





## **Important Days**



- World Kindness Day will be observed globally November 13.
- The history of World Kindness Day traces back to 1997 when the World Kindness Movement conducted its first session in Tokyo, Japan to unite similar associations from around the world. It is a day of festivity in numerous nations, for instance, Australia, Canada, Nigeria and the United Arab Emirates. It was only after 1998 that the day was laid out as a yearly event.
- After that, the kindness movement has been making headlines all over the planet. The UK began the Kindness Movement in 2005 and Singapore joined hands in 2009.
- The World Kindness Movement started in the UK in 2010, and by 2019 it had increased to 27 countries, including France (2015), the USA (2018), Australia (2012), and the UK (2010).
- The **theme** for the year 2023 is "Be Kind Wherever Possible".










- Two Indian veterans, Virender Sehwag and Diana Edulji, alongside Sri Lankan batting great Aravinda de Silva, are the latest inductees into ICC's Hall of Fame.
- The cricket's governing body announced their inclusion with all three acknowledging the utmost honour for the service they provided on the field.
- One of India's greatest openers across formats, Sehwag deserves to be in ICC's Hall of Fame for the impact he had on the game and Indian Cricket.
- Regarded by countless as perhaps the most destructive batter since the great Viv Richards, Sehwag was the first Indian to complete a triple hundred in Tests – scoring 309 against Pakistan in Multan, 2004. A few years later, he scored his second triple-century against South Africa in Chennai in 2008.
- Even during the 2011 World Cup, Sehwag was among the top run-getters and helped India clinch the coveted trophy for the first time in 28 years.





- Diana Edulji, the trailblazer for women's cricket in India both on and off the field, is the first female cricketer from the country to be inducted into ICC's Hall of Fame.
- Cricket's most elegant batter from Sri Lanka, Aravinda de Silva, has also been inducted into ICC's Hall of Fame. A pioneer of his game, Aravinda was instrumental in shaping Sri Lanka's cricket during his playing days.

- Nehal Gupta and Naveen Sivakumar also secured a gold medal for India in men's doubles SL3-SL4 category beating compatriots Deep Ranjan Bisoyee and Manoj Sarkar 21-19 18-21 21-17 in the final.

- The programme also envisages integrated planning reforms to control urban sprawls and foster systemic and planned urbanisation through enhancing the entire ecosystem of legal, regulatory, and institutional reforms.
- The **sub-programme 1, approved in 2021** with the financing of \$350 million, established national-level policies and guidelines to improve urban services, while the latest sub-programme 2 supports investment planning and reform actions at the state and urban local body (ULB) levels.
- The loan agreement for the sub-programme 2 was signed between Juhi Mukherjee, joint secretary, department of economic affairs, ministry of finance, and Takeo Konishi, country director of ADB's India resident mission.



- Sub-programme 2 supports the reforms initiated by the states and the ULBs in operationalising the national flagship programme of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 targeted for universal access of water supply and sanitation
- The sub-programme also supports other mission objectives for ensuring urban water security through reducing water losses, recycling treated sewage for non-domestic use, rejuvenation of water bodies, and maintaining sustainable groundwater levels

- Gautam Adani-led Adani Group has secured a substantial \$553 million investment from the US International Development Finance Corporation (DFC) for a port terminal project in Sri Lanka, marking the US government agency's most significant infrastructure foray in Asia to date.
- The move is seen as a strategic enhancement of Sri Lanka's economic prospects and is anticipated to foster closer regional economic ties, particularly with India—a nation of mutual interest to both the US and Sri Lanka.
- The Adani Group begam the development of the Colombo Port's Western Container Terminal (WCT) in November of the previous year
- The DFC's financing is part of a broader ramp-up in its global investments, which have surged to an unprecedented \$9.3 billion in 2023. This investment in Sri Lanka's port infrastructure underscores the United States' reinforced commitment to development across the Indo-Pacific region.





#### **Explanation**

- In partnership with John Keells Holdings Plc and Adani Ports & Special Economic Zone, the DFC aims to leverage local expertise and uphold stringent quality standards.
- The Colombo port, a vital node in Indian Ocean maritime traffic, has been operating beyond its capacity, necessitating the expansion to accommodate the voluminous container traffic that its strategic location attracts.
- The construction and operation of the port terminal are structured under a 35-year buildoperate-transfer (BOT) agreement, with Adani International Port Holdings securing a 51 per cent majority stake, John Keells holding 34 per cent, and the Sri Lanka Ports Authority (SLPA) retaining 15 per cent.
- The project's first phase is slated for completion by the end of 2024, with the second phase expected by mid-2026. Once finished, the upgraded facility will boast a significant cargo capacity, capable of handling 300 million Twenty-foot Equivalent Units (TEUs).



- Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IIT Madras) faculty members, students, and alumni
  have designed and developed a mobile application to enable easier and efficient
  transportation of goods within cities.
- Called '**OptRoute**', this mobile phone app connects a driver with the consumer and does not take any commission or on-boarding fee. The payment from the consumer goes directly to driver, with no intermediaries.
- The first version of the app has been developed and commercialised through OptRoute
  Logistics, an IIT Madras-incubated start-up co-founded by NS Narayanaswamy, Department
  of Computer Science and Engineering, IIT Madras and Anuj Fulia, an IIT Madras alumnus
- The start-up has also developed packing and efficient vehicle space utilisation methods, which will be included in the application once sufficient initial traction is achieved.
- The OptRoute application has two user modes driver and customer. In the customer mode, users can place any goods transport request for which a vehicle is needed. In the driver mode, users can view the available requests and accept them.





- The key points of differences between OptRoute and existing services include zerocommission per transaction and nominal subscription based service model; direct payment from consumer to driver; high scalability of the software system and operations and single app for both drivers and customer.
- The app is currently available for operational in multiple cities including Chennai, Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Chandigarh, Coimbatore, Delhi, Faridabad, Gurugram and Hyderabad



- The 'AAINA Dashboard for Cities' portal www.aaina.gov.in has been made live by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) where Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) across the country can participate in this pioneering initiative to voluntarily submit their key data on a regular basis, through a simple, easy-to-fill, data entry form on the portal.
- The primary objectives of the AAINA Dashboard are to help cities to (i) see how they are faring vis-à-vis other cities, (ii) inspire them by pointing to possibilities and areas of improvement and (iii) providing opportunity to learn and engage with frontrunners. While not ranking the ULBs, the AAINA dashboard would serve as a tool for comparing similarly placed cities and promoting peer learning among cities.
- The Dashboard will present the data submitted by the ULBs on the basis of indicators across five broad pillars namely, (i) Political & Administrative Structure, (ii) Finance, (iii) Planning, (iv) Citizen Centric Governance and (v) Delivery of Basic Services.





- The ULBs will submit their data, including audited accounts, and self-reported performance metrics by logging in to the dashboard's portal. ULBs would be free to update the information initially provided by them, anytime on the portal as per need.
- The Dashboard has been envisaged as a permanent platform for ULB related data, that would be updated on a regular basis. With active cooperation of all ULBs, the 'AAINA Dashboard for Cities' aims to create a robust database of the key performance metrics of Urban Local Bodies, which could be accessed by all stakeholders, and subsequently would open for public view once it gets populated. The Ministry through Digital India Corporation will provide handholding support to ULBs / States in the data submission process on a need basis.






