









- International Pay Day occurs annually on September 18.

- The Equal Pay International Coalition (EPIC) is led by **the ILO, UN Women, and OECD**.











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World Patient Safety Day 2023

- During the 72nd World Health Assembly that took place at Switzerland's Geneva in May 2019, member states of the WHO recognised the importance of patient safety as a global health priority and a resolution titled "Global Action on Patient Safety" was adopted.
- This resolution emphasised the need to enhance patient safety at the global level and called for the establishment of World Patient Safety Day as an annual observance hence, World Patient Safety Day was officially inaugurated on September 17, 2019 to commemorate the anniversary of the adoption of the resolution on patient safety at the World Health Assembly and September 17th was designated as the annual date for this observance.
- According to the World Health Organization, the theme this year for World Patient Safety Day is "Engaging patients for patient safety"









World Ozone Day or International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer

- World Ozone Day or International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer observed annually on September 16, is meant to raise awareness about the importance of the ozone layer and how its depletion is leading to global warming and climate change across the world
- The day is recognised to commemorate the Montreal Protocol, an environmental agreement that regulates the production and consumption of nearly 100 man-made chemicals referred to as ozone-depleting substances (ODS).
- It was adopted in 1987 and is the only UN treaty that has been ratified by all 198 memberstates.
- In 1994, the UN General Assembly declared September 16 as the International Day for the Prevention of the Ozone Layer.
- The theme of World Ozone Day 2023 is "Montreal Protocol: Fixing the Ozone Layer and Reducing Climate Change."



- Olympic and world champion javelin thrower **Neeraj Chopra** failed to defend his Diamond League champion's title, finishing **second with a modest effort of 83.80m in the grand finale**
- The 25-year-old Chopra, who clinched his maiden World Championships gold last month
- Jakub Vadlejch of Czech Republic became the Diamond League champion for the third time with a best throw of 84.24m which came in his sixth and final attempt. He was leading the six-man field from the beginning following his first round effort of 84.01m.
- Vadlejch, who won bronze in Budapest World Championships in August and silver in Tokyo Olympics behind Chopra, had also clinched the DL title in 2017 and 2018.
- Oliver Helander of Finland took the third spot with a best throw of 83.74m.
- This was the same venue where Chopra had finished second in the 2022 World Championships.










- Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) or e-rupee worth ₹16.39 crore is in circulation as of March 2023, as per data from RBI's Handbook of Statistics on the Indian Economy for FY23.
- Of the total e-rupee circulation, ₹10.69 crore was wholesale CBDC whereas ₹5.70 crore was retail CBDC, data showed.
- E-rupee is the digital representation of India's legal tender and similar to physical currency, is issued in various denominations to banks.
- The circulation was highest for ₹500 CBDC notes at ₹2.71 crore, followed by ₹200 notes at 1.16 per cent. Circulation for all other currency denominations of 50 paise to ₹100 was below 1 per cent, ranging between 0.01-0.83 per cent.
- RBI had introduced the CBDC pilot for the wholesale segment, known as the CBDC (W) or e₹-W, was launched in November 2022, with the use case being limited to settlement of secondary market transactions in government securities. The central bank is now looking to expand the use of the e-rupee to other inter-bank money markets.








- The retail pilot known as CBDC (R) or e₹-R, was launched a month later in December 2022, within a closed user group comprising participating customers, banks and merchants.
 Initially launched with eight public and private sector banks, retail e-rupee has now been extended to more banks and has been made interoperable with UPI QR codes.
- UPI interoperability will facilitate e-rupee payments through the use of existing QR codes for the UPI ecosystem. Even if the merchant does not have a CBDC wallet, CBDC payments via UPI will allow for the e-rupee to be deposited in the merchant's or receiver's bank account.








- Public sector Indian Bank announced roll out of 'IB SAATHI' initiative aimed at providing an integrated ecosystem for all stakeholders in the financial sector through the business correspondent route.
- The IB Sustainable Access and Aligning Technology for Holistic Inclusion (SAATHI) offers an enhanced user experience through the simplified delivery of services, encompassing both basic and value-added offerings to customers.
- The bank's Managing Director and CEO S L Jain launched the initiative at their corporate office
- Indian Bank, with the launch of the scheme, seeks to provide basic banking services at all centres for a minimum of four hours per day at fixed branches while the Banking Correspondents would extend their services directly at the doorsteps of the customers.
- By March 2024, Indian Bank has planned to deploy about 5,000 banking correspondents and this is expected to bolster the bank's reach and accessibility.










- The value of Financial Inclusion (FI) Index, which captures the extent of financial inclusion across the country, improved to 60.1 in March 2023 vis-à-vis 56.4 in March 2022, with growth witnessed across all sub-indices, according to the Reserve Bank of India.
- Improvements in FI Index were mainly contributed by usage and quality dimensions, reflecting deepening of financial inclusion
- When FI Index was first published in **August 2021**, the Index for FY ending March 2021 was at 53.9. This index was at 43.4 for the period ending March 2017.
- The FI Index has been conceptualised as a comprehensive index incorporating details of banking, investments, insurance, postal as well as the pension sector in consultation with Government and respective sectoral regulators.







- The index captures information on various aspects of financial inclusion in a single value ranging between **0 and 100**, where 0 represents complete financial exclusion and 100 indicates full financial inclusion.
- The FI Index comprises of three broad parameters (weights indicated in brackets) access (35 per cent), usage (45 per cent), and quality (20 per cent) with each of these consisting of various dimensions, which are computed based on a number of indicators.









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- Private steel major Tata Steel said the company and the UK government have announced a joint agreement on a proposal to invest in electric arc furnace steelmaking at the Port Talbot site in Wales with a capital cost of £1.25 billion, inclusive of a grant from the UK government of up to £500 million.
- The project will reduce direct emissions by 50 million tonnes over a decade
- Tata Steel UK will soon start consultation on the proposal and the transition period, including potential deep restructuring for the carbon-intensive, unsustainable iron and steelmaking facilities at Port Talbot, where many of the existing 'heavy end' assets such as blast furnaces and coke ovens — are reaching the end of their operational life.
- Further, the company announced its intention to invest approximately £20 million over four years to set up two additional centres of innovation and technology in the UK at the Henry Royce Institute at Manchester (for advanced materials research) and at Imperial College London (for research in sustainable design and manufacturing).

- The Centre appointed special director Rahul Navin as in-charge director of the Enforcement Directorate (ED) till the name of the regular director is announced or until further orders
- **Rahul Navin**, a 1993-batch IRS officer, has taken charge as the acting director of the ED replacing **Sanjay Kumar Mishra**, an IRS officer of the 1984 batch.
- With his appointment, Navin becomes the most senior officer within the central probe agency.
- Navin has also served as the chief vigilance officer of the ED headquarters.
- In July, the Supreme Court granted an extension of tenure to ED chief Mishra till September 15 but made it clear there would be no further extension.
- Mishra was first appointed the ED director for two years on November 19, 2018.
- Later, by an order dated November 13, 2020, the central government modified the appointment letter retrospectively and his two-year term was changed to three years.

- Three from Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat and two each from Punjab and Delhi were also selected.





- The Sangeet Natak Akademi has also organised a four-day festival from September 16 to 20 at the Akademi complex featuring the recipients of the awards.





- SpaceX launched 22 Starlink internet satellites to low-Earth orbit, marking the company's 65th launch of the year.
- The Falcon 9 launch vehicle carrying the satellites lifted off from Space Launch Complex 40 (SLC-40) at Cape Canaveral Space Force Station in Florida.
- This was the fifth flight for the first stage booster supporting this mission, which previously launched Crew-6, SES O3b mPOWER, and now three Starlink missions.


















- A Russian spacecraft blasted off from Kazakhstan's Baikonur cosmodrome carrying two Russian cosmonauts and a U.S. astronaut to join the crew of the International Space Station (ISS)
- Soyuz MS-24 spacecraft with American Loral O'Hara and Russians Oleg Kononenko and Nikolai Chub on board docked at the ISS
- They will join the current crew of NASA astronauts Jasmin Moghbeli and Frank Rubio, Russian cosmonauts Dmitry Petelin, Konstantin Borisov and Sergei Prokopyev, as well as Denmark's Andreas Mogensen and Japan's Satoshi Furukawa.
- O'Hara and Chub are on their first spaceflight, while Kononenko is on his fifth. Russia's space programme suffered a major setback last month when its Luna-25 spacecraft crashed during an attempt to land near the south pole of the moon in the country's first lunar mission in 47 years.
- The ISS is one of the few international projects on which the United States and Russia still cooperate closely.






- The convention centre has the largest LED media facade in the country. The plenary hall in the convention centre has the seating capacity of around 6,000 guests.



- Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar launched the new e-Bhoomi portal to further ease the process of purchasing land for government projects with the land owners' consent.
- The government aims to purchase land in a transparent manner with the consent of the landowners
- Now, apart from farmers, aggregators will also be able to offer land on this portal
- The aggregator must be an income taxpayer and must have a Parivar Pehchan Patra family ID

The offer of land on the new portal would be valid for six months. Farmers can offer their land independently or through listed aggregators.

• A minimum offer of 10 acre has been made mandatory for voluntary offers made by aggregators










- However, if the rates are higher than the collector rates, the proposal will be presented for consideration before the Committee of Secretaries headed by the Chief Secretary.
- If the rates are more than 50 per cent of the collector rates, the proposal will be sent to the High Powered Land Purchase Committee headed by the chief minister
- In normal cases, it is expected that the entire process will be completed within a time frame of 3 to 6 months.
- This process will bring transparency as well as reduce complaints of delay in payment by land owners and aggregators











- Last year, the ministry had extended the panel's tenure till **September 16, 2023.**





- Ministry of Railways has extended it suo-moto up to 02nd October and has decided to culminate it with Mahatama Gandhi's Jayanti.





 - 3rd Position: North Eastern Railway.



- Mamata Yojana is taking proper care of the health of pregnant women and newborns in the state.








- The Chief Minister said the 'Mukhyamantri Sampoorna Pushti Yojana' will further improve the nutritional value among the needy.

- The project cost is estimated to be approximately Rs 3,178 crore in the first three years of the bus operation from 2023-24 to 2025-2026.
- The bus operation under the scheme has been planned to connect all the GPs, block headquarters, district headquarters, major cities, and economic hubs across the state.
- The scheme would be implemented in a phased manner. About 1000 buses would be deployed under the scheme for 10 years.
- The Odisha Cabinet on Friday approved a new scheme called , "Improvement to Tanks and MIPs for a period of three years from 2023-24 to 2025-26 with an outlay of Rs 248.00 Crore for revival of lost ayacut of approximately 16,400 hactares.







- Under this scheme it is planned to renovate 503 Minor Irrigation Projects (MIPs) throughout the State to revive a lost ayacut of approximately 16,400 hectares by restoring live storage capacity of the reservoirs to its designed capacity.
- Upon completion of the projects, assured irrigation facilities will be provided to the tail end by augmenting the irrigation potential of MIPs to their design capacity, thus benefiting many farmers, while also augmenting the water storage capacity of the tanks.







- The state government will implement the breakfast scheme at Dusshera to reflect the CM's humane approach.












- The Maharashtra government has renamed Aurangabad district to Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar district and Osmanabad district to Darashiv district.
- The state government published the gazette and changed the names of both districts.
- Henceforth, Osmanabad district will be named Dharashiv, and Aurangabad district will be named Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, stated the Gazette.
- During the ongoing hearing in the Bombay High Court, it was said the objections raised by the state government have not been verified. The HC asked how you changed the names when there was no verification.
- Therefore, it had been decided to keep the names of Aurangabad as Aurangabad and Osmanabad as Osmanabad district for the time being.







- Accordingly, the names of the entire districts of Osmanabad and Aurangabad were changed.
- Earlier, the name of Aurangabad city had been changed to Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar.
