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






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
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

- The International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction (IDDR) is celebrated every year on 13
 October

- The history of International Day for Disaster Reduction dates back to 1989 when the United Nations General Assembly established the day to promote a culture of risk-awareness and disaster reduction across the globe.
- Since then, the day is observed annually on 13 October to appreciate and honor the efforts
 of communities in reducing the global risks of disasters through awareness, advocacy, and
 several other means.

- Former England captain Alastair Cook, his country's record test run scorer, announced his retirement from professional cricket.
- The 38-year-old left-handed opener, who retired from international cricket in 2018, played his entire county career with Essex.
- Scorer of 12,472 test runs for England and capped 161 times
- Cook was **England test captain** from **2012 to 2017** and also captain for 69 one day internationals from 2010-14.
- He scored 766 runs in seven innings during the 2010-11 Ashes tour to help England to their first series win in Australia for 24 years.
- Overall, he has played 352 First-Class games and has scored a staggering 26,643 runs with the help of 74 centuries and 125 half-centuries.





- In international cricket, he played for England from 2006 to 2018.
- He made his debut against India in 2006 and famously hit a century in his maiden Test innings.
- He brought down curtains on his Test career after playing 161 Tests and he played 159 of them consecutively, a world record
- He scored 12,472 runs with the help of 33 centuries in Tests.
- He also led his country in 59 Tests from 2012 to 2017.

- The International Olympic Council's (IOC) Executive Board has issued a statement and announced the suspension of the Russian Olympic Committee (ROC) with immediate effect for "breach of charter".
- The move comes after the Russian Olympic Committee recognised regional organisations from four Ukrainian territories annexed since the invasion began in 2022.
- The 141st Session of the IOC will be held from October 15-17 and the IOC's Executive Board is meeting over two days, on October 12 and 13, to discuss the proposals it has to move forward to the Session.
- The National Olympic Committee (NOC) of Russia was suspended after it decided to include regional sports organisations which are under the authority of the NOC of Ukraine.

Explanation

- Bengaluru became the second highest-ranked Indian city on the Global Residential Cities Index Q2 2023, climbing to 22nd position from 77th in Q2 2022, according to the Global **Residential Cities Index Q2 2023, Knight Frank**
- Mumbai too saw growth by securing the 19th rank with a 6 per cent annual percentage change, compared to its 95th position in Q2 2022.
- Meanwhile, New Delhi has claimed the 3rd spot among Indian cities and the 25th spot globally
- In Q2 2023, Chennai and Kolkata have taken the 4th and 5th positions among Indian cities, and on the global index, they stand at 39th and 40th, both showing a 2.5 per cent increase in the residential asset class.
- In the preceding year, these cities were ranked at 107th and 114th on the global scale.

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- The Knight Frank Global Residential Cities Index Q2 2023 reveals that the Turkish capital,
 Ankara, leads the list with the highest growth rate of 105.9 per cent, followed by Istanbul at 85.1 per cent.
- On the other end of the spectrum, Stockholm ranks lowest in terms of price appreciation with a decline of -14.3 per cent on the Global Residential Cities Index.

- India ranked 111th out of 125 countries in the Global Hunger Index-2023
- India ranked 107th out of 121 countries in 2022.
- The **Global Hunger Index (GHI)** is a tool for comprehensively measuring and tracking hunger at global, regional, and national levels.
- India's neighbouring countries Pakistan (102th), Bangladesh (81st), Nepal (69th) and Sri Lanka (60th) have fared better than it in the index.
- India stands in a group of 40 countries where the scale of global hunger has been termed as 'serious'.
- Four factors were taken into account for calculating the GHI scores: undernourishment
 (refers to the entire population both children and adults); child stunting (share of children
 who have low height for their age); child under-5 mortality; and child wasting (children who
 have low weight for their height). All these indicators are components of the universally
 agreed UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- With a score of 28.7 on the Global Hunger Index-2023, India has a serious level of serious hunger, the report said.





- It added that the rate of undernourishment in India stood at 16.6 per cent and under-five mortality at 3.1 per cent.
- The prevalence of anaemia in women aged between 15 and 24 years stood at 58.1 per cent, according to the controversial index.
- It ranked the country reporting the highest child-wasting rate, which is based on children's weight relative to their height, at 18.7 per cent.
- Global Hunger Index is a tool for comprehensively measuring and tracking hunger at global, regional, and national levels. It is released by the Alliance2015, a network of seven European non-government organisations engaged in humanitarian and development action.
- The index captures three dimensions of hunger: insufficient availability of food, shortfalls in the nutritional status of children and child mortality (which is, to a large extent, attributable to undernutrition).
- Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Chile, China and Croatia are the top five countries in the list
- Chad, Niger, Lesotho, Congo, Yemen, Madagascar, and Central African Republic are bottom ranking in the list







- Indian Bank and HUDCO (Housing and Urban Development Corporation Ltd) are major shareholders in the housing finance company, holding 51 per cent and 25 per cent stake, respectively.
- The company was set up in 1991.
- The housing finance company's net loss widened to ₹55.78 lakh in FY23 against ₹12.93 lakh in FY22.
- The balance loss carried to balance sheet stood at ₹135.70 crore in FY23 against ₹135.15 crore in FY22, per the HFC's annual report.

- HDFC Mutual through its various schemes reduced its holding from 5.14 per cent to 3.06 per cent.
- Earlier, in December 2021, HDFC MF had booked a similar profit by selling a 2.06% stake in the firm, reducing its overall holding to 5.14%.
- On 28 September, HDFC MF raised its stake by 2.01% to 8.56% in India's biggest winemaker Sula Vineyards. Recently, HDFC MF received the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI's) approval to raise stake to up to 9.5% in five private lenders—Karur Vysya Bank Ltd, DCB Bank Ltd, Equitas Small Finance Bank Ltd, Federal Bank Ltd, and City Union Bank.

- Puma India has added Indian fast bowler Mohammed Shami to its list of brand ambassadors as the sports brand launched spikes crafted for pacers.
- Shami joins Puma's star-studded roster, which consists of some of the greatest names from the world of sports, including Indian batting icon Virat Kohli, eight-time Olympic gold medalist Usain Bolt, football stars Neymar Jr and Sunil Chhetri, six-time World amateur boxing champion MC Mary Kom, and celebrated women cricketers like Harmanpreet Kaur and Harleen Deol.
- Shami has been a key member of the Indian squad since 2013, when he made his Test debut against the West Indies at the Eden Gardens, Kolkata.
- He picked up nine wickets in the match, the most by an Indian fast bowler on debut.
- The right-arm fast bowler has till now played 64 Tests, picking up 229 wickets at an average of 27.7.
- He also has 171 wickets in 94 One Day Internationals (ODIs) along with 24 scalps in 23 matches.

- Legendary Sri Lanka captain Kumar Sangakkara has been named as the new chair of the Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC) World Cricket Committee.
- He took over the role from former England captain Mike Gatting, who served the role for six years
- Sangakkara was previously serving as MCC's president, which will be taken over by ex-Hampshire captain-turned-broadcaster Mark Nicholas.
- The 45-year-old was the first non-British President of the MCC in 2019 and served in it for two years before handing it off to Stephen Fry, who is currently the body's immediate past president.
- The MCC committee also consisted of Ricky Skerritt, Heather Knight, Suzie Bates, Clare Connor, Justin Langer, Eoin Morgan, Ramiz Raja, Sourav Ganguly, and Kumar Dharmasena.
- The committee meets twice a year to discuss urgent issues in the game as an adjunct to the International Cricket Council (ICC) and its member states.





- Nicholas, who will take over for Stephen Fry as president of the MCC, has expressed his
 excitement about the new position.
- Along with Sangakkara and Nicholas, the MCC also announced the appointment of Chris Rogers as the new treasurer, who will succeed Tony Elgood, who served in the position for six years.
- He joined the Club in 1977 and has been a member of the finance committee since 2015.

 Samman for the year 2022 for her memoir written in Tamil, Surya Vamsam, at the
 National Museum in Delhi
- Former Union minister and a former recipient of the award, M Veerappa Moily, who was the chief guest at the event, hailed Sivasankari as a national icon.
- The Saraswati Samman, instituted by the KK Birla Foundation, carries a plaque, a citation, and a cash prize of ₹15 lakh.
- Sivasankari is the 32nd recipient of the award, joining a pantheon of writers over the years
- Sivasankari's literary career spans over five decades. She is the author of 36 novels, 48 novellas, 150 short stories, 15 travelogues, seven collections of essays, and three biographies.





- Her 2019 memoir, Surya Vamsam, unfolds in two volumes the first is the metamorphosis from a child to a young writer, and the second is the life and times of an acclaimed author spreading her wings.
- The work was selected by a Chayan Parishad (Selection Committee), headed by former Supreme Court judge Arjan Kumar Sikri.
- The Saraswati Samman, given annually for outstanding literary works in 22 Indian languages in the last 10 years, is among the highest recognitions in the field of Indian literature.
- Besides the Saraswati Samman, the Vyas Samman and the Bihari Puraskar are other literary awards instituted by the foundation.

- The veteran actor's filmography includes the cult classic thriller 'Basic Instinct' and the Oscar winning 'One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest' and 'Wall Street'.
- Michael Douglas began his Hollywood career in 1966 and acted in more than 63 movies, winning the Academy Award for 'Best Actor' for the 1987 drama 'Wall Street'.
- He received an American Film Institute Lifetime Award in 2009 and has won and been nominated for several BAFTAs, Golden Globe Awards and Emmy Awards.
- The well known Hollywood actor Michael Douglas has mane accolades to his fame. These include two Academy Awards, five Golden Globe Awards, a Primetime Emmy Award, the Cecil B. DeMille Award, and the AFI Life Achievement Award.





- The year 1987 saw Douglas star in the thriller Fatal Attraction with Glenn Close. That same year he played tycoon Gordon Gekko in Oliver Stone's Wall Street for which he received an Academy Award as Best Actor.
- Previous winners of the Satyajit Ray Excellence in Film Lifetime Award include Martin Scorcese, Wong Kar-wai, Lata Mangeshkar and Dilip Kumar.
- In 2018, he starred with Alan Arkin in The Kominsky Method, playing Sandy Kominsky, an aging acting coach. He received a Golden Globe Award for his performance
- The International Film Festival of India (IFFI) 's 54th edition will take place from November 20 to 28 in Goa.
- The Satyajit Ray Lifetime Achievement Award, instituted in the IFFI in 1999, is presented to individuals whose exceptional contributions have significantly enriched and elevated the world of cinema



- As spacetech start-up Skyroot Aerospace gears up for the launch of its first commercial mission Vikram-1 orbital rocket it has inked two memoranda of understanding (MoUs) with a couple of French companies Prométhée and ConnectSAT.
- While **Skyroot has signed an MoU with Prométhée Earth Intelligence** for providing satellite launch services for former's JAPETUS earth observation constellation, it has also inked a trilateral agreement with **ConnectSAT and Expleo**.
- As part of the trilateral pact, Expleo will provide reconfigurable software for ConnectSAT's IoT satellite which is to be launched on Vikram-1 for building the ConnectSAT's futuristic OSIRIS satellite constellation.
- The MoUs, inked at Skyroot's Hyderabad facility, will lead to procurement of Skyroot's launch services by these satellite companies over single or multi-launch agreements covering several Vikram space launches
- The two companies had entered into an exploratory understanding in Paris in July this year during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit.

- The Tamil Nadu government launched the Nilgiri Tahr, an ambitious flagship programme to conserve the state animal.
- Chief Minister M K Stalin launched the project at a function held at the Secretariat here by unveiling a plaque and distributing books to school students to create awareness on the animal.
- Locally known as "Varai Aadu", the Nilgiri Tahr is an endangered species endemic to the Western Ghats known for their gravity defying skills in climbing steep cliff. These mountain goats are aptly called "Mountain Monarch."
- The Nilgiri Tahr finds mention in books such as Natrinai, Aingurunooru, Paripadal, Pathitruppathuu and Patinapalai from Pathinen Melkanakku Noolgal.
- The play, Courtallar Kuravanji, written by Trikoodarasappa Kavirayar in 1600-1700 A.D. describes
 Nilgiri Tahr in a song "Kurathi malai valam kooral."
- It is one of the animals that indicates the biodiversity richness of the region
- As a testimony to its ecological and cultural significance in Tamil Nadu, Nilgiri Tahr was
 declared as a state animal of Tamil Nadu.





- A Government Order issued in **December 2022**, said the project aimed at developing a better understanding of Nilgiri Tahr population, distribution and ecology, re-introduction of Nilgiri Tahr to their historic habitats, addressing proximate threat to Nilgiri Tahr besides increasing awareness among public about the species.
- The **Rs 25 crore project**, with office in Coimbatore, will focus on bi-annual synchronised surveys across the divisions, tranquilisation, collaring and monitoring of Tahr Individuals, diagnosis and treatment for affected individuals, Shola Grassland restoration in Upper Bhavani, implementation of eco-tourism programmes among the other things.

- In a boost to Kerala's thriving MSME sector, the state government has introduced a comprehensive insurance scheme covering Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises.
- This initiative aims to safeguard these businesses from various risks and instill confidence in them to thrive in a competitive business environment
- The insurance scheme covers a range of risks, including natural disasters, fire accidents, theft, accidents, and market fluctuations, all of which can lead to significant financial losses for MSMEs.
- All MSMEs in the manufacturing, service, and trade sector with UDYAM registration in Kerala, and enrolled in the "Bharat Sookshma/Laghu Udyam scheme" from any of the four public sector insurance firms beyond April 1, 2023, are eligible for benefits under the scheme
- Enterprises are eligible for a reimbursement of 50 per cent of their annual premium, with a ceiling of Rs 2500.





- MSMEs can purchase the insurance policy by paying the full annual premium, after which they
 should submit the application for reimbursement to the concerned DIC through the online portal,
 along with supporting documents.
- The scheme will be implemented through the District Industries Centres (DICs), which will
 process the applications and reimburse the eligible assistance directly to the bank accounts of
 MSMEs






Explanation

- RITES Limited, a PSU under the Ministry of Railways involved in transport consultancy and the
 engineering sector, has now been upgraded to Navratna status.
- RITES has become the **16th Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) in India** to have been granted the Navratna status.
- The government categorises all Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) in three categories, namely **Maharatna, Navratna and Miniratna.**
- To get Navratna status, the PSU should be a Miniratna-I, Schedule 'A' company, should have obtained 'excellent' or 'very good' MoU rating in three of the last five years and must have a composite score of 60 in six performance indicators.
- For a company to achieve the Navratna status, it must report a net profit of more than Rs 5,000 crore for three consecutive years and maintain an average annual turnover of Rs 25,000 crore for three years or have an annual average net worth of over Rs 15,000 crore for three years

 The list of other 15 Navratna PSUs of India include Bharat Electronics Limited, Container Corporation of India Limited, Engineers India Limited, Hindustan Aeronautics Limited, Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited, National Aluminium Company Limited, National Buildings Construction Corporation Limited, Neyveli Lignite Corporation Limited, NMDC Limited, Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Limited, Shipping Corporation of India Limited, Rail Vikas Nigam Limited, ONGC Videsh Ltd, Rashtriya Chemicals & Fertilizers Limited and IRCON.

Presently, there are 42 wetland cities situated across 17 nations around the world, with China boasting the highest number at 13 such cities.



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






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
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
