**International day of the Commemoration and Dignity of the Victims of the Crime of Genocide and Prevention of this crime is observed on December 9**

- **The International day of the Commemoration and Dignity of the Victims of the Crime of Genocide and of the Prevention of this Crime was declared in 2015 by the UN on the initiative of Armenia.**
- The primary goal of the day is the fight against genocide, reminding people about the irreversible loss of the humanity caused by genocide.
- **Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide was adopted by the UN on December 9 and it was ratified by 153 UN member states.**
- **This year marks 75th anniversary of the adoption of the Convention.**

- **Theme: Freedom, Equality and Justice for All**
- **The Declaration was proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly in Paris on 10 December 1948** and sets out, for the first time, fundamental human rights to be universally protected.
- This landmark document enshrines the inalienable rights that everyone is entitled to as a human being - regardless of race, colour, religion, sex, language, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status

- **The National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) on behalf of River Cities Alliance (RCA), has signed a Memorandum of Common Purpose (MoCP) with the Mississippi River Cities and Towns Initiative (MRCTI), representing 124 cities/towns situated along the banks of the Mississippi River, USA.**
- This signing ceremony held as part of the ongoing COP28 or the United Nations Climate Change Conference in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.





## Explanation

- The MoCP was signed by Shri G. Asok Kumar, DG, NMCG and by Mayor Mitch Reynolds of La Crosse (Wisconsin), Mayor Errick Simmons of Greenville (Mississippi), Mayor LaToya Cantrell of New Orleans (Louisiana), and Mr. Colin Wellemkamp (Executive Director, MRCTI) on behalf of USA's MRCTI, in the presence of senior officials from US State Department, UNEP, National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA) and Rotary International.
- **Through this agreement the current River Cities Alliance (RCA) has now expanded its strength to the membership of 267 global river-cities including India, USA and Denmark.**



## Explanation

- **The collaboration includes a comprehensive water monitoring program, sharing best practices for renaturing urban areas, and restoring aquatic ecosystems for sustainable urban development.**



## **River Cities Alliance: 142 Indian River Cities, Aarhus, Denmark - Member**

- **National Mission of Clean Ganga, in association with National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA) under Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) had initiated a unique concept of River Cities Alliance (RCA) in November 2021.**
- RCA is envisaged as a dedicated platform for cities on the banks of rivers in India for concerted discussions and capacity building on aspects related to enhancing the state of urban rivers and has 142 Indian River cities and Aarhus of Denmark as members.

- Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management (IITTM), an autonomous body under MoT, in collaboration with MoEFCC will build the capacity of local community members around different Ramsar sites in order to strengthen nature tourism at these sites and provide alternative livelihood to the local community.

- The 'Nature-tourism and Wetcomponent of this initiative is being implemented jointly by MoT and MoEFCC with an aim to enhance livelihood opportunities for local communities of Ramsar Sites.

- These enhancements encompass bettering station accessibility, waiting areas, toilet facilities, lift and escalator installations as needed, cleanliness, offering free Wi-Fi, setting up kiosks for local products through initiatives like 'one station one product', enhancing passenger information systems, establishing executive lounges, designating spaces for business meetings, incorporating landscaping, and catering to the unique requirements of each station etc.

- The Exercise is part of ongoing efforts of Centre for United Nations Peacekeeping (CUNPK) to strengthen international cooperation and capacity-building in peacekeeping missions, with specific focus on empowering women in the field.



## Explanation

- CUNPK is a premier institution of the Indian Army to impart training in peacekeeping operations.
- This TTX is a follow up exercise of ongoing joint military training between India and ASEAN member states.
- The Exercise underscores India's shared commitment to the world peace, stability, and gender equality.

## Explanation

- **Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, has approved reservation norms for mandatory use of jute in packaging for the Jute Year 2023 -24 (1st July, 2023 to 30th June, 2024) on 8th December, 2023.**
- **The Mandatory packaging norms approved for Jute Year 2023-24 provide for 100% reservation of the foodgrains and 20% of sugar to be compulsorily packed in jute bags.**
- **Reservation for packaging in jute packaging material consumed around 65% of the raw jute produced in the country (in 2022-23).**



## Explanation

- By bringing into effect the provision of JPM Act, the Government will provide relief to 4 lakh workers employed in jute mills and ancillary units as well as support the livelihood of around 40 lakh farm families.
- Besides, it will help protect environment because jute is natural, bio- degradable, renewable and reusable fibre and hence fulfils all sustainability parameters.

- Government of India purchases Jute sacking bags worth approximately Rs. 12,000 crore every year for packing of foodgrains

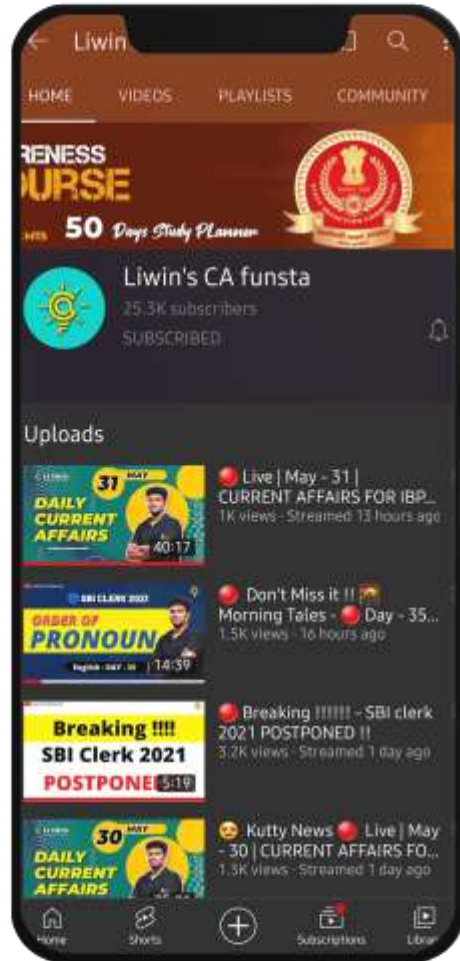
