- Dennis Austin, who co-created the PowerPoint software almost 36 years ago which
 is still being used by millions, has passed away
- Released in 1987 by software firm Forethought, PowerPoint was the digital successor to overhead projectors, "transforming the labour-intensive process of creating slides".
- The company released the software in 1987, and Microsoft bought the company just a few months later for \$14 million.
- By 1993, PowerPoint was generating more than \$100 million in sales. Microsoft integrated PowerPoint to its suite of Office products, including Word.
- Austin served as PowerPoint's primary developer from 1985 to 1996 when he retired.
- After Microsoft acquired Forethought, Austin continued to lead development of PowerPoint.
- He retired in 1996.

- India's best performance came in the 'Movers' category, in which countries are ranked based on their future growth potential, including how prepared it is to weather challenges posed by the global economy.
- India was ranked 5th on the list below UAE, Qatar, Egypt, and Saudi Arabia.
- In terms of culture and heritage, India was ranked 8th.
- Among the most powerful countries, India was ranked 12th.
- The annual ranking by the US News & World Report ranks countries based on various attributes grouped into 10 thematic sub-rankings that rolled into the Best Countries rankings: Adventure, Agility, Cultural Influence, Entrepreneurship, Heritage, Movers, Open for Business, Power, Quality of Life and Social Purpose.





- Google Cloud is partnering with CERT-In within the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), in the area of Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Cybersecurity. This collaboration marks a significant step towards advancing the cybersecurity skills of learners and government officials.
- The partnership between CERT-In (Indian Computer Emergency Response Team) and Google Cloud will significantly ramp up cybersecurity training and skilling through various initiatives.
- This includes training a 'cyber force' of 1,000 government officials in cyber defence best practices.
- The initiatives also involve using generative AI and conducting cybersecurity AI
 hackathons led by front-line experts from Google Cloud and Mandiant.
- Google will also provide 100,000 new scholarships for Google Cybersecurity Certificates to learners in the community.

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- Built and taught by experts at Google, the Cybersecurity Certificate will equip people with in-demand skills needed for jobs in cybersecurity.
- Google Cloud is also collaborating with ONDC (Open Network for Digital Commerce) to drive innovation across the e-commerce industry in India at scale.
- This includes a new India-wide hackathon and an extension of their existing ONDC initiative.
- ONDC is the Indian government's marquee initiative to increase the penetration
 of e-commerce in India currently limited to about 10 per cent of all
 commerce in the country by bringing millions of last-mile stores into ecommerce on the open network.
- ONDC and Google Cloud will launch an India-wide hackathon aimed at catalysing innovation and addressing critical challenges for the next billion digital users in the country.





- The hackathon intends to develop solutions that democratise access to digital commerce, regardless of digital literacy, geography, or economic status.
- The event also aims to foster an open ecosystem of developers, students, and startups to innovate within the ONDC framework.
- Google Cloud has also expanded its partnership with Apollo Hospitals to build a digital platform, Apollo 24|7. - IDFC First Bank said Rajiv Jain's GQG Partners has acquired 5,07,39,653 shares of the bank from MD & CEO V Vaidyanathan in a block trade transaction
- The sale net of STT and other brokerage charges of Rs 478.70 crore
- Vaidyanathan would utilise Rs 229 crore as payment to IDFC First Bank to subscribe to new shares, Rs 240.5 crore for payment of income tax for exercising the stock options, and Rs 9.2 crore will be contributed to precommitted causes.
- After the execution of the deal, Vaidyanathan's stake in the bank would increase to 1.04 per cent from the existing 0.58 per cent as of June 30, 2023.
- Further, including options yet to be converted, his shareholding will be 1.23
 per cent of the total share capital of the bank.





- Capital First, which was a non-banking finance company and was merged with the then IDFC Bank, had originally granted CMD stock options to Vaidyanathan.
- After the merger of Capital First in December 2018, these stock options were converted to IDFC FIRST Bank stock options.
- Earlier on September 1, bulk deals data showed that GQG Partners has picked up 17.1 crore shares or 2.58% stake in the lender for about Rs 1,527 crore. The transaction was done at Rs 89 apiece.

- Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IIT Madras) faculty Rajnish Kumar has been recognised with the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize.
- The Prize is bestowed on a person who has made outstanding contributions to human knowledge and progress – fundamental and applied – in a particular field of their specialization.
- The award is being given for his contributions to fundamental understanding of the nucleation and growth of clathrate hydrates, CO2 sequestration in solid hydrates and methane recovery from marine gas hydrates
- The Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize for Science and Technology (SSB) is a science award in India given annually by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) for notable and outstanding research, applied or fundamental, in biology, chemistry, environmental science, engineering, mathematics, medicine, and physics.





- The award, being given since 1985, is named after the Founder Director of the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar.
- He is also a recipient of the NASI-SCOPUS Young Scientist Award for the year 2016
- Ahead of its foundation day, the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) on Monday announced the Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar awards for 2022 to be distributed to 12 young scientists across the country.
- Immunologist Dipyaman Ganguli of CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Biology, Kolkata, astrophysicist Kanak Saha from the Pune-based Inter-University Centre for Astronomy and Astrophysics, Kanishka Biswas from International Centre of Materials Science of the Bengaluru-based Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research were among the awardees.
- The award is given every year to scientists under the age of 45 years and carries a purse of Rs five lakh and a citation.





- Amit Singh, Department of Microbiology and Cell Biology of the Indian Institute of Science and Arun Kumar Shukla Department of Biological Sciences and Bioengineering of Indian Institute of Technology-Kanpur were awarded in the category of Biological Sciences.
- Biswas and T Govindaraju of the Bio-organic Chemistry Laboratory of Jawaharlal Nehru
 Centre for Advanced Scientific Research have been selected for the prestigious prize in the
 Chemical Sciences category.
- In the Earth, Atmosphere, Ocean and Planetary Sciences category, the Prize has been bagged by Binoy Kumar Saikia of the Coal and Energy Research Group of CSIR North East Institute of Science and Technology, Jorhat.
- In the field of Engineering Sciences, Debdeep Mukhopadhyay of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering, Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur has bagged the Prize.
- The prize in the Mathematical Sciences category has gone to Anish Ghosh of Mumbaibased Tata Institute of Fundamental Research and Saket Saurabh of the Institute of Mathematical Sciences, Chennai.





- In the field of Medical Sciences, Dr Jeemon Panniyammakal of the Achutha Menon Centre for Health Science Studies of Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology and Rohit Srivastava of the Department of Biosciences and Bioengineering, Indian Institute of Technology Bombay will receive the Prize.


- According to the MoU, India and Saudi Arabia will cooperate in the following areas:
 - Renewable Energy, Energy Efficiency, Hydrogen, Electricity and Grid Interconnection between the two countries, Petroleum, Natural Gas, Strategic Petroleum Reserves and Energy Security.
 - Encouraging bilateral investment in the field of Renewable Energy, Electricity, Hydrogen and Storage; and Oil & Gas.
 - Circular Economy and its technologies to reduce the effects of climate change, such as: carbon capture, utilization and storage.
 - Promoting digital transformation, innovation and cyber-security and artificial intelligence in the field of Energy.
 - Working on developing qualitative partnerships between the two countries to localize materials, products and services related to all sectors of energy, supply chains and its technologies.
 - Strengthening the cooperation with companies specialized in the field of energy.
 - Any other fields related to the energy field that the two countries agree upon.



- The US International Development Finance Corporation's (DFC) board has approved up to \$425 million in financing in TP Solar for its upcoming greenfield 4.3 gigawatts (GW) solar cell and module manufacturing plant at Tirunelveli (Tamil Nadu).
- TP Solar is a subsidiary of Tata Power Renewable Energy (TPREL) which, in turn, is a Tata Power subsidiary.
- DFC is a US-based development finance institution
- The plant's first module production is expected by the year-end and the first cell production is expected in the first quarter of FY24
- In July 2022, Tata Power signed a MoU with the Tamil Nadu government in which it put the proposed investment in the project at ₹3,000 crore.





Explanation

- the project cost has been revised to ₹4,500 crore, consequent upon the increase in the proposed capacity from 4 GW to 4.3 GW.
- This is the second time that the US International Development Finance Corporation is giving funding for a solar plant in India. In December 2021, First Solar had secured a \$500m funding from the DFC, for is 3.3 GW plant coming up at Sriperumbudur, near Chennai. The plant has just commenced production.
- This financing support will contribute towards securing India's commitment to achieve 500 GW of clean energy targets by 2030.

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





- The Department of Posts has brought out a compilation on the heroic deeds of Alluri and sacrifices of his lieutenants in the form of monograph covering release of all six special covers and narratives from the family members of Alluri and research scholars through the medium of philately.
- Col. V Ramulu, Chief Postmaster General, Andhra Pradesh Postal Circle, M. Venkateswarlu, Retd. PMG, Visakhapatnam, who was instrumental in bringing out the Monograph and other officers were present on the occasion.





- 'Manyam Veerudu' Alluri Sitarama Raju fought against the British forces against atrocities meted out to tribal people. He attacked the police stations at Chintapalli, Krishnadevipeta, Rampachodavaram, Addatigala, Annavaram and Rajavommangi and took away arms and ammunition.
- His unique way of dispatching advance messages to the officials about his intended attack on police stations, through an arrow by tying up message along with bunch of chillies, was popularly called CHILLI POST.
- Rampa Rebellion led by Alluri with the help of tribal people against the British, started in the year 1922 and ended in 1927 with the martyrdom of Alluri. His heroic deeds and patriotism are still remembered by the people of Andhra Pradesh

- The Union Environment Ministry has set up a new Central Empowered Committee (CEC), replacing an ad hoc expert panel with the same name which assisted the Supreme Court in matters of forest and environment issues.
- The CEC, initially established by the apex court in 2002, served as a watchdog for issues pertaining to environmental conservation and compliance.
- Over the years, the committee has played a pivotal role in shaping India's environmental policy and governance landscape.
- While its restructuring aims to make it more efficient, questions remain about its independence under the government's complete control.






- This development comes shortly after the passage of the **Forest Conservation (Amendment) Bill, 2023**, which critics argue weakens existing safeguards in Indian forest law, potentially facilitating construction projects in ecologically sensitive regions.
- The Union government will nominate and appoint members to the new CEC, according to a September 5 notification.
- Under the revamped structure, the CEC will comprise a chairperson, a member secretary and three expert members, all selected by the Union government.
- The chairperson, with a minimum of 25 years of experience in environmental, forestry, or wildlife fields or substantial administrative expertise in government, will serve a maximum term of three years.
- The member secretary must hold a rank not lower than deputy inspector general or director in the government and possess at least 12 years of experience in environmental, forestry, or wildlife matters.
- The three expert members, one each from the environment, forest, and wildlife sectors, should have a minimum of 20 years of expertise.
