- World Standards Day is organized and led by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC), the International Organization for Standardization (ISO), and the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), which are the primary global developers of international standards.
- World Standards Day was inaugurated on October 14, 1946, and was initiated by prominent international standards organizations such as ISO, IEC, and ITU.



- Her poetry was known for its candor in exploring family and childhood with "an unmistakable voice" and "austere beauty," the Swedish Academy, which is responsible for selecting the winner of the literature prize, said when awarding her the Nobel
- A professor of English at Yale University, Gluck first rose to critical acclaim with her 1968 collection of poems entitled "Firstborn"
- Gluck won a **Pulitzer Prize in 1993** for her poetry **collection "The Wild Iris,"** with the title poem touching on suffering and redolent with imagery of the natural world.
- She served as Poet Laureate of the United States in 2003-04 and was awarded the National **Humanities Medal by President Barrack Obama in 2016.**
- In her lifetime, she published 12 collections of poetry and several volumes of essays.
- Born in New York, Gluck became the 16th woman to win a Nobel Prize for Literature, the literary world's most prestigious award.

- The study aims at strategising economic development across the nodes of Andal-Panagarh, Kharagapur-Goaltore-Salboni and growth centres such as Siliguri, Dankuni and Kalyani with urban-industriallogistics-skills-energy-social sector convergence.
- The ADB has worked on a number of landmark projects, including the East Coast Economic Corridor and the Bangladesh Corridor study
- Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee recently announced the Industrial and Economic Corridor Policy and that the government plans to develop and upgrade three corridors -- Dankuni-Kalyani, Tajpur-Raghunathpur and Dankuni-Jhargram -- in southern West Bengal, and another from Panagarh to Cooch Behar spanning across the northern districts.

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed monetary penalties on RBL Bank, Union Bank, and Bajaj Finance due to violation of certain norms.
- **RBL Bank** has been fined **Rs 64,00,000** for its failure to obtain an annual declaration in Form B from one of its major shareholders within the stipulated time frame of one month after the close of the financial years ending on March 31, 2018, March 31, 2019, and March 31, 2020. The bank also neglected to provide certificates to RBI confirming the 'fit and proper' status of one of its major shareholders by the end of September in these respective financial years.
- Further, Union Bank of India has incurred a penalty of Rs 1 crore for its failure to comply with specific directions. The bank had sanctioned a term loan to a corporation without conducting necessary due diligence on the viability and bankability of the projects. This non-compliance occurred as the bank did not ensure that the revenue generated from these projects was adequate to cover the debt servicing obligations. Additionally, the repayment and servicing of the loan were made from budgetary resources, contrary to the prescribed regulations.





Explanation

• A penalty worth **Rs 8,50,000** was imposed on **Bajaj Finance**. The penalty was levied due to the company's non-compliance with the 'Monitoring of Frauds in NBFCs Directions, 2016,' a set of guidelines issued by the RBI.



- NASA launched a spacecraft from Florida on its way to Psyche, the largest of the several
 metal-rich asteroids known in our solar system and a body thought to be the remnant core of
 an ancient protoplanet.
- The Psyche probe, folded inside the cargo bay of a SpaceX Falcon Heavy rocket, blasted off from NASA's Kennedy Space Center in Cape Canaveral on a planned journey 2.2 billion miles (3.5 billion km) through space
- SpaceX launched the spacecraft into a midmorning sky from NASA's Kennedy Space Center
- The spacecraft, roughly the size of a small van, is due to reach the asteroid in August 2029.
- This asteroid measures roughly 173 miles (279 km) across at its widest point and resides on the outer fringes of the main asteroid belt between the planets Mars and Jupiter
- The asteroid, discovered in 1852 and named for the goddess of the soul in Greek mythology, is the largest of about nine known asteroids that appear from ground-based radar observations to consist largely of metal, with rocky material mixed in.

- The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the 141st International Olympic Committee (IOC) Session in Mumbai.






