- Table-toppers Maharashtra clinched three gold medals in Yogasana and one more in shootingon the final day of the 37th National Games to clinch the Raja Bhalindra Singh Rolling Trophy for overallchampionship for the first time since 1994.
- Maharashtra finished with a total of 228 medals, including 80 gold, 69 silver and 79 bronze medals to endthe Services Sports Control Board's (SSCB) reign at the top since the 2007 Games in Guwahati. SSCB finished second, bagging 66 gold, 27 silver and 33 bronze medals, while Haryana were third in thestandings with 62 gold, 54 silver and 73 bronze.
- Madhya Pradesh and Kerala finished fourth and fifth respectively with hosts Goa registering their best-ever finish of 9th with a total of 92 medals, including 27 gold.
- Karnataka swimmer Srihari Nataraj (8 gold, 1 silver, 1 bronze) was adjudged the Best Male Athlete whilegymnasts Sanyukta Prasen Kale and Pranati Nayak of Odisha (4 gold, 1 silver each) were adjudged the BestFemale athletes of the 37th National Games, which witnessed almost 11000 sportspersons vying for tophonours in 42 sports disciplines, three of which were demo sports.

- In the women's trap final, Punjab's Rajeshwari Kumari took the gold medal with a score of 44 points withUttar Pradesh's Sabina Haris taking the silver with a score of 43 points. Aashima Ahlawat of Haryanafinished with bronze.

- Shaurya Bhattacharya paired with Sachin Baisoya to win the gold in the team event ahead of Anant SinghAhlawat and Aadil Bedi of Delhi who won the silver and Giirraj Singh Khadka and Sawai H.S Bhati of Rajasthan who won the bronze.
- Earlier in the morning, Punjab's Harveer Singh took the gold in the men's Road Race while Monika Jat ledRajasthan's 1-2 in the women's individual Time Trial at Verna with Kavita Siyag taking the silver medal.





Explanation

- Former U.S. astronaut Frank Borman, who made history by commanding the first manned flight to circle the moon and later piloted Eastern Airlines as chairman in severe economic turbulence, has died at the age of 95
- Born in Gary, Indiana, on **March 14, 1928**, he was the oldest American astronaut still living; that mantle now passes to Jim Lovell, who is also 95 but eleven days younger.
- He became an Air Force fighter pilot after graduating from the U.S. Military Academy in 1950.
- He trained as a test pilot before being selected for NASA's second astronaut program in 1962
- Three years later he was commander on **Apollo 8 the first lunar orbital mission -** and made 10 trips around the moon with his two crewmates on a mission that stretched over Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. The mission yielded a stunning and unprecedented photo by Borman's crewmate William Anders that came to be known as "Earthrise" a blue and white Earth seen as a partial orb rising over the blank lunar surface.

- Indian Navy Ships Kuthar, Kiltan and Maritime Patrol Aircraft (MPA) Dornier participated in the exercise along with Bangladesh Navy Ships Abu Bakr, Abu Ubaidah and MPA.
- The ships undertook communication drills, surface gun-shoots, tactical manoeuvres and other exercises that culminated with a steam past.
- CORPAT-23 also included the maiden Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) drills conducted between the two navies wherein a Search and Rescue scenario at sea was exercised.



- The event is an inter Command championship.
- This edition witnessed participation from more than 100 personnel from all three naval Commands comprising of officers, sailors (including agniveers) and cadets.
- The championship was conducted in five different classes of boats namely ILCA 7 for men, ILCA 6 for women, BicNova Wind surf boards, Laser Bahia (team racing), and J-24 (match racing) class of boat. A total of 37 races were conducted over a span of four days in three different formats of racing.

- The government unveiled a digital advertisement policy that will enable websites with a
 minimum of 2.5 lakh unique users per month and other digital platforms such as OTT and
 podcasts to get empanelled for publicity campaigns.
- The policy, unveiled by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, will enable and empower the Central Bureau of Communication (CBC) to undertake campaigns in the digital media space.
- Besides rationalising the process of empanelling websites, the CBC now for the first time will be able to channelize its public service campaign messages through mobile applications
- The policy also introduces competitive bidding for rate discovery, ensuring transparency and efficiency. Rates discovered through this process will remain valid for three years and will be applicable to all eligible agencies.
- According to TRAI's Indian Telecom Services Performance Indicators January–March 2023, the internet penetration in India was more than 880 million, and the number of telecom subscribers was over 1,172 million.





- The policy also empowers CBC to empanel digital media agencies to enhance its outreach through the various platforms.
- For empanelment with the CBC, websites and mobile applications have been classified into four categories more than 20 million unique users (A+), between 10 and 20 million unique users (A), 5-10 million unique users (B) and 0.25-5 million unique users (C).
- OTT platforms have been classified into two categories more than 2.5 million unique users in category A and those with 0.5 to 2.5 million unique users in category B.
- Podcasters or digital audio platforms should have a minimum of five lakh unique users to be eligible for empanelment with the CBC. Such platforms too have been classified as 'A' which have more than 2.5 million unique users and 'B' with unique users between 0.5-2.5 million.
- The policy also empowers CBC to on board New and Innovative Communication Platforms in the Digital Space with the approval of a duly constituted committee.
- It also introduces competitive bidding for rate discovery, ensuring transparency and efficiency. Rates discovered through this process will remain valid for three years and will be applicable to all eligible agencies.

- Kerala Financial Corporation (KFC), a prominent Kerala-based lending institution, has launched Kerala MSME Bill Discounting Platform aiming to ensure liquidity to MSMEs by discounting their outstanding bills.
- The State-Budget declared platform was inaugurated by Adv.KN Balagopal, Minister for Finance in a function held.
- The function was presided over by Adv. Antony Raju, Minister for Transport.
- KFC partnered with Receivables Exchange of India Limited (RXIL), an RBI approved company to start the platform. RXIL is the venture of the Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) & National Stock Exchange of India (NSE).





- Under the scheme, the bills accepted by the Department/ PSU/ Corporations can be discounted and KFC would pay the eligible amount to the supplier within 48 hours. The departments will get 180 days to repay the money to KFC.
- The scheme benefits the Government Departments/ PSUs in many ways. The liquidity position of the Department/ PSU improves as the repayment liability is eased.
- The Department/ PSU will be able to do purchases/ execute works at a competitive price as the Supplier/ Contractor can be assured of immediate payments. More established suppliers would participate in the tendering process as they are assured of payments on time.
