- August 11 has been officially designated World Steelpan Day.
- The United Nations made the declaration at the 77th Session of the United Nations General Assembly in New York.
- Introducing the resolution for determining World Steelpan Day before the General Assembly, Randall Mitchell, Trinidad and Tobago's Minister of Tourism, Culture and the Arts, said the steelpan represents much more than musical versatility to the people of T&T where it was born.
- Stating that In 2019, Port of Spain, the capital city of Trinidad and Tobago, was designated as a UNESCO Creative City of Music for its creativity through the Steelpan as a strategic component for sustainable urban development

- The draft resolution received co-sponsorship from 84 member states of the General Assembly.

OBITUARY



- Renowned nuclear physicist Bikash Sinha died in Kolkata
- A recipient of Padma Shri in 2001 and Padma Bhusan in 2010
- Sinha specialized in nuclear physics, high energy physics, Quark Gluon Plasma and early universe cosmology.
- He led the Indian team for the first time to participate in the experiments at the European Organization for Nuclear Research in Geneva.
- Sinha was the director of the Variable Energy Cyclotron Centre and the Saha Institute of Nuclear Physics and a fellow of the Indian National Science Academy.
- Sinha had lived in England for around 12 years and after coming back to India he joined the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre in 1976.



OBITUARY



- In 1987 he was appointed the director of the Variable Energy Cyclotron Centre. He held the concurrent charge as director of the Saha Institute of Nuclear Physics till 2009.
- He was conferred by the West Bengal government the state's highest award 'Bangabibhushan' in 2022 and also the 'Rabindra Smriti Puraskar' in the same year

- The **Reserve Bank** has imposed monetary penalties on four co-operative banks—one from Bihar and three others from Maharashtra—for deficiencies in regulatory compliance.
- These banks are Tapindu Urban Co-operative Bank Limited, Islampur Urban Cooperative Bank Limited, Mahabaleshwar Urban Co-operative Bank Limited, and Mangal **Co-operative Bank Limited.**
- The Reserve Bank imposed a monetary penalty of ₹1,00,000 on The Tapindu Urban Cooperative Bank Limited, Patna for non-compliance with the directions issued by RBI on 'Exposure Norms and Statutory / Other Restrictions – UCBs'.
- The Islampur Urban Co-operative Bank Limited, Maharashtra was penalised of ₹2.00 lakh for non-compliance with certain provisions the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 and certain provisions of the 'Reserve Bank of India (Know Your Customer (KYC)) Directions, 2016' and 'Maintenance of Deposit Accounts-UCBs'.





- The bank had not transferred the eligible amount to Depositor Education and Awareness Fund (DEAF) and had not conducted periodic review of risk categorisation of its customers as well as annual review of inoperative accounts.
- The Mahabaleshwar Urban Co-operative Bank Limited, Maharashtra was also penalised of ₹2.00 lakh for non-compliance for contravention of certain provisions Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (BR Act), specific directions issued by RBI under Supervisory Action Framework (SAF), and directions issued by RBI on 'Maintenance of Deposit Accounts' and 'Know Your Customer (KYC)'.
- The Co-operative bank had granted interest relief in a loan account of its ex-director, sanctioned fresh loans and renewed CC limits of its borrowers despite SAF restrictions and had not conducted annual review of inoperative accounts and periodic review of risk categorisation of its customers.





- The apex bank imposed a monetary penalty of ₹1.00 lakh (Rupees One lakh only) on Mangal Co-operative Bank Limited, Mumbai (the bank) for non-compliance with the directions issued by RBI on 'Maintenance of Deposit Accounts' and 'Know Your Customer (KYC)'.
- The bank had not conducted annual review of inoperative accounts and periodic review of risk categorisation of its existing customers.





- Raman Sukumar, an authority on the Asian elephant, has been elected a vice-chair of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) during the recent election held at the United Nations Environment Programme headquarters in Nairobi from July 25-28, 2023.
- Sukumar was elected as a member of the Working Group II Vice-Chairs. He is now part of the new IPCC Bureau comprising 34 members, including the new IPCC Chair and three Vice-Chairs.
- The Panel also elected the 12 members of the Task Force Bureau on National Greenhouse Gas Inventories (TFI).
- Mazhar Hayat of Pakistan was elected as a co-chair of the same.



- He became a member of the Project Elephant Steering Committee, which provided technical support and advice on matters of elephant conservation to the Indian government in 1993.
- Sukumar chaired the Asian Elephant Specialist Group of the World Conservation Union from 1997 to 2004. He also served as director of the Asian Elephant Research and Conservation Centre, a special division of the Asian Nature Conservation Foundation, an independent organisation that he had helped to establish in 1997.
- Sukumar has been awarded the Presidential Award of the Chicago Zoological Society in 1989, the Order of the Golden Ark in 1997, the Whitley Gold Award in 2003 and with the International Cosmos Prize in 2006.

- A lightweight autonomous underwater vehicle (AUV) used in mine countermeasure operations by armed forces was launched at the Garden Reach Shipyard in Kolkata
- Developed by Kolkata-based Defence PSU Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE) Ltd in collaboration with M/s Aerospace Engineering Private Ltd. (AEPL) in Tamil Nadu, the man-portable AUV is 2.15m long, has an endurance of nearly 4 hours, and is capable of operating up to a depth of 300m.
- These AUVs make excellent reusable targets during Anti-Submarine
 Warfare (ASW) practices by warships and can also be deployed for passive
 acoustic monitoring during which they could remain in position for
 prolonged durations, monitoring the possible movement of sub-surface
 platforms.





Explanation

Named "Neerakshi" meaning "Eyes in the Water", the AUV was launched by Samir V Kamat, Secretary, Defence Research & Development (DR&D) and Chairman, Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO). Cmde PR Hari IN (Retd.), Chairman and Managing Director, GRSE, and other Senior officials of Indian Armed Forces, GRSE and AEPL were present on the occasion.

- SpaceX launched a new batch of Starlink satellites to low-Earth orbit.
- The Falcon 9 launch vehicle carrying 22 Starlink internet satellites lifted off from Space Launch Complex 40 (SLC-40) at Cape Canaveral Space Force Station in Florida.
- Falcon 9's first stage landed on the Just Read the Instructions droneship stationed in the Atlantic Ocean.
- This was the ninth flight for the first stage booster supporting this mission, which previously launched CRS-24, Eutelsat HOTBIRD 13F, OneWeb 1, SES-18 and SES-19, and four Starlink missions.

- The Russian space agency, Roscomos, launched the Luna-25 lander aboard a Soyuz 2.1b rocket that blasted off from the launch pad at the Vostochny Cosmodrome
- The country successfully launched its first lunar lander in 47 years, marking a significant milestone in its space program.
- The spacecraft lifted off from the Vostochny Cosmodrome in Amur Oblast and is expected to reach lunar orbit by August 16 and make a landing on the Moon's surface on August 21-22.
- The primary objective of Luna-25 is to collect samples of moon rock and dust. These samples are crucial for understanding the lunar environment before any potential base construction.





- Luna-25 is the first Russian Moon mission in nearly five decades. Russia launched its last Moon mission in 1976.
- India's Chandrayaan-3, which blasted off into space on July 14, is also aiming to be the first spacecraft to land on the Lunar South Pole with expected landing on August 23-24.
 - The spacecraft, roughly the size of a small car, will operate for a year on the moon's south pole. Scientists have detected traces of water ice in the region's shadowed craters, making it a prime location for future lunar bases.

- The ADeX and ADMF (Agriculture Data Management Framework), which governs how the data should be managed, were formally launched by Telangana IT and Industries Minister K T Rama Rao





- The exchange is an open source, open standard and interoperable public good, democratising access to data and enabling the public and private sector to build applications and deliver services to benefit society.
- The software platform facilitates the secure, standards-based exchange of data between agricultural data users and agricultural data providers.
- In Phase-I of the project, the ADeX Platform has been deployed in Khammam district, and over a period, will be expanded to the entire State.
