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

- World Refugee Day is celebrated every year on the 20th of June, serving as a global reminder of the challenges faced by refugees and displaced persons around the world.

- The resolution aimed to raise awareness about the increasing number of refugees worldwide and to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the 1951 Refugee Convention.
- The 1951 Refugee Convention, adopted in the aftermath of World War II, established the legal framework for the protection and rights of refugees.
- The theme of World Refugee Day 2023 is "hope away from home"



- The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) has approved appointment of SBI managing director Swaminathan Janakiraman to the post of deputy governor of Reserve Bank of India for a period of three years.
- Current RBI DG Mahesh Kumar Jain's term is set to expire in June.
- Swaminathan Janakiraman is currently the managing director of the State Bank of India and is responsible for the bank's Corporate Banking and Subsidiaries vertical.
- Prior to this role, he was responsible for Bank's Assurance functions Risk Management, Regulatory Compliance, and Stressed Assets verticals.
- He has also served as a nominee director of the SBI on the boards of Yes Bank, Jio Payments Bank, and NPCI as well as Bank of Bhutan, an SBI JV.
- Jain was appointed as a deputy governor in **June 2018** for three years. He was reappointed in June 2021 for a further two-year period.





- Jain is in-charge of the department of supervision, financial inclusion and development, consumer education and protection, among others.
- Currently, the other three deputy governors of the RBI are Michael D Patra, T Rabi Sankar and Rajeshwar Rao.
- MK Jain had served as the managing director and chief executive officer of IDBI Bank before being appointed as the deputy governor of the Reserve Bank Of India. Before joining IDBI Bank, he headed Indian Bank.

- The Peace Prize of the German Book Trade for 2023 has been awarded to British-American author Salman Rushdie, "for his indomitable spirit, for his affirmation of life and for enriching our world with his love of storytelling".
- The Peace Prize of the German Book Trade, endowed with €25,000 (\$27,300), will be handed out in a ceremony in October during the Frankfurt Book Fair.
- The prize, **created in 1950**, recognizes a personality committed to serving international understanding between nations and cultures through their work.
- Last year, the award went to Ukrainian author Serhiy Zhadan.
- Previous recipients include, among others, Margaret Atwood, Orhan Pamuk, Susan Sontag, Amos Oz, Vaclav Havel.
- Rushdie served as the president of the PEN American Center from 2004 to 2006, and then as chairman of the PEN World Voices International Literary Festival for 10 years.







- Multinational Peacekeeping Joint Exercise "Ex Khaan Quest 2023" featuring participation from military contingents and observers from over 20 countries has commenced in Mongolia.
- Mr Ukhnaagiin Khurelsukh, the Hon'ble President of Mongolia inaugurated the Exercise in a ceremony organised at the exercise location in Mongolia.
- The exercise is co-sponsored by Mongolian Armed Forces (MAF) and United States Army Pacific Command (USARPAC).
- The Indian Army is represented by a contingent from the GARHWAL RIFLES.





- The 14-day exercise is aimed at enhancing interoperability of the participating nations, for sharing experience and to train uniformed personnel for the United Nations Peacekeeping Operations (UNPKO).
- The exercise will prepare participants for future UN Peacekeeping missions, develop peace operations capabilities and enhance military readiness.
- The exercise includes Command Post Exercise (CPX), Field Training Exercises (FTX), combat discussions, lectures and demonstration.
- The military exercise will enhance the level of defence co-operation between Indian Army and participating countries especially with the Mongolian Armed Forces which will enhance bilateral relations between the two countries.








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- India gifted the indigenously-built in-service missile corvette INS Kirpan to **Vietnam** to enhance that country's naval capabilities.
- **Defence Minister Rajnath Singh** announced after bilateral talks with his visiting Vietnamese counterpart General Phan Van Gang.
- Both Ministers identified means to enhance existing areas of collaboration, especially in defence industry cooperation, maritime security and multinational cooperation.
- Earlier in the day, General Gang laid a wreath at the National War Memorial and was later given a Tri-Service guard of honour. He arrived in India on a two-day visit.
- INS Kirpan is a Khukri class missile corvette displacing 1,350 tonnes and was commissioned into the Navy on January 12, 1991.
- It has a displacement of close to 1,400 tonnes, a length of 91 metres, a beam of 11 metres, and is capable of speed in excess of 25 knots.





- The ship is fitted with a medium range gun, 30 mm close range guns, chaff launchers, and surface to surface missiles, enabling it to perform a wide variety of roles, including coastal and offshore patrol, coastal security, surface warfare, antipiracy, and Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) operations, according to the Navy.
- In June 2022, India and Vietnam signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on mutual logistics support in the presence of the two Defence Ministers during Mr. Singh's visit to the Southeast Asian nation, and the two Defence Ministers signed the "Joint Vision Statement on India-Vietnam defence partnership towards 2030", which the Ministry had said would significantly enhance the scope and scale of existing defence cooperation.
- Hanoi has procured 12 high speed patrol boats for the Vietnamese border guard force under a \$100 million Line of Credit (LoC) extended in September 2014.
- In 2016, India extended another \$500 million defence LoC, and discussions are under way to identify the equipment.





- **In its first field training exercise** in a foreign country, a contingent of the Vietnam People's Army was also hosted by **India** for the three-week "VINBAX" in August last year.
- India has also announced gifting two simulators and monetary grant towards the setting up of a Language and IT Lab at the Air Force Officers Training School for capacity building in the Vietnamese armed forces.
- India and Vietnam have shared a Comprehensive Strategic Partnership since 2016 and defence cooperation is a key pillar of this partnership.
- Vietnam is an important partner in India's 'Act East' policy and the Indo-Pacific vision.

- Mahindra Group chairman Anand Mahindra announced that Mahindra Defence Systems (MDS), a wholly-owned subsidiary of his company, has started deliveries of 'Armado,' an Armoured Light Specialist Vehicle (ALSV) built for the Indian armed forces (Indian Army).
- A fully-indigenous vehicle, Armado can accommodate a driver and 5
 passengers, the manufacturer noted on its website, adding that above
 the standard 1,000 kg load capacity, the ASLV can carry another 400
 kg.
- It gets ballistic protection up to the B7 level and STANAG level-2.
- Powering the 4-wheeler is a 3.2-litre multi-fuel diesel engine that generates 216 hp of maximum power. A 6-speed automatic gearbox sends power to the wheels through a dedicated 4x4 system.





- Armado takes just 12 seconds to accelerate from 0 to 160 kmph, and runs at a speed of more than 120 kmph.
- A modular vehicle, it can be used in counter-terrorism operations, raids in open and desert terrains, and reconnaissance missions. Special forces and quick reaction teams, too, can use it, doing so for conventional operations, weapon-carrying, border patrolling etc.

- Each project will be administered under a separate project agreement, in which TCIL will be the lead partner, C-DOT will be the technology partner and ITI will be the manufacturing partner.






Explanation


