



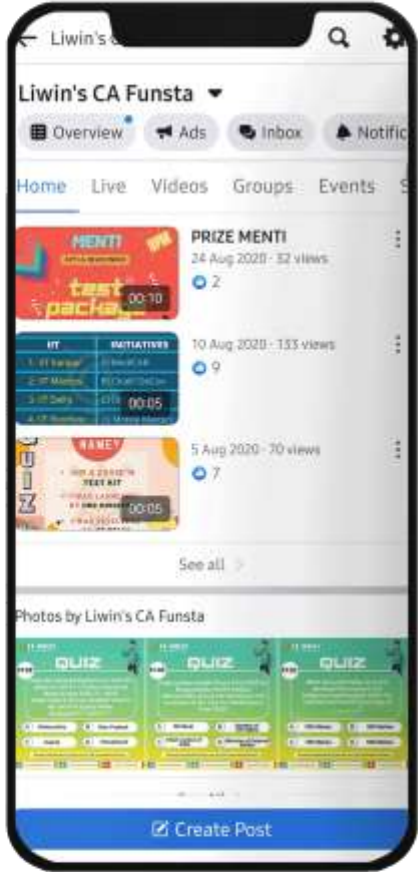

- **ASI has protected over 3,650 ancient monuments and archaeological sites.**

- In 1997, the "**World Forum of Fish Harvesters & Fish Workers**" met in New Delhi, leading to the establishment of the "**World Fisheries Forum.**"
- **Representatives from 18 countries signed a declaration** advocating for global adoption of sustainable fishing practices and policies.
- **Department of Fisheries under the Ministry of Fisheries** is hosting the **Global Fisheries Conference India 2023**. This two-day conference is scheduled for November 21st and 22nd, 2023 take place at **Ahmedabad, Gujarat.**

- He holds the record for the most Grand Slam men's singles victories with 24, including a record ten at the Australian Open.
- He has won 98 singles championships in total, including a record 71 Big Titles, which include 24 majors, 40 Masters, and an unprecedented seven ATP Finals.
- **Jannik Sinner from Italy** is ranked at **No 4 in ATP Rankings**

Explanation

- **The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a monetary penalty of Rs 25,000 on The Pudukkottai Co-operative Town Bank Ltd., Pudukkottai, Tamil Nadu.**
- This penalty has been imposed in exercise of powers conferred on RBI under the provisions of Section 47A (1) (c) read with Sections 46 (4) (i) and 56 of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (AACRS),"



Explanation

- RBI announced a **penalty of Rs 2 lakh to Sangli Sahakari Bank Limited, Mumbai for violating rules laid out by the central bank related to the 'Board of Directors-UCBs'**
- **Kolkata-based Sappers Finance and Consultancy Pvt Ltd. was fined Rs 1.50 lakh by the RBI** for violating rules related to the acquisition/transfer of control of NBFC.
- It is based on (i) 'Requirement for obtaining prior approval of RBI in cases of acquisition/transfer of control of Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs)'; and (ii) 'Non-Banking Financial Company Returns (Reserve Bank) Directions, 2016'

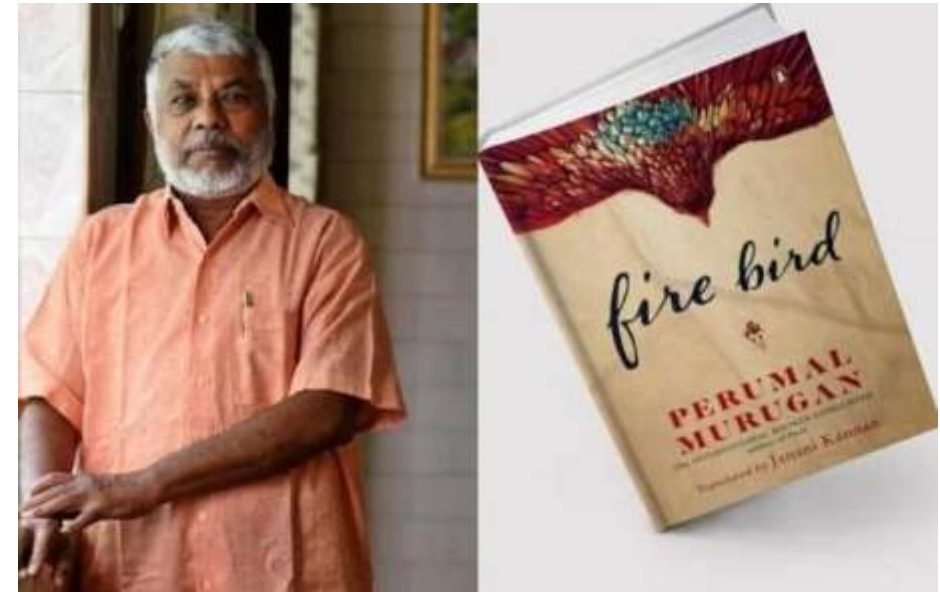

- **It was published by Penguin Random House India.**
- **The award was announced virtually by Lord Bamford, Chairman of JCB Group, and awarded in person by Deepak Shetty, CEO and Managing Director, JCB India Limited.**
- **This award carries Rs 25 lakh to the author and an additional Rs 10 lakh to the translator.**
- **Murugan has written 12 novels, six collections of short stories, six anthologies of poetry, and many non-fiction books.**
- **Ten of his novels have been translated into English, which include 'Seasons of the Palm', 'Current Show' and 'One Part Woman'.**

- **Vir Das was nominated for an International Emmy for the second time for his Netflix special Vir Das: Landing**.
- He was **nominated alongside Le Flambeau, El Encargado and Derry Girls Season 3**.
- **Vir Das won and shared the prize with Derry Girls season 3. This is the first time an Indian comedian won the award.**

- The first Emmy Awards ceremony was held on **January 25, 1949**, while the idea for the awards dates back to 1948.
- **Six prizes, including Most Outstanding Television Personality and Most Popular Television Program, were given out.**

Explanation

- **Uttar Pradesh** is focusing on connecting the proposed **Bulk Drugs Park in Lalitpur** with technology along with research and innovation to **provide high-quality and affordable medicines and medical devices.**
- For this, the government has **linked the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) and Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO) with the Bulk Drug Park** and made them its **knowledge partners.**
- Under this, the state government has **signed MoUs with 43 labs of CSIR and 46 labs of DRDO,** where research work will be done to manufacture affordable medicines.



Explanation

- **Adani Gas has been chosen as the PNG supply partner** to create a nature-friendly zone for Bulk Drugs Park, while **THDC has been selected as the solar power partner**.
- The state Government has organized an **Investors Connect webinar** and signed an MOU with around **1,500 stakeholders** to make the state a hub for the medical sector with the latest technology.
- **CONCOR is the logistics partner**, playing a crucial role in distributing medicines and medical devices nationally and internationally.
- **STPI will support Industry 4.0** to establish global recognition for the medical units in the park.



Lalitpur Bulk Drug Park (Uttar Pradesh):

- The park would accommodate **60-70 production units** that would work to **manufacture 452 medicines and 23 starting materials**.
- It will **attract the investment of 1 Lakh crore**.
- **The budget of this park includes 460.6 crore for Infrastructure, Rs 20 Crore for Liquid Discharge Systems, Rs 144.2 crore for land aquisitionand Rs 10 crore for administrative expenses.**

- The earlier editions of this Mart held in **Guwahati, Tawang, Shillong, Gangtok, Agartala, Imphal, Kohima and Aizwal. Shillong will be hosting this event for the second time,** since its inception.
- **Travel for LiFE Program** is envisaged to position India as a leader in promoting sustainable and responsible tourism and using tourism as a vehicle for achieving **Sustainable Development Goals by 2030.**

Development of tourism infrastructure and tourism promotion in NER:

- **16 projects** have been sanctioned in the North East States under the **Swadesh Darshan Scheme** for a total amount of **Rs.1309.00 crores**.
- A total of **15 tourist destinations** are being taken up in the North East for development under the **revamped Swadesh Darshan Scheme 2.0** with an objective to develop destinations with a tourist and destination-centric approach.



Development of tourism infrastructure and tourism promotion in NER:

- Ministry of Tourism under the **PRASHAD Scheme** has sanctioned a total of **8 projects for an amount of Rs.256.45 Crore for the integrated development of identified pilgrimage destinations in the North East States.**

- **This agreement was signed by Shri Indra Mani Pandey, Permanent Representative of India to the United Nations, on behalf of the Ministry of Ayush, and Dr. Bruce Aylward, Assistant Director General, Universal Health Coverage and Life Course Division, on behalf of WHO.**
- **The main objective is to integrate aspects like standardization, quality, and safety of Traditional and Complementary Medical Systems into the National Health System and to disseminate them at the international level.**



Explanation

- To fulfil this objective, **Traditional Medicine Global Strategy 2025-34 will be prepared by WHO with the support of the Ministry of Ayush.**
- **An International Herbal Pharmacopoeia of herbs found in South-East Asia will be developed by the Ministry in collaboration with WHO.**
- A total of two 'Project Collaboration Agreements' have already been signed by the Ministry of Ayush with WHO.
- **The first contract was signed in 2016 to take Traditional Medical systems like Yoga, Ayurveda, Unani, and Panchakarma to the global level and the second contract was signed in 2017 to strengthen the system of Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha medical systems.**
- **Ayush Secretary, Vaidya Rajesh Kotecha also present in this event.**

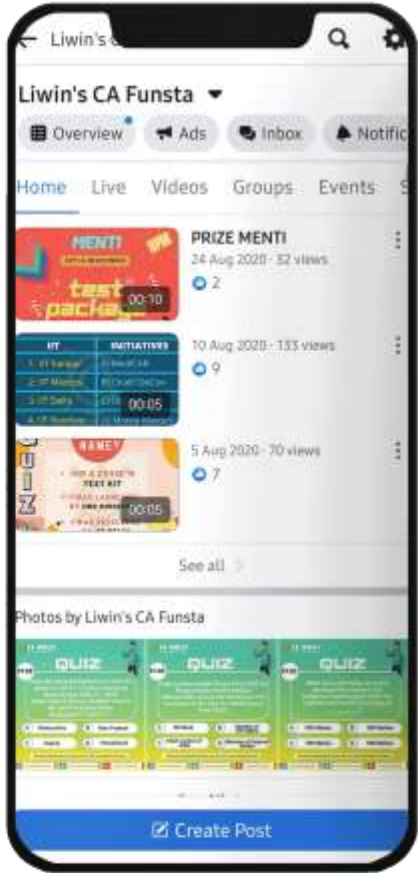

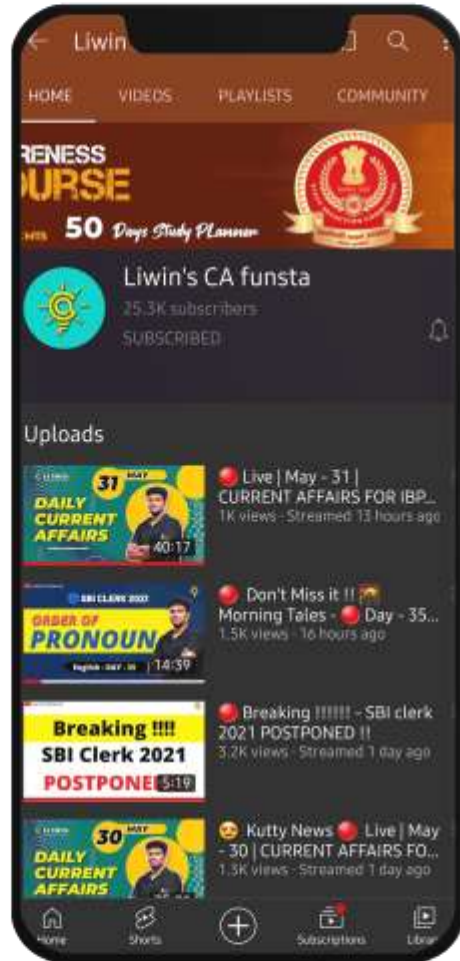
