OBITUARY



- Calyampudi Radhakrishna Rao, the renowned mathematician and statistician, passed away
- Popularly known as CR Rao, the man had many titles, be it 'Legendary Mathematician', 'Statistics Professor' and 'Statistician'.
- At the beginning of 2023, he was awarded the International Prize in Statistics, equivalent to the Nobel Prize in this field.
- He was also awarded the Padmabhushan in 1968,
 Padma Vibhushan in 2001 and SS Bhatnagar Award.
- He also received the Wilks Medal of the American Statistical Association in 1979 and the US National Medal of Science in 2002.



OBITUARY



- Dr. Rao was also a member of several government committees for the development of national statistical systems, statistical education and research in India.
- He served as chairman of the Committee on Statistics (1962-69), chairman of the Demographic and Communication for Population Control (1968-69), chairman of the Committee on Mathematics, Atomic Energy Commission, AEC (1969-78), member of the Committee on Science and Technology, COST (1969-71).

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has approved the amalgamation of Twin Cities Cooperative Urban Bank Ltd with Kranti Co-operative Urban Bank Ltd
- The scheme of amalgamation will come into force with effect from August 23, 2023
- The RBI further said the branch of Twin Cities Co-operative Urban Bank will function as a branch of Kranti Co-operative Urban Bank with effect from August 23, 2023.
- On March 23, 2021, the central bank issued master direction for amalgamation Urban Cooperative Banks.
- As per the directions, the RBI may consider proposals for merger and amalgamation under three circumstances, including when the net worth of the amalgamated bank (the UCB which proposes to transfer its business to another UCB) is positive and the amalgamating bank (the UCB which is to acquire the business of the amalgamated bank) assures to protect entire deposits of all depositors of the amalgamated bank.







- The Jury members for National Film Awards handed over the list of awardees for feature, non-feature and best script category to Union I&B Minister Anurag Thakur.
- A total of 280 films from 28 languages were submitted for the awards in year 2021. 31 categories in Feature film, 24 in non-feature and 3 in script writing on cinema
- Best feature film award has been given to Rocketry: The Nambi Effect and the Best Non-Feature Film has been bagged by Ek Tha Gaon directed by Srishti Lakhera.
- The **Kashmir Files** has been awarded with **Nargis Dutt Award** for Best Feature Film on National Integration, while RRR has bagged the Award for Best Popular Film Providing Wholesome Entertainment.

- Argentina, Egypt, Ethiopia, Iran, Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates have all been invited to become members of BRICS, said South African President Cyril Ramaphosa, who hosted a three-day summit of the emerging markets group in **Johannesburg**
- Their membership will take effect January 1, 2024.
- Representatives from the BRICS emerging group made up of Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa — gathered in Johannesburg for their 15th summit




- Numaligarh Refinery Ltd (NRL) and Inland Waterways Authority of India signed a pact to use National Waterways-2 (Brahmaputra) and Indo Bangladesh Protocol Route (IBPR) for export of petroleum products to Bangladesh and other southeast Asian countries
- Under the MoU, NRL will export approximately 10,000 metric tons of petroleum and petrochemical products per month from the IWAI Jogighopa Multi Modal terminal.
- Additionally, NRL will establish a POL Oil Terminal at the Jogighopa Logistics Park with rail connectivity, further strengthening the region's transportation infrastructure
- The primary goal of this MoU is to fulfill the 'Hydrocarbon Vision 2030 for Northeast' by harnessing inland waterways transportation via NW2 and IBPR, ushering in a new era of export-import trade for the Northeastern region
- The MoU was signed by NRL's chief general manager (Marketing) Subrata Das and IWAI director A Selva Kumar in the presence of Union Shipping Minister Sarbananda Sonowal and Union Minister of State for Petroleum and Natural Gas Rameshwar Teli.





- NRL is currently executing the Numaligarh Refinery Expansion Project (NREP), a refinery
 expansion cum modernisation project with a capex of ₹28,026 crore.
- This project will significantly contribute to the region's growth, and NRL has already transported five over dimension consignments/overweight consignments (ODC/OWC) via the IBPR and NW2.
- The weight of cargo transported so far amounts to approximately 4,500 metric tonne, demonstrating the efficiency and cost-effectiveness of waterway transport.




- A **Defence Acquisition Council (DAC)** meeting, held under the chairmanship of **Raksha** Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh, accorded Acceptance of Necessity (AoN) for capital acquisition proposals worth approximately Rs 7,800 crore
- To enhance the efficiency of the Indian Air Force, the DAC has granted AoN for procurement and installation of Electronic Warfare (EW) Suite on Mi-17 V5 Helicopters under Buy (Indian-IDDM) category which will enhance better survivability of Helicopters.
- The EW Suite will be procured from Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL).
- The DAC has also accorded **AoN** for procurement of Ground-Based Autonomous System for mechanised infantry and armoured regiments which will enable various operations like unmanned surveillance, logistic delivery of ammunition, fuel & spares and casualty evacuation in the battle field.





- Proposals for procurement of 7.62x51 mm Light Machine Gun (LMG) and Bridge Laying Tank (BLT) have also been given go ahead by the DAC. While induction of LMG will enhance fighting capabilities of infantry forces, the induction of BLT will result in faster movement of Mechanised Forces.
- The AoN for procurement of Ruggedised Laptops and Tablets for the Indian Army under Project Shakti has also been accorded. All these procurements will be sourced from Indigenous vendors only.
- To enhance the operational capability of the MH-60R Helicopters of the Indian Navy, the DAC has accorded AoN for procurement of weapons for the same.

- Taking one more step towards clean and green energy, NHPC Limited, India's premier hydropower company, has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with **Andhra Pradesh** Power Generation Corporation (APGENCO) Limited (an undertaking of the Government of Andhra Pradesh) for implementation of Pumped Hydro Storage Projects and Renewable Energy Projects in the state of Andhra Pradesh.
- In the first phase, the MoU envisages implementation of two identified Pumped Hydro Storage Projects of total capacity 1,950 MW.
- These projects are Kamlapadu (950 MW) and Yaganti (1,000 MW).
- The implementation of these projects is expected to create significant employment opportunities and boost the local economy in the region. The projects will be implemented under Joint Venture mode.





- The MoU was signed in Tadepalli, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh on 23rd August, 2023, in the presence of Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Shri Y. S. Jagan Mohan Reddy.
- The agreement was signed by Director (Finance), NHPC, Shri R.P. Goyal and Managing Director, APGENCO, Shri K. V. N. Chakradhar Babu, in the presence of other officers of both organizations.
- NHPC Limited is India's premier Hydropower Company. NHPC's total installed capacity is 7,097.2 MW of renewable power (including Wind & Solar), through its 25 power stations including 1,520 MW through subsidiaries.

- Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways is committed towards developing the best infrastructure at the ports for increasing the economic growth of the country.
- Deendayal Port Authority (DPA), a leading Major Port on the West Coast of India in Gujarat, is signing a concession agreement for the development, operation and maintenance of a new mega container terminal at Tuna-Tekra, Gujarat (near Kandla) with DP World, a multinational logistics company based in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.
- The concession agreement will be signed between Deendayal Port Authority and DP World in the august presence of Shri Sarbananda Sonowal, Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways and AYUSH, and H.E. Sultan Ahmed Bin Sulayem, Group Chairman and CEO of DP World at Tactic 1&2, Aloft Hotel Aerocity, New Delhi.
- Shri Shantanu Thakur, Minister of State for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, and other dignitaries will also be present during the signing.





- The project involves construction of a mega-container terminal at Tuna-Tekra near Kandla, at a cost of Rs 4,243.64 crore through Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode.
- Once complete, the terminal will have annual capacity to handle 2.19 million container units (TEUs) with capability to handle next-generation vessels carrying more than 18,000 TEUs.
- The 30-year PPP project agreement with an SPV of Hindustan Infralog Private Limited (a
 JV of DP World and National Investment and Infrastructure Fund (NIIF)), is on BuildOperate-Transfer (BOT) basis, extendable upto 50 years.
- The container terminal will be fully compliant with the green port guidelines ensuring sustainability in port operations by adopting best practices of port environment management contributing towards the long-term sustainability goals set out by the Government of India
- The project is part of the National Infrastructure Pipeline and will complement initiatives of the Government of India envisioned by the Prime Minister, such as the PM Gati Shakti Master Plan and National Logistics Policy.





- Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel launched the Panchayati Raj Accounting Information
 System Automation, or PRAISA, at a state-level programme of 'Meri Mati Mera Desh' in
 Gandhinagar.
- PRAISA will make the administration of the state Panchayats Department paperless and more effective as financial and accounting transactions of all the 33 districts and 248 taluka panchayats will be handled through this online platform
- Financial transactions worth Rs 34,000 crore of these Panchayati Raj institutions, local selfgoverned bodies, will be handled in a transparent manner through PRAISA. Various processes, including issuance of work orders, payment to vendors or contractors and maintenance of accounts, will be handled using this online platform
- This online application's dashboard also allows real-time monitoring of any panchayat's transactions at taluka, district and state level

- India got its 54th tiger reserve in Rajasthan's Karauli and Dholpur districts with the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) approving a proposal in this regard.
- This is Rajasthan's fifth tiger reserve after Ranthambore, Sariska, Mukundra Hills and Ramgarh Vishdhari.
- With a 50 per cent increase in the last four years, Madhya Pradesh has the maximum number of tigers in the country (785), followed by Karnataka (563), Uttarakhand (560), and Maharashtra (444).
- The number of tigers in Rajasthan has increased from 32 in 2006 to 88 in 2022
- The Government of India began the conservation of the national animal, tiger, by introducing "Project Tiger" in 1973.





- Since its inception, Project Tiger has expanded its coverage to 53 tiger reserves across 18
 of our tiger range states covering a total area of 75,796.83 sq km.
- This equates to approximately 2.3 per cent of India's geographical area.
- As per the recent report on "Status of Tigers 2022" released by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in April, the minimum number of tigers has increased to 3,167
