




Important Days



- International Malala Day is celebrated on 12 July, every year, to honour and observe the bravery of Malala Yousafzai.
- The United Nations first celebrated International Malala Day on July 12, 2013 a year after she was shot by a Taliban gunman in Pakistan for opposing their restrictions on female education in the country.
- The meeting of the UN was addressed by former British Prime Minister Gordon Brown, who was then serving as UN Special Envoy for Global Education. The day also coincides with Malala's birthday.
- She won the Nobel Peace Prize in **2014** at just the age of 17 for her advocacy of girls' education.
- In 2013, she and her father co-founded the Malala Fund to bring awareness to the social and economic impact of girls' education and to empower girls to demand change.

SPORTS



- India won 11 medals at the World Archery Youth Championships 2023 in Limerick, Ireland held from July 3-9. The medal haul of the 24-member Indian contingent included six gold, one silver and four bronze.
- The World Archery Youth Championships 2023 had events for men's and women's recurve and compound archers in the under-21 and under-18 age categories.
- Individual, as well as team events, took place at the University of Limerick. India sent 12 archers each in the U21 and U18 age groups.
- At the last edition of the World Archery Youth Championships held in 2021 in Wroclaw, Poland, India won 15 medals, including eight golds.



OBITUARY



- Former Barcelona and Inter Milan midfielder Luis
 Suarez, the only male footballer born in Spain to win the Ballon D'Or, died
- Nicknamed "The Architect" the Spaniard won the prestigious award in 1960 and later coached La Roja at the 1990 World Cup.
- Suárez won the Ballon d'Or in 1960 and was runnerup in 1961 and 1964. He played on Spain's team that won the 1964 European Championship, its first major title.
- He also managed Spain's national side from 1988-91.
- Spanish midfielder Alexia Putellas has won the women's Ballon d'Or twice.

- The first IBU was set up at GIFT City by Yes Bank in 2015.
- The IBU, which will be initially manned by 10 employees, will be BOI's 22nd international branch.
- The BOI IBU will provide a range of global banking solutions, External Commercial Borrowing (ECBs), Trade Finance Facilities, Foreign Currency Loans, Syndication Loans (Origination, Underwriting & Distribution), Foreign Currency deposit account -Current & Term Deposits, besides offering digital banking facilities through transaction-based Internet Banking facility.
- Mr. Karnatak also inaugurated the NRI Help Centre (NRI HC) housed in the premises of the Centralised Foreign Exchange Back Office (FEBO), on 18th Floor in Tower-1 in GIFT City, Gandhinagar.

AWARDS



- India topped the medals tally at the 34th International Biology Olympiad (IBO)
 2023, held in Al Ain, UAE, from July 3 to 11, by securing four gold medals.
- For the first time, India has turned in an all-gold performance and topped the medals tally in IBO.
- The student's team this year was Dhruv Advani (Gold) from Bengaluru,
 Karnataka, Ishan Pednekar (Gold) from Ratnagiri, Maharashtra, Megh Chhabda (Gold) from Jalna, Maharashtra, Rohit Panda (Gold) from Risali, Chhattisgarh.
- The team was accompanied by two leaders, Professor Madan M. Chaturvedi
 (Former Senior Professor, Delhi University) and Dr Anupama Ronad (Homi
 Bhabha Center for Science Education, TIFR), and two Scientific Observers, Dr V.
 V. Binoy (National Institute of Advanced Studies, Bengaluru) and Dr Rambhadur
 Subedi (NIRRH, Mumbai).



AWARDS



- There were 293 students from 76 countries in this year's IBO. After India, Singapore was the only other country to secure four gold medals.
- In all 29 gold medals were awarded.
- Earlier, India topped the medals tally in Astronomy and Astrophysics (in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2015, and 2021), Physics (in 2018), and Junior Science (in 2014, 2019, 2021, and 2022).
- The International Biology Olympiad organises the world's premier biology competition for secondary school students with an aim to stimulate and expand their talents to promote their future careers as students.

- Department of Telecommunications (DoT) secretary K Rajaraman has launched the Standards Coordination Portal, developed by the Telecommunication Engineering Centre (TEC) in association with the Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DoT) and Telecommunications Standards Development Society, India (TSDSI) to drive the country's engagement in global standardisation activities.
- The portal by bringing together experts from diverse sectors including industry, academia, research institutes, and government aims to boost India's involvement in global standardisation activities.
- The portal shall also serve as a central hub for sharing information and promoting collaboration in the standardisation of telecom and related ICT domains.
- Rajaraman has also launched the TEC standard on "Fairness Assessment and Rating of Artificial Intelligence Systems".

- The Defense Acquisition Council approved the proposal to buy 26 Rafale-M fighter aircraft for the Indian Navy.
- These include 22 single-seated Rafale marine aircraft, and four twin-seater trainer versions.
- Also, three additional Scopene class submarines will also be bought for the Indian Navy. The deals are expected to be worth around Rs 90,000 crore.
- These planes will be used by the Indian Navy on the INS Vikrant and INS Vikramaditya, which currently employ the MiG-29. This will be the second such fighter jet purchase from the French aerospace major Dassault Aviation in recent years.

- Both Ministers also unveiled a book titled 'Healthy Recipes for Defence' to promote the consumption of Shree Anna (millets) and its health benefits.
- The MoU was signed by Lt. Gen. Preet Mohindera Singh, Director General (Supplies and Transport) on behalf of Ministry of Defence (MoD) and Ms Inoshi Sharma, Executive Director, Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI).





- It aims to create awareness about the nutritional benefits of diet diversity and millet-based food products among the personnel.
- The book 'Healthy Recipes for Defence', developed by FSSAI, includes a range of millet-based dishes. It will serve as a valuable resource for different canteens and food outlets under the MoD.



- The Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways is committed towards innovation, building best infrastructure, and strengthening the Indian Maritime sector to further the digital initiative in maritime sector the Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Shri Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurated the indigenous Differential Global Navigation Satellite System (DGNSS) 'SAGAR SAMPARK' in the presence of Shri Shripad Y. Naik, the Minister of State of Ports, Shipping and Waterways; Shri TK Ramachandran, IAS Secretary, MoPSW and other senior officials from the ministry and Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships.
- DGNSS is a terrestrial based enhancement system which corrects the errors and inaccuracies in the Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) allowing for more accurate positioning information.
- The DGNSS service will help mariners in safe navigation and will reduce the risk of collisions, groundings, and accidents in the port and harbour areas.
 This will lead to safe & efficient movement of vessels.
