


Explanation

- Every year on **August 26**, the world observes **Women's Equality Day**.
- This year's Women's Equality Day theme is **Embrace Equity**.

History:

- The 50th anniversary of the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution, which guaranteed full woman suffrage, was August 26, 1970.
- On that anniversary, the National Organisation forWomen (NOW) urged women to participate in a statewide "strike for equality."
- More than 100,000 other women marched and demonstrated in more than 90 major cities and towns around the country, making the strike the greatest gender-equality protest in US history.
- Eventually, Women's Equality Day was established by Congress in 1971 to remember not only the passage of the Nineteenth Amendment but also the ongoing efforts of women to attain full equality.



Important Days



International Dog Day

- It is celebrated every year on August 26 in several countries.
- This day aims to recognise the important role that a dog plays in our lives.
- International Dog Day has been observed since **2004**, when a pet lover, Colleen Paige, celebrated the day as a way to raise awareness about dog shelters.

- The visually challenged Indian women's cricket team scripted history winning a gold medal beating Australia by nine wickets at the IBSA World Games
- The Games, due to take place from **18-27 August** 2023, will be held at the University of Birmingham, across the Edgbaston area and wider region.
- The first event took place at Madrid, Spain in 1998
- This year is **7th edition**





Which medal did Indian badminton player HS Prannoy win in the men's singles at the BWF World Badminton Championships 2023?

- Indian badminton player **HS Prannoy** finished with a bronze medal in the men's singles at the BWF World Badminton Championships 2023 after losing his semi-final match in Copenhagen, Denmark
- World No. 9 HS Prannoy lost 21-18, 13-21, 14-21 to Thailand's Kunlavut Vitidsarn
- HS Prannoy became only the fifth Indian men's singles player to win a medal at the BWF World Badminton Championships.
- Kidambi Srikanth remains the only Indian to reach the men's singles final (2021) of the global showpiece event.
- This is India's 14th medal at the World Championships. This includes one gold, four silvers and nine bronze medals.
- **China** is the most successful team in the tournament's history, with 196 medals, including 69 gold, 48 silver and 79 silvers.
- Prakash Padukone is the first-ever Indian to have won an individual medal at the World Championships. He clinched a bronze medal in 1983 in men's singles.





- After 28 years, Jwala and Ashwini brought back home a World Championship medal, clinching a bronze in the 2011 championships in women's doubles.
- PV Sindhu, India's two-time Olympic medalist, is the first-ever Indian player to secure a women's singles medal at the World Championships. After bronze medals in 2013 and 2014 and silver in 2017 and 2018, she reached the pinnacle in 2019, becoming the only Indian badminton world champion in all categories to date.
- Indian tennis great Saina Nehwal has two World Championships medals to her name in the women's singles category, a silver in 2015 and a bronze in 2017.
- Sai Praneeth won a bronze for India in the men's singles competition in the 2019 edition of the Championships.
- The former world number one Kidambi Srikanth secured a silver medal in the 2021 Championships in men's singles.





- In the 2021 World Championships, Lakshya Sen secured a bronze medal in the men's singles competition.
- Last year, India's current world number two ranked men's doubles pair of Satwiksairaj
 Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty made history, becoming the first-ever men's pair from India to secure a medal at a World Championships, with a bronze medal.

- IDFC First Bank has won the title sponsorship rights for all BCCI matches for domestic and international cricket for the next three years for ₹4.2 crore per match
- The Board of Control for Cricket in India had issued its invitation to tender for the rights earlier this month after **Mastercard** Inc. exited in **March as title sponsor for team India.**
- The base price was kept at ₹2.4 crore per match. The only other bidder was OTT service
 SonyLIV, which bid for ₹2.7 crore per match
- The agreement will cover 56 matches over three years, including 15 ODIs, an equal number of test matches and another 26 T20 matches.
- IDFC First Bank will be the title sponsor for international matches (both women and men), domestic cricket matches like Irani Trophy, Duleep Trophy and Ranji Trophy organized by BCCI and also all junior cricket (Under 19 and Under 23) matches held in India.
- The partnership will begin with the 3-match ODI series against Australia beginning next month



- In September 2022, Mastercard temporarily took over from Paytm, which had signed a deal with BCCI for ₹326.80 crore in 2019.
- Paytm was to fork out ₹3.8 crore per match, about 58% above the earlier ₹2.4 crore deal, but in July 2022, it requested BCCI to assign the rights to Mastercard till March 2023. But MasterCard didn't renew the deal after March.

- According to the data, FDI dipped from countries including Mauritius, Singapore, the US and the UAE during April-June 2023-24.
- Inflows dipped in segments including computer hardware and software, trading, automobile and pharma.

- Indore has been adjudged the best Smart City while Madhya Pradesh has been chosen as the top State for exemplary performance in the Smart Cities Mission.
- Surat and Agra are the second and third-place winners among cities, while Tamil Nadu is the second in the State category followed by Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh shared third prize in the India Smart Cities Award Contest (ISAC), 2022.
- In October last year, Indore was adjudged India's cleanest city for the sixth time in a row.
- Madhya Pradesh, too, won the tag of the cleanest state in the Swachh Survekshan 2022
- In the Smart Cities awards, Indore had shared the first place with Surat last time.
- The award for the best Union Territory has gone to Chandigarh.
- In the Smart Cities Awards 2022, Coimbatore's project of model roads, restoration and renovation of lakes was ranked the best in the category of built environment, while Jabalpur won the award for its incubation centre in the economy category.
- Chandigarh's public bike sharing and e-governance services won in the mobility and governance categories





- The ISAC awards for 2022, organised under the Smart Cities Mission, by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs were announced
- President Droupadi Murmu will give away the awards on September 27 at Indore in Madhya Pradesh.
- This is the **fourth edition of the ISAC awards**.
- In the past, the ISAC witnessed three editions in 2018, 2019 and 2020. The 2022 edition was launched in April last year during the 'Smart Cities-Smart Urbanization' event in Surat.
- There were no awards in 2021 because of the Covid-19 pandemic.
- The ISAC recognises and rewards cities, projects and innovative ideas that are promoting sustainable development across the 100 smart cities, as well as stimulating inclusive, equitable, safe, healthy and collaborative cities leading to a better quality of life for all.
- The ISAC 2022 award had a two-stage submission process consisting of 'Qualifying Stage', which involved overall assessment of the city's performance, and the 'Proposal Stage' which required the smart cities to submit their nominations for six award categories.





Explanation

- A total of 845 nominations were received for ISAC 2022 from 80 qualifying smart cities out of which 66 final winners have been identified in various categories.
- Smart Cities Mission launched on June 25, 2015, aims to provide core infrastructure, clean and sustainable environment and a decent quality of life to their citizens through the application of "smart solutions".
- the 100 selected cities have completed 76% of the proposed projects worth Rs.1.10 lakh crore, while the remaining projects worth Rs.60,095 crore "will be completed by 30 June 2024

- A SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket launched the Dragon spacecraft into orbit carrying NASA astronaut Jasmin Moghbeli, ESA (European Space Agency) astronaut Andreas Mogensen, JAXA (Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency) astronaut Satoshi Furukawa, and Roscosmos cosmonaut Konstantin Borisov, for a science expedition aboard the orbital laboratory.






Explanation

- The Indian Air Force (IAF) deployed five MiG-29 combat jets, six transport aircraft and a group of its special forces personnel at a 21-day multilateral war game in Egypt
- The biennial tri-services exercise, Bright-Star, is taking place at **Cairo (West) Air Base** and it is being participated by militaries of the US, Saudi Arabia, Greece and Qatar besides of the host country and India
- It is for the first time that the IAF is participating in the exercise
- The IAF contingent will consist of five MiG-29, two IL-78, two C-130 and two C-17 aircraft.
 Personnel from the IAF's Garud special forces, as well as those from the Numbers 28, 77, 78 and 81 squadrons will be participating in the exercise
- Around 150 personnel from the Indian Army are also part of the Indian contingent

- The defence and strategic cooperation between India and Egypt has been on an upswing in the last few years.



- Delhi Environment and Forest Minister Gopal Rai launched a portal to enhance public awareness about the forest and wildlife sanctuary areas that need protection.
- The portal, **evanlekh.eforest.delhi.gov.in**, introduces several features that empower citizens and streamline information dissemination.
- It utilises a geographic information system (GIS) platform to visualize data effectively, aiming to enhance the ease of doing business and living in Delhi.
- Also, users can generate KML files on the portal.
- It currently provides information on various aspects, including protected forest areas, reserve forest areas, morphological details, wildlife sanctuaries, buffer areas of wildlife sanctuaries, and administrative boundaries of the Department of Forest and Wildlife.





Explanation

- Looking ahead, the portal's future enhancements will include unclassified forest areas, areas with tree felling permissions, areas targeted for compensatory plantation and afforestation, plantation sites by greening agencies, locations requiring approvals for non-forestry activities, soil moisture conservation details, and Indian State of Forest Report-based green cover information.
