## Important days in November 2023 National and International: In Detail

Special days in November 2023: The Important days in November 2023 national and International are listed below along with their importance and details.

## World Vegan Day (1st November)

Important days in November 2023 national and International: World Vegan Day is celebrated annually on November 1st to increase public awareness of the advantages of a vegan diet and veganism in general. To celebrate the 51st anniversary of the UK Vegan Society, the inaugural Vegan Day took place on November 1, 2023.

## All Saints' Day (1st November)

## Melbourne Cup Day (1st November)

Significant days in November 2023: This day is marked by the Melbourne Cup, a 3200-meter thoroughbred horse race held in Australia. It is customary to celebrate on the first Tuesday in November, having started in 1861.

## World Tsunami Awareness Day (5th November)

## Diwali (12th November)

Significant days in November 2023: October or November sees the annual celebration of Diwali, also known as the Festival of Lights. Although it is associated with a number of religious occasions, figures, and deities, it is most commonly observed as the return of Rama to his kingdom in Ayodhya following a 14-year banishment. It is also commonly linked to Ganesha, the god of wisdom and the remover of obstacles, and Lakshmi, the goddess of prosperity.

## World Pneumonia Day (12th November)

On November 12th, the world observes World Pneumonia Day to increase awareness of pneumonia and ways to prevent it. With children under the age of five being the most affected, this is said to be the most common infectious disease in the world.

## World Kindness Day (12th November)

Notable days in November 2023: November 13th is World Kindness Day, which is honored annually. Encouraging everyone to consider and adhere to one of the most significant and distinctive human values is the primary objective of this day. Additionally, this day encourages modest deeds of goodwill that unite people.

## Children's Day in India (14th November)

## National Epilepsy Day (17th November)

## World Toilet Day (19th November)

Important days in November 2023 national and International: November 19th is World Toilet Day, which is observed annually. The main purpose of this day is to mobilize support for addressing the global sanitation issue and achieving Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6,
which calls for universal access to clean water by 2030. UNICEF and WHO estimate that 4.5 billion people, or about $60 \%$ of the world's population, do not have access to a toilet at home or do not know how to properly dispose of their waste.

## Africa Industrialization Day (20th November)

Significant days in November 2023: Africa Industrialization Day is marked annually on November 20th to increase awareness of the issues and difficulties associated with African industrialization. Additionally, it has been noted that governments and other institutions throughout several African nations are concentrating on diverse strategies to propel Africa's industrialization process.

## Universal Children's Day (20th November)

Notable days in November 2023: November 20th is recognised as Universal Children's Day each year. The main goals of this day are to enhance children's welfare, foster international collaboration, and increase awareness among kids everywhere. The first Universal Children's Day was observed on November 20, 1954.

## World Television Day (21st November)

Important days in November 2023 check national and international days: It is marked as World Television Day on November 21st each year. The UN claims that on this day, television's everyday contribution is celebrated because it raises a variety of concerns that have an impact on people. On this day, people acknowledge the influence and scope of geo-televisual communication on the worldwide scene.

## International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women (25th November)

The United Nations General Assembly declared this day to be observed in 1993. ## International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People (29th November)

The International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People is observed on November 29th of each year. The General Assembly declared this day to be the International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People in 1977 after Resolution 32/40 B was passed. On November 29, 1947, the Assembly passed Resolution 181 (II) regarding the partition of Palestine.

## St. Andrews Day (30th November)

Scotland observes Saint Andrew's Day annually on November 30. This holiday is particularly popular in nations where Saint Andrew is the patron saint, including Barbados, Bulgaria, Columbia, Cyprus, Greece, Romania, Russia, Scotland, and Ukraine. Andrew the Apostle's feast day is today. This is one of the most significant occasions in the Scottish calendar, after Burns Night and Hogmanay, as it marks the beginning of Scotland's Winter Festival every year.
