



Explanation

- Every year, National Flag Adoption Day is celebrated in India on July 22.
- The day is observed to commemorate the Constituent Assembly's adoption of the tricolour in its current form in 1947, a month before our country gained Independence from British rule.

History

- The National Flag was first designed in 1923 by Pingali Venkayya.
- The initial flag design by Venkayya had only two colours red representing Hindus in the country and green representing the Muslim population.
- However, Gandhiji asked Venkayya to add a white colour representing peace and the remaining communities of India and also suggested adding a running wheel to symbolise the progress of the Nation.
- The Constituent Assembly on July 22, 1947, approved this flag, which was also called the Swaraj flag.

- After India received its freedom, the pattern of the flag remained the same, and the running wheel was replaced with the Ashok Chakra with 24 equallyspaced spokes.
- Also, the red colour of the flag was changed to saffron.

Pi Approximation Day 2023

Pi Approximation Day is celebrated on July 22 every year.

History

- The symbol of Pi was designed back in 1706 by mathematician Leonhard Euler.
- Pi Approximation Day, besides being celebrated on July 22, is also celebrated on November 10, as it is the 314th day of the year.
- Pi Day is also observed on March 14, as it looks like 3/14 when placed in the month/date format.





World Brain Day

- World Brain Day is celebrated globally on July 22nd every year
- World Brain Day's 2023 theme is "Brain Health and Disability: Leave No One Behind."
- The World Federation of Neurology (WFN) was founded on July 22, 1957.
 The Public Awareness and Advocacy Committee put up a suggestion that
 led to the creation of "World Brain Day" on July 22. This suggestion was
 presented during the World Congress of Neurology (WCN) Council of
 participants meeting on September 22, 2013, and the participants heartily
 welcomed it.
- Following this enthusiastic response, the Board of Trustees gave the idea its blessing at their meeting in February 2014, making it an annual celebration that would take place on the same day every year.





National Mango Day

- The National Day of the Mango is celebrated every year on July 22.
- The National Horticulture Board of India came up with the idea for the International Mango Festival in 1987 as a way to honour the adored mango
- The name "mango" originates from the Malayan word "manna"





National Broadcasting Day 2023

- National Broadcasting Day is observed on July 23 every year in India.
- The India Broadcasting Company was established on July 23, 1927 and became the first radio company in India.
- Nonetheless, the company faced liquidation in less than three years.
- Following, All India Radio (AIR) came into being in April 1930 as the Indian Broadcasting Service.
- On **June 8**, it was rebranded again as All India Radio.
- Since 1956, All India Radio has been officially known as 'Akashvani'.





- The name **Akashvani** (**voice or announcement from the skies**) was formally adopted by the national broadcaster in 1956. The name was derived from a poem of the same name by Rabindranath Tagore in 1938. He wrote the poem for the inauguration of Kolkata's first short-wave radio station, as noted by historian Chandrika Kaul.
- In 1941, AIR came under the purview of the Department of Information and Broadcasting in British India.



- China's Galactic Energy successfully launched two satellites Qiankun-1 and Taian into orbit
- The satellites were launched via a Ceres-1 carrier rocket from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center
- This is the sixth launch for this rocket series. The Qiankun-1 remote earth probing satellite will be used to test "key breakthrough technologies for extremely low orbit and for establishment of an advance aerospace platform."
- The Taian, also known as Xing Shidai-16, is designed for a hightechnology computer project.
- The Ceres-1 is solid-propellant four-stage light rocket fuel. It is 19 meters long, 1.4 meters wide and can take up to 400 kg of cargo into orbit.

- Overall, these rockets have launched 21 commercial satellites for 12 organizations.
- The launch was the sixth flight mission of the CERES-1 rocket series.

Explanation

- The government has extended the unemployment scheme, the Atal Beemit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana, under the Employees' State Insurance Corporation for a period of two years up to June 30, 2024.
- It has been decided to extend the Atal Beemit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana for the period 01.07.2022 to 30.06.2024 with the relaxed eligibility conditions and enhanced rate of relief
- ABVKY was launched in 2018 to provide employment opportunities to people who lost their jobs during the novel coronavirus pandemic, including industrial workers.
- ABVKY was launched on a pilot basis for two years with an aim to provide relief to those who were left unemployed during the Covid-19 pandemic

- Under this scheme, insured people are paid unemployment allowance at 50 per cent of wages for three months who lost their jobs for various reasons. People whose interests are protected by an insurance policy come under the category of insured.
- Employees who are covered under the ESI scheme can avail the benefits of ABVKY.





Explanation

Eligibility criteria for Atal Beemit Vyakti Kalyan Yojana:

- -Employees working with private companies, factories and industries can avail the benefits of ABVKY. Either an ESI card has to be made or benefits can be claimed with the help of documents given by the company.
- -Only those people can avail the benefits of ABVKY whose monthly salary is less than Rs 21,000 and in the case of specially disabled people, the limit is Rs 25,000.
- -The insured person must have insurable employment for a minimum time period of two years before his/her employment.
- -The insured person should also have contributed to ESI not less than 78 days in the contribution period immediately preceding unemployment to avail the benefits of the scheme. As per the government notification, the contribution should have been paid or payable by the employer.






Explanation

- As per the government notification, the contribution should have been paid or payable by the employer.
- If the person has lost his/her job due to punishment, misconduct, superannuation or voluntary retirement, then the benefits of ABVKY cannot be availed.
- The Aadhaar and bank account of the insured person must be linked with the data base and the claims can be filed only by workers.
- -The claim will be due 30 days after the date of unemployment. Earlier, the limit was 90 days.

- A Revamped India Energy Security Scenarios (IESS) 2047 (IESS 2047 V3.0) to assess the integrated impact of various green energy policies of Government of India was released by NITI Aayog.
- An open-source tool, IESS incorporates several policies related to alternative energy resources like Green Hydrogen, Energy Storage, Renewable Purchase Obligations, PM-KUSUM, offshore wind strategy, Electric Vehicle policy, Energy efficiency, etc. Assessing the demand and supply of energy in the country, the tool helps in analysing emissions, cost, land, and water requirements till 2047.
- The release was attended by Shri Suman Bery, VC, NITI Aayog, Dr. V.K. Saraswat, Member, NITI Aayog, Shri B.V.R. Subrahmanyam, CEO, NITI Aayog, Shri Amitabh Kant, G-20 Sherpa, and other experts from Academia, Industry and the Government.





- With an aim of making this technology available to the people, this version of IESS is easily downloadable and facilitates users to generate their own pathways.
- It will help researchers and think tanks to develop user-specific scenarios and the option of customised applications on the basis of share of industry/services/agriculture, population, the pace of urbanisation, end-use energy demand etc.
- IESS 2047 is a user-friendly interactive tool that can help ministries/ departments to develop a variety of energy transition scenarios to achieve netzero. The tool is flexible enough to provide many permutations and combinations of net-zero pathways. It provides capabilities to compute the energy needs and estimates of the country and hence reduce India's dependency on external agencies for the estimates.

- The planemaker **Airbus** will deliver India's first tactical military transport aircraft C295 to Indian Air Force (IAF) in September.
- IAF crews will carry out acceptance trials of India's first C295 transport aircraft at the Airbus Defence and Space's Seville facility in southern Spain in early September before taking delivery of the plane.
- The first 16 C295 aircraft will be delivered to the IAF by Airbus in flyaway condition from Spain.
- Remaining forty planes are to be built in India, and work on domestic production is in full swing





- The delivery of first C295 to India will set in motion a crucial 'Make in India' project worth ₹21,935 crore to equip the IAF with 56 such aircraft.
- The first C295 aircraft has completed its maiden flight in May and second one is in final assembly stage at Airbus's Seville facility and will be delivered to IAF in May 2024, said the report.
- Two years ago, India's defence ministry had signed the contract with Airbus to boost self-reliance in the defence manufacturing sector. Tata Advanced Systems Limited (TASL) and Airbus are jointly executing the project.





- Six IAF pilots and 20 technicians have been trained at the Seville facility, Jorge Tamarit, head of the C295 India programme
- Another 18 pilots and 60 technicians will be trained at Seville next year
- The main constituent assembly for the C295 set up by Tata at Hyderabad will be functional next week, while the final assembly line in Vadodara will be operational in November 2024, Jorge Madrid, another senior Airbus official associated with the Indian programme
- In October 2022, Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of the manufacturing facility being set up by the Tata-Airbus consortium at Vadodara.

- Telangana Government and World Economic Forum (WEF) have launched " Saagu Baagu" project Phase-I insights report.
- The report was launched by Telangana Minister for IT and Industries K.T.Rama Rao (KTR) in the presence of Tamil Nadu IT Minister Palanivel Thiagarajan, Telangana Principal Secretary Jayesh Ranjan, Telangana State Agriculture and Cooperation department Secretary M. Raghunandan Rao, State IT Department Director(Emerging Technologies Wing) Rama Devi Lanka, C4IR India, WEF Chief Advisor J. Satyanarayana and World Economic Forum's Centre for the Fourth Industrial Revolution in India Head Purushottam Kaushik.
- The state government plans to scale existing and additional agritech services in phase II (from 2023 onwards) to 20,000 chilli and ground nut farmers in three districts.





- The digital public infrastructure will also be introduced in phase II; in phase III (by 2025), the target is to reach 100,000 farmers in the state
- The project was initiated in 2022 and is being implemented by Digital Green (in consortium with three agritech startups) with support from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
- Currently, more than 7,000 chilli farmers in Khammam district in Telangana have accessed four agritech services, including AI-based advisories, soil testing, produce quality testing and e-commerce - all in the project's pilot phase.





- **AI4AI**, a collaborative initiative of Government of Telangana and WEF is transforming the chilli value chain in Khammam district of Telangana; 7,000 chilli farmers already have access to agritech services, according to a report.
- The Artificial Intelligence for Agriculture Innovation (AI4AI) initiative conceptualized in partnership with World Economic Forum aims to transform the agriculture sector in India by promoting the use of artificial intelligence (AI) and other emerging technologies

- Odisha Cabinet chaired by Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik approved a proposal to extend the Canal Lining and System Rehabilitation Programme (CLSRP) for a further period of five years
- the scheme would be extended from the financial year 2023-24 to 2027-28 with an outlay of Rs 2,032.92 crore.
- The scheme was launched by the government during **2013-14** and got positive responses from the public as the tail end of canals were getting sufficient water
- Under the scheme canal lining of **676.04** km was done in the first phase and 307.03 km was taken up in the second phase






- The cabinet decided to undertake canal lining work of 287.62 km in major and medium irrigation projects, 24.58 km at canal lining work in minor irrigation projects, new lining work of 660.28 km of lining in major and medium irrigation projects and 2995.34 km of canal lining work in minor irrigation projects.
- The scheme will be implemented as Mukhya Mantri canal lining Yojana. It will increase water use efficiently of the canals and stabilization of irrigation potential through improved service delivery in the whole system
- Odisha Cabinet, led by Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik, approved Mission Shakti Scooter Yojana, under which interest subvention on bank loans up to Rs 1 lakh will be provided to beneficiaries to purchase a scooter.





- Around 75,000 SHG community support staff and nearly 1,25,000 SHG federation leaders will be benefited under the new scheme. The State government has made budgetary provision of Rs 528.55 crore for execution of the scheme over a period of next five years
- The Cabinet has approved a budget of Rs 1001.14 crore for expanding
 Comprehensive Cancer Services across the State with an objective to provide cancer care facilities nearer to the household of the patients.
- Odisha cabinet approved a provision of Rs 500 crore for implementation of price support Scheme (PSS)by the state Cooperative Marketing Federation for procurement of oilseeds and pulses on behalf of NAFED.
- the five years scheme from 2023-24 to 2027-28 is introduced with an objective to support more than 1500 of PACS,LAMPS/RMCs/FPOs/ WSHGs reaching around one lakh farmers in next five year to support the beneficiaries and will prevent distress sale.

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
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
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
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
