- The Indian women's compound team of Jyothi Surekha Vennam, Parneet Kaur and Aditi Gopichand Swami won the gold medal at the World Archery Championships 2023 in Berlin, Germany
- It was India's first-ever gold at the archery world championships in any category.
- The Indian trio defeated the Mexican team of Dafne
 Quintero, Ana Sofía Hernandez Jeon and Andrea Becerra
 235-229 in the gold medal match to claim top podium.
- Heading into the Berlin meet, India had won 11 medals nine silvers and two bronze - at the World Archery Championships.

- England batsman Alex Hales has announced his retirement from international cricket at the age of 34

- Hales, aged 34, was one of the leading figures of England's change in approach to white ball cricket under Eoin Morgan after the 2015 World Cup.
- He was also a key figure in them winning the 2022 T20
 World Cup
- Hales last played an ODI match in March 2019

- Teen chess champion **Gukesh D** ended Grandmaster **Viswanathan** Anand's 37-year reign as India's highest-ranking chess player in the live world (FIDE) rankings
- The 17-year-old defeated **Mistradin Iskandarov** in the second round of the FIDE World Cup in Baku, Azerbaijan, and scored a live rating of 2755.9, while Anand's rating was at 2754.0.
- With this, Gukesh replaced his idol to move up to World No. 9 in the classic open category, while the five-time World Champion slipped to the 10th spot.
- Anand, who first made it to the World's top 10 in July 1991, has remained India's top-ranked player in all published lists since January 1987.
- He only dropped to second place in the live world rankings twice since 1986.

- Former Telecom Secretary and Central Vigilance
 Commissioner (CVC) N Vittal passed away
- He was Padma Bhushan awardee(2012) and IAS officer of the Gujarat cadre, 1960 batch
- N Vittal has an impressive career history, serving in various high-ranking positions in the Indian government.
- He held the position of Additional Chief Secretary (Home) in the Government of Gujarat and later became the Additional Secretary in the Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India.
- Subsequently, he took on the role of Secretary in the Department of Electronics, also in the Government of India.



OBITUARY



- Continuing his ascent, N Vittal became the Chairman of the Telecom Commission and served as the Secretary in the Department of Telecommunication within the Government of India.
- Later in his career, he was appointed Chairman of the Public Enterprises Selection Board. His final and most notable appointment before retirement was as the Central Vigilance Commissioner.
- He initiated policies for boosting software, setting up software technology parks and strategic alliance with the industry. This eventually led to the formation of the Software Technology Parks of India (STPI).
- He also initiated the process of liberalisation in the telecom sector and played a major role in getting the National Telecom Policy 1994 approved.

- Earlier, Rs 117.15 crore had been sanctioned for the construction of 104 veterinary hospitals and 431 sub-centres in all districts of the state

- After Sebi's recent tightening of norms, PMS players are required to conduct a performance audit annually and submit a report within 60 days after the end of a financial year.
- This performance audit needs to consider all clients' portfolios managed by the PMS.
- However, performance of advisory clients can be excluded only if it is not published in any marketing material or website.
- The standard specified by APMI will be effective from October 1





- The National Health Authority (NHA) has extended its digital health incentives scheme (DHIS) under the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) till 31 December 2023
- Launched on 1 January 2023, DHIS provides financial incentives to hospitals, diagnostic labs, and digital health solution providers who contribute to the transformational digitization efforts under the ABDM initiative.
- The scheme has significantly spurred the adoption of digital health technologies and practices across the nation
- Its extension comes in response to positive feedback from health providers and tech companies, allowing more stakeholders to benefit from the scheme's financial incentives.





Explanation

- The DHIS enables eligible health facilities and digital solutions companies to earn up to ₹4 crore in incentives, determined by the number of digital health records linked to patients' Ayushman Bharat Health Account numbers.
- This incentive can be availed by the health facilities (hospitals, diagnostic labs) and Digital Solution Companies, registered with ABDM's Health Facility Registry (HFR) and fulfilling the eligibility criterion specified under the scheme.
- It is anticipated that the DHIS advantages offered to the DSCs will contribute to cost reduction or will be transmitted further to the relevant healthcare facilities to pay their digitization costs, etc.

- The two-day event that coincided with the 3rd anniversary of the National Education Policy 2020 was inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.












Explanation

- The extension applies to both Small Scale Industries (SSI) and non-SSI manufactured drugs.
- This move follows a series of notifications intended to establish a procedural framework for implementing the Track and Trace system for drug formulation export consignments.
- The Track and Trace system, which involves maintaining a Parent-Child relationship at packaging levels and uploading data onto the Central Portal, is a critical measure for increasing transparency in the pharmaceutical supply chain.
- It allows for tracking the movement of drug consignments through various stages of packaging and distribution.
