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


Important Days



- International Chess Day is celebrated on July 20 every year with the aim to raise awareness about the game of chess and appreciate chess players across the world.
- International Chess Day was announced in **1996** by UNESCO to commemorate the establishment of the International Chess Federation, commonly known as **FIDE** by its French acronym.
- On **December 12, 2019,** the General Assembly proclaimed **20 July** as World Chess Day, marking the establishment of the International Chess Federation (FIDE) in Paris in **1924**.
- FIDE was founded in **Paris, France**, and currently has its **headquarters in Switzerland**.
- FIDE is an international body responsible for connecting various international chess federations and acts as the governing body for international chess competitions.
- FIDE was recognised by the International Olympic Committee in 1999.







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
Explanation

- The trophy tour of the prestigious Durand Cup reached Air Force Academy (AFA), Dundigal, Hyderabad

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
• The trophies were unveiled by **Air Marshal B Chandra Sekhar, Commandant Air Force Academy.**

- The final is scheduled on **September 3**.







- India finished the 25th edition of Asian Athletics Championships by winning 27 medals – six gold, nine silver, and 12 bronze medals respectively.
- The Asian Athletics Championships 2023 was held at Suphachalasai National Stadium in Bangkok, Thailand, from July 12 to 16.
- This achievement equaled their previous record -in 2017 edition held at Bhubaneshwar.
- The Asian Athletics Championships was held after a gap of four years after the 2021 edition in Hangzhou, China was cancelled due to COVID-19.
- The previous edition, **Doha 2019**, saw India finish with 16 medals two gold, seven silver and seven bronze.


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




- In the overall Asian Athletics Championships 2023 medals table, India finished third, behind Japan and the People's Republic of China.
- Japan won in 37 medals, including 16 golds, while China bagged 22 medals, including eight golds.



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
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

- The **Indian men's football team** achieved sub-**100 FIFA ranking** for the first time since 2018 as it moved up one spot to **99th** after its SAFF Championship triumph.
- Lebanon also gained two places to be just below India at 100th spot while Kuwait moved up four places to be at 137th.
- India now have 1208.69 points.
- India's best FIFA ranking was 94th, attained in 1996. The country had also reached 99th spot in 1993 and 96th in 2017 and 2018. It was placed at 100th last month.
- Overall, world champions **Argentina** continued to be at the top, followed by **France, Brazil, England and Belgium.**
- In Asia, Japan led the chart at 20th spot, followed by Iran (22), Australia (27), Korea (28) and Saudi Arabia (54) in top five














- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has cancelled the licence of Uttar Pradesh-based United India Co-operative Bank.
- Consequently, the bank (Nagina, Bijnor, Uttar Pradesh) will cease to carry on banking business with effect from the close of business on July 19, 2023.
- The bank does not have adequate capital and earning prospects and has failed to comply with the requirements of relevant Sections of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.
- Every depositor would be entitled to receive deposit insurance claim amount of his/her deposits up to a ceiling of ₹5 lakh from the Deposit Insurance and Credit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC).

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- Giving reasons for cancellation of the licence, it said United India Co-operative Bank, based out of Bijnor in Uttar Pradesh, does not have adequate capital and earning prospects.
- With the licence cancelled, the bank has been prohibited from conducting regular business, which includes acceptance and repayment of deposits.
- The Commissioner and Registrar of Cooperative, Uttar Pradesh, has also been requested to issue an order for winding up the bank and appoint a liquidator for the bank.











- An MoU has been signed between the Ministry of Culture and Canara Bank for disbursal of financial assistance to the selected beneficiaries under the "Scheme for Financial Assistance for Veteran Artists" earlier known as "Scheme for Pension and Medical Aid to Artists".
- As per the MoU, master data of selected beneficiaries both for fresh as well as legacy data is to be uploaded by the Ministry in the online portal to be developed by the Canara Bank for this purpose.

- An artist aged 60 years and above who have contributed in the field of art and culture in their active age and whose annual income is not more than Rs. 48,000/- can apply under the scheme either through Art & Culture Department of concerned State Government/UT or Zonal Cultural Center.
- Release of financial assistance on monthly basis to the eligible beneficiaries is one of the main objectives of the MoU entered with Canara Bank.



- Under this scheme an amount of Rs. 26.00 crore has been allocated in B.E. for the year 2023-24.
- To ensure transparency and efficient utilization of funds, the scheme guidelines provides for direct transfer of amount to the account of selected beneficiaries.

- Howrah railway station, the largest in the country in terms of number of platforms, was awarded the CII-IGBC gold rating for incorporating green buildings and passenger-friendly features.
- The features that brought the honour to the 169-year-old station include the installation of station rooftops, water management, mechanised cleaning, no artificial lighting during the daytime, solid waste management, fresh air ventilation, universal accessibility, pedestrian friendliness and first- and last-mile connectivity.
- The station, which witnesses a daily footfall of approximately 6.5 lakh passengers, was awarded the CII-IGBC (Confederation of Indian Industry-Indian Green Building Council) gold rating under its green railway stations rating system.
- **Built in 1854** with just one platform, Howarh station now has 23 platforms.












- The first train which moved from it on August 15, 1854, went to Hooghly station over 38 kilometres away.
- The objective of the CII-IGBC rating is to facilitate the adoption of green concepts, thereby reducing the adverse environmental impacts due to station operation and maintenance, and enhancing the overall commuter experience at stations.







- As many as 34 services of the Revenue department have been digitised.







- Government had allocated ₹24,166 crore for the scheme in it's recent budget announcement.
- The scheme will come into effect from August 16 onwards
- It will cost the government ₹35,000 crore every year.



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- Women from both Below Poverty Line (BPL) and Above Poverty Line (APL) households are eligible for the scheme as long as they - or the husbands - do not fall under the tax-paying bracket.
- The registration for the scheme is free of cost.














- For operationalizing the scheme, DAHD has established a Credit Guarantee fund Trust of Rs. 750.00 crores, which will provide credit guarantee coverage up to 25% of the credit facilities extended to the MSMEs by the eligible lending institutions.
- The credit guarantee scheme facilitates access to finance for un-served and underserved livestock sector, making availability of financial assistance from lenders to mainly first-generation entrepreneurs and under privileged section of society, who lack collateral security for supporting their ventures.










- The main objective of the Credit Guarantee Scheme is that the lender should give importance to project viability and secure the credit facility purely on the basis primary security of the assets financed.
- The establishment of credit guarantee fund trust was approved under the Prime Minister's AtmaNirbhar Bharat Abhiyan stimulus package of Rs.15000 crores" Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund" (AHIDF) for incentivizing investments by individual entrepreneurs, private companies, MSMEs, Farmers Producers Organizations (FPOs) and Section 8 companies to establish (i) the dairy processing and value addition infrastructure, (ii) meat processing and value addition infrastructure, (iii) Animal Feed Plant, (iv) Breed Improvement technology and Breed Multiplication Farm (v) Animal Waste to Wealth Management (Agri Waste Management) and (vi) Setting up of Veterinary Vaccine and Drugs Manufacturing facilities.










- One of the key features of the AHIDF scheme is the establishment of a Credit Guarantee Fund Trust of Rs. 750.00 Crores.
- DAHD has formed a trust with NABSanrakshan Trustee Company Private Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of NABARD for the establishment of a Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for extending the credit guarantee to Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises under AHIDF scheme.
- This fund trust established in **March 2021** is the Nation's first ever fund trust under Credit guarantee scheme of AHIDF in the agriculture and Animal Husbandry sector and is a path-breaking initiative taken by DAHD which would exponentially increase the number of MSME units getting benefits of AHIDF scheme and strengthen the ecosystem for the collateral-free credit from the banks.







 - loan up to 90% of the total project cost from any Scheduled Bank, National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC).
















- It will create approximately 500 direct and indirect employment opportunities in the state.
