







International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition

- Between 2016 and 2019, Alex Hartley took part in 28 50-over matches and four T20Is and clinched the 2017 ODI World Cup















- Indian wrestlers finished their campaign at the World Under-20 Wrestling Championships 2023 with with 14 medals - four gold, three silver and seven bronze.






- The implementation of this MoU will enhance bilateral maritime cooperation between the two nations for ensuring safe, secure and clean seas in the region.










- The BRICS nations, Brazil, Russia, India, and China, are planning to launch a new university ranking system.

- This initiative was prompted by a joint consensus among departmental leaders who acknowledged the limitations of current rating methodologies.
















- Tejas, Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) LSP-7 successfully fired the ASTRA indigenous Beyond Visual Range (BVR) air-to-air missile off the coast of Goa
- The missile release was successfully carried out from the aircraft at an altitude of about 20,000 ft.
- All the objectives of the test were met and it was a perfect text book launch.
- The test launch was monitored by the Test Director and scientists of Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA), Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) along with officials from Centre for Military Airworthiness and Certification (CEMILAC) and Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality Assurance (DG-AQA).











- The aircraft was also monitored by a Chase Tejas twin seater aircraft.
- ASTRA, a state-of-the-art BVR air-to-air missile to engage and destroy highly maneuvering supersonic aerial targets, is designed and developed by Defence Research and Development Laboratory (DRDL), Research Centre Imarat (RCI) and other laboratories of DRDO. The indigenous Astra BVR firing from home grown Tejas fighter is a major step towards 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat'.

- The National Health Authority (NHA) had announced 100 Microsites project for accelerated adoption of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) across the country.
- **Mizoram** becomes the first state in India to operationalize an ABDM Microsite in its capital city Aizawl.
- Under this, all healthcare facilities including the private clinics, small hospitals and labs in the region shall be made ABDM-enabled and will offer digital health services to the patients.
- The ABDM Microsites are defined geographical regions where focused outreach efforts would be made to onboard small and medium scale private healthcare providers.











- These Microsites would be majorly implemented by State Mission Directors of ABDM while the financial resources and overall guidance would be provided by NHA.
- An interfacing agency under this program will have an on-ground team to reach out to the healthcare providers in the area.
- This team will spread awareness about the benefits of ABDM and will help the service providers to join the core registries under ABDM besides promoting the use of ABDM enable digital solutions for regular clinical documentation.
- NHA had previously overseen Microsites pilots in Mumbai, Ahmedabad and Surat.
- The learnings and experiences from these pilots have been incorporated in the overall structure of 100 Microsites project under ABDM.
- Besides Mizoram, other states including Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh have also made significant progress regarding implementation of ABDM Microsites.










- Seventy-eight per cent parents of girls in rural areas want to educate their children to graduation and above and 82 per cent parents of boys in rural areas want to educate their children, as per a report that was launched by the Union Minister for Education, Dharmendra Pradhan
- The first 'State of Elementary Education in Rural India' report is based on data accumulated from 6,229 rural households across 20 states.
- The study was focused on children in rural communities between the age of **6 to 16 years.**
- Out of the 6,229 rural households surveyed, 6,135 had school-going students, 56 had students who dropped out of school and 38 had children who had never enrolled in school










- According to the survey, one-fourth of male children dropped out of school during primary schooling. The dropout rate at this stage was higher for female children at nearly 35 per cent. Nearly 75 per cent boys and 65 per cent girls dropped out of school after completing primary school education.
- The main reason for this can be non-availability of schools with higher classes within the village or nearby villages.
- According to the report, 40 per cent of parents said that they have age-appropriate reading material other than school books available at home
- A total of 64.2 per cent of the children were under the supervision of their mothers when it came to studies while 50.2 per cent were supervised by their fathers, 25.6 per cent students study under the supervision of elder sibling, 3.8 per cent under the guidance of Anganwadi workers and 7.6 per cent are taught by community teachers. Over 38 per cent of parents opt for private tutors. And, 26.7 per cent children study under the supervision of private tutors.






 About 84 per cent of parents stated that they regularly attended parent-teacher meetings. A total of 73 change vectors from Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand were interviewed to understand the community aspects and out of them, 93.4 per cent said that parents regularly attend parent-teacher meetings in their village






