
- The theme for World Bee Day 2023 is "Engaging in Pollinator-Friendly Agricultural Production."
- May 20th was chosen as the designated date to honor the birthday of **Anton Janša**, a prominent Slovenian beekeeping pioneer and esteemed expert in the field of bees.

- The dividend payout was Rs 30,307 crore for accounting year 2021-22.
- The decision was taken at the 602nd meeting of the Central Board of Directors of Reserve Bank of India held under the chairmanship of governor Shaktikanta Das.

- Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras has signed a Letter of Intent
 (LoI) with Israel to build an 'India-Israel Center of Water Technology'
 (CoWT) in Water Resources Management and Water Technologies.
- The LoI to establish this center was signed by Manoj Joshi, Secretary,
 Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), Prof V Kamakoti,
 Director, IIT Madras, and Naor Gilon, Ambassador of Israel to India in the
 presence of External Affairs Ministers S Jaishankar and his Israeli
 counterpart Eli Cohen.
- The Centre aims to build human capacity to ensure the implementation of the best technologies of Israel in a tailor-made context for the Indian requirements and pilot sustainable technologies to ensure water security for the country.
- In cooperation with MASHAV, Israel's Agency for International Development Cooperation, the upcoming Centre will help MoHUA develop its 'AMRUT' Mission for achieving its overall targets.

- In a major move aimed at enhancing cooperation between the **Indian Navy and the Royal Saudi Naval Force**, cadets from the latter are in India for **24 days of afloat training**.
- 55 cadets from the King Fahd Naval Academy, Saudi Arabia arrived this week in Kochi, the headquarters of India's Southern Naval Command, as part of their first-ever training with the Indian Navy.
- 55 cadets along with five Directing Staff from King Fahd Naval Academy, Saudi Arabia arrived onboard First Training Squadron (1TS) ships, INS Tir and INS Sujata at Kochi as part of afloat training with the Indian Navy.
- The maiden afloat training of cadets from Royal Saudi Naval Force onboard Indian Navy's Training Squadron is a major stride towards mutual cooperation between the two Navies.

- On the occasion of **World Hypertension Day**, the **Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW)** announced the launch of its "**75/25**" initiative based on screening and putting 75 million people with hypertension and diabetes on Standard Care by 2025.
- The screening would be done through the **public health centres (PHCs)**.
- The Health Ministry made the announcement at the G20 co-branded event with the World Health Organisation (WHO). The event titled "Accelerating the Prevention and Management of Hypertension and Diabetes".
- In addition to the 75/25 initiative, the **Shashakt Portal** was also launched for the training of 40,000 primary health care medical officers on the Standard Treatment Workflow for NCDs, initiated to bring health care services closer to the community.
- The MoHFW also released revised operational guidelines for the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Non-Communicable Diseases (NP-NCD) with the aim of much wider coverage.

- The 42 inches tall bronze bust has been sculpted by Padma Bhushan awardee Shri Ram
 Vanji Sutar. The bust site, adjacent to the Motoyasu River, is close to iconic A-Bomb Dome
 that is visited by thousands of people locals and tourists alike every day.
- The location has been chosen as a mark of solidarity for peace and non-violence. Mahatma Gandhi dedicated his life to peace and non-violence. The location truly resonates with the principles and life of Gandhiji, which continue to inspire the world and its leaders

- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed for the development of 'Riverine
 Based Religious Tourism Circuit' among Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI),
 Sagarmala Development Corporation Limited (SDCL), Assam Tourism Development
 Corporation (ATDC) and Department of Inland Waterways Transport (DIWT), Government of Assam.
- The MoU will facilitate modern ferry service on a 'Hop On Hop Off' among seven (07) historic religious sites around Guwahati.
- The seven religious sites are Kamakhya, Pandunath, Ashwalknata, Doul Govinda,
 Umananda, Chakreshwar and Auniati Satra to be covered with the help of this agreement.
 The waiting lounge at the ferry terminal will be a modern facility providing comfortable ambience for the passengers.





- The project, executed via a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV), is likely to completed with an investment of Rs 45 crores and will be completed within 12 months.
- SDCL and IWAI will jointly contribute 55% of the project cost while the remaining will be provided by ATDC.
- **DIWT** has consented to provide the usage of Ghats near the temples free of cost for the project.

- Spanish company Indra has begun delivery of the naval version of its Lanza 3D surveillance radar to the Indian Navy, in collaboration with its Indian partner company, Tata Advanced Systems Limited (TASL).
- In 2020, Indra signed a contract with TATA Advanced Systems Limited (TASL), a local Indian company, for a technology transfer program.
- As part of the agreement, Indra will deliver three complete radars and the core components for an additional 20 radars, which TASL will integrate locally.
- The Lanza-N radar is based on the system installed on the Spanish Navy's ship Juan Carlos
 I but has been adapted to meet India's regulatory requirements, including environmental
 factors such as high humidity and extreme heat.
- In addition to its defense endeavors, **Indra** has partnered with **Centum Electronics**, an Indian company, to propose a joint project to the Indian Space Agency (ISRO) for manufacturing a radar system dedicated to observing and tracking objects in space.



- Air India's low-cost subsidiary AirAsia India, successfully operated the country's first commercial flight on the Pune-Mumbai sectors using an indigenously produced sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) blend.
- Flight I5767 flew from Pune to Delhi powered by SAF blended aviation turbine fuel (ATF) supplied by Indian Oil Corporation Ltd (IOCL) in partnership with Praj Industries, which provided the technology for the blend.
- Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Hardeep Singh Puri, received this special flight at the airport in New Delhi.
- The SAF sourced for this initiative by Praj Industries, is in partnership with Gevo Inc, which
 has developed a breakthrough Alcohol-to-Jet (ATJ) technology for the production of SAF
 using bio-based feedstock.
- The proposed rollout would be similar to what India is doing through its ongoing Ethanol Blended Petrol (EBP) programme to achieve a 20 per cent mix of ethanol in petroleum for the road transport sector by 2030.

- Shri Bhupender Yadav Inaugurates Centre of Excellence on Sustainable Land Management at Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education in Dehradun.
- The Prime Minister of India during the 14th Conference of the Parties (COP-14) of the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) on 9th September 2019, announced the establishment of Centre of Excellence on Sustainable Land Management (CoE-SLM) at the Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education.
- CoE-SLM aims to promote South-South Cooperation and address land degradation issues through sustainable land management practices.





- The CoE-SLM, established at the ICFRE, aims to facilitate the restoration of degraded land through technical support, capacity building, and knowledge sharing at the national and sub-national levels.
- By collaborating with developing countries that are party to the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD), the CoE-SLM seeks to achieve LDN targets, promote south-south cooperation, and contribute to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) outlined by various international conventions, including the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
- Shri Yadav also released two publications "Technical Paper on Pathway to achieve LDN in India" and "Compendium of Sustainable Land Management Practices" on this occasion.




