- Harbin, capital of northeast China's Heilongjiang Province, was chosen by the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) to host the 2025 Asian Winter Games.
- The OCA made the decision at its 42nd Congress held in **Bangkok, Thailand**.
- It will be the second time Harbin hosts the Asian Winter Games - the first was in **1996** - and the third time the regional games is to be held in a Chinese city, the other being in Changchun, northeast China's Jilin Province, in 2007.
- Harbin's successful bid also came after Beijing successfully hosted the Olympic Winter Games in 2022






- Harbin which has previously hosted a number of events including the third Asian Winter Games in 1996, the 10th National Winter Games of China in 2003, and the 24th World University Games in 2009.
- Harbin, whose name was originally a Manchu word meaning "a place for drying fishing nets", grew from a small rural settlement on the Songhua River to become one of the largest cities in Northeast China.
- The yet-to-be-built **Saudi Arabia resort of Trojena** was awarded the **2029 Asian Winter Games** as last year's OCA General Assembly in Phnom Penh.











- Sapporo in Japan held the last Asian Winter Games in 2017 when 64 events in 11 sports were contested.
- It was the second time they had hosted the Games having staged the first edition in **1986**.


- The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the proposal of the Department of Telecommunications for the extension in tenure of Dr. Rajkumar Upadhyay, CEO, C-DoT for a period of two years beyond his attaining the age of 60 years, or until further orders
- Earlier, the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) had proposed the extension for **Upadhyay** beyond his superannuation on July 9, 2023.
- In October 2020, **Upadhyay** joined India's telecom technology research organisation C-DoT as the executive director.
- Last December, he was promoted to the newly-created rank of the CEO, and had become C-DoT's board chairman.

- Upadhyay is also the founding member of the Bharat 6G Alliance, the country's prestigious group to spearhead developments in the next generation technology.






- The Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) elected Sheikh Talal Fahad Al-Sabah as its new president at the 42nd OCA Congress.
- Sheikh Talal received 24 of the 44 votes cast.
- Sheikh Talal, 58, is the son of the first OCA president Sheikh Fahad Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah, who was president from 1982 to 1990, and the younger brother of the previous OCA president Sheikh Ahmad Fahad Al-Sabah, who led the organization from 1991 to 2021.
- Sheikh Talal joined the OCA in 2007 and served as chair of the OCA Rules Committee and a member of the OCA Executive Board.

#### Explanation

- Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel and Union Minister of State for Communications Devusinh Chauhan launched the Antyodaya Shram Suraksha Accident Insurance Scheme from Nadia of Kheda district in Gujarat.
- The scheme, launched on a pilot basis, is being implemented through the Indian Postal Department, the Indian Post Payments Bank, and the Ministry of Labour and Employment.
- It is important to note here that Gujarat became the first state in India to launch a scheme for the welfare of laborers.
- The objective of Antyodaya Shramik Suraksha Yojana is to give priority to the welfare and safety of our Shram Yogis so that they can get financial security in case of an accident.
- Under this scheme, insurance with a **premium of ₹289 and ₹499 per year** will provide to be crucial support to workers in the event of death or partial disability.





- In case of the laborer's accidental death, ₹10 lakh will be given to their family and the same amount will be given to the worker in case of permanent disability.
- Also, in the event of the death, the deceased's children will be eligible for education assistance of **₹1 lakh**.
- The India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 1st September 2018.
- IPPB has been set up under the Department of Posts, Ministry of Communications, with 100% equity owned by the Government of India.
- The bank has been established with a vision to make it the most accessible, affordable, and reliable bank for the common man in India.






- Larsen & Toubro and Navantia of Spain signed a teaming agreement (TA) to participate in a techno-commercial bid for the Indian Navy's six P75 (India) submarine programme expected to be valued at \$5.8 billion.
- The TA was signed at the Spanish Embassy to meet the deadline of the Request for Proposal (RFP) floated by the Ministry of Defence for six submarines which was earlier extended to August.
- The other bidder is defence PSU Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders which has tied up with Germany's Thyssenkrupp Marine Systems.
- P75(I) will be the first programme to be processed under the ambitious Strategic Partnership (SP) model of acquisition of the Ministry of Defence.










#### Explanation

- Navantia would carry out the design of P75(I) submarines based on its S80 class of submarines, the first of which was launched in 2021 and is undergoing sea trials prior to its delivery to Spanish Navy at the end of 2023.
- Apart from S80 class, Navantia has been involved in design and construction of Scorpéne class of submarines together with DCNS (Now Naval Group) of France, which have been exported to Chile and Malaysia. Navantia has also been involved in the Scorpene submarines (Kalvari class) built in India including handholding of the Indian yard.
- P75(I) program calls for integration of an AIP system.
- In March, Centre approved a budget of Rs 56,000 crore for its navy, which has 16 conventional submarines, 11 of which are more than two decades old, along with two indigenous nuclear-powered submarines.
















- Odisha Cabinet approved 'Ama Odisha Nabin Odisha' scheme with an allocation of Rs 4000 crore.
- There is provision of Rs. 4000 Crore under the scheme from the State Budget.
- The State government has modified the guidelines of the earlier intervention "Ama Gaon Ama Bikash" by giving it a new dimension in the form of "Ama Odisha Nabin Odisha" under the State Plan to make it effective from the Financial Year 2023-24.







#### The details of the Scheme are as follows

- The vision of the intervention is to transform Odisha into a modern and aspirational Odisha retaining the essence, soul, and spirit of Jagannath culture and spreading over to the world. Odisha is the land that gave Jagannath culture to the world. A culture that is based on universal love, service and equality.
- The main objective of the scheme is to provide missing links to the existing small and essential projects and the development of infrastructure. Also achieving empowerment of women, youth, bridging critical gap in education, digital and sports facilities.
- Improvement of infrastructure for primary education and also providing missing links to the existing development infrastructure, construction, modernization, and expansion works.
- Creating additional facilities for Mission Shakti Groups at GP level.

#### The details of the Scheme are as follows

- Bridging critical gaps at GP level to improve rural areas by way of providing urban facilities.
- Development of sports facilities for the youths.
- Providing Banking Facilities.
- Improvement of digital access in terms of mobile connectivity, optical fibre connectivity, WiFi and internet connectivity.
- There is a budget provision of Rs 4000 crore under the scheme from the State Budget.
- The scheme will cover all Gram Panchayats in each Block of the State with the entitlement of Rs 50 lakh.
- The project cost shall be between Rs 2.50 lakh to Rs 10 lakh.









- The project under the scheme shall be suggested/ recommended by local people/community organizations/ public representatives and other stakeholders.
- The consolidated G.P. wise project list of the Block shall be submitted to PR & DW Department with the signatures of the Collector and President, Zilla Parishad of the district for due examination and approval of the Government.
- The Panchayat Samiti shall execute the work departmentally following due procedure. The Collector shall be authorized to select any other agency/agencies for the execution of work.
- Transparency measures such as a web-based MIS for monitoring the Scheme and a dedicated app for sharing photographs before, during, and after each project with GIS tagging shall be developed under the scheme.
