
Explanation

- From establishing and leading the Indian National Army to forming alliances against the British during World War II, he was among the key figures to lay the foundation for the modern Indian state.






About Subhas Chandra Bose:

- Subhas Chandra Bose was born on 23 January 1897 in Cuttack, Odisha.
- It was in 1921 that he resigned from the Indian Civil Service and returned to India.
- His frequent run-ins with the authorities earned him notoriety as a rebel by the then-British government in India.
- Netaji worked under the mentorship of prominent Congress leader Chittaranjan Das who, along with Motilal Nehru, left the Congress Party to form the Swaraj Party in 1922.
- He started a newspaper called Swaraj and even served as editor of the Forward, a newspaper started by Chittaranjan Das.




About Subhas Chandra Bose:

- In 1923, Netaji was elected the President of the All India Youth Congress Committee and the Secretary of the Bengal State Congress.
- He served as the mayor of Calcutta in 1930 as well.
- In 1942, he formed the Indian National Army in Southeast Asia with the help of Japan, comprising of Indian soldiers the British Indian army captured in war.
- Netaji established a provisional government of Free India or Azad Hind in 1943 in Andaman and Nicobar, then captured by Japanese forces.
- Subhas Chandra Bose is believed to have died in a plane that crashed shortly after take-off.









About Subhas Chandra Bose:

Notably, the title 'Netaji', which means 'Revered Leader' in Hindi, was given to Subhas Chandra Bose by German and Indian officials at the Special Bureau of India in Berlin.

- It was held at Jerez in Andalucía from 1986 to 1990 and since then has enjoyed a long run at the Circuit de Barcelona-Catalunya









- Lachit Borphukan (24 November 1622 25 April 1672) was an Ahom Borphukan, primarily known for commanding the Ahom Army and the victory in the Battle of Saraighat (1671) that thwarted an invasion by the vastly superior Mughal Forces under the command of Ramsingh I.
- He died about a year later in April 1672.
- Lachit Borphukan has emerged as a powerful symbol of Assam's historical autonomy








- He established the world's largest independent mobile ad tech platform, connecting local businesses in UP and India with national and international audiences.







- Karpoori Thakur was the pioneer in providing the Other Backward Classes (OBCs) with the benefit of reservation as he implemented the recommendations of the Mungeri Lal Commission during his tenure as Bihar CM from 1977 to 1979.
- Born in the Samastipur district of Bihar, Karpoori
 Thakur became part of India's freedom struggle
 from a young age.







Explanation

- During the Quit India Movement, he was jailed with other freedom fighters but kept struggling to push the Britishers out of the country.
- Following his initial triumph in 1952, he consistently emerged victorious in every subsequent election.
- Karpoori Thakur actively advocated for the rights of marginalised communities, including scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, and other backward classes.
- His 100th birth anniversary is observed on January 24.









Bharat Ratna:

- The Bharat Ratna is the highest civilian award of the Republic of India.
- Instituted on 2 January 1954, the award is conferred in recognition of "exceptional service/performance of the highest order", without distinction of race, occupation, position, or sex.
- The award was originally limited to achievements in the arts, literature, science, and public services, but the government expanded the criteria to include "any field of human endeavour" in December 2011.
- The recommendations for the Bharat Ratna are made by the Prime Minister to the President, with a maximum of three nominees being awarded per year.







Bharat Ratna:

- The recipients receive a Sanad (certificate) signed by the President and a peepal leaf-shaped medallion. There is no monetary grant associated with the award.
- Bharat Ratna recipients rank seventh in the Indian order of precedence.
- The first recipients of the Bharat Ratna were: the last Governor-General of the Dominion of India and the former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu – C.
 Rajagopalachari, second President and the first Vice President of India – Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan and Nobel Prize Laureate and Physicist C. V. Raman; who were honoured in 1954.



- The award is announced every year on 23rd January, the birth anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose.







- The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 51 lakh and a certificate in case of an institution and Rs. 5 lakh and a certificate in case of an individual.
- For the year 2024, 60 Parachute Field Hospital, Uttar Pradesh, in the Institutional category, has been selected for the Subhash Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskar-2024 for its excellent work in **Disaster Management.**









About winner of the Subhash Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskar:

- 60 Parachute Field Hospital, Uttar Pradesh, was established in 1942.
- It is the sole airborne medical establishment of the Indian Armed Forces, recognized for its exceptional service in various global crisis.
- The primary mission includes Humanitarian
 Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) operations
 during natural calamities, nationally and
 internationally, both in time of peace and war.
- It had provided medical assistance during the Uttarakhand floods (2013), Nepal Earthquake under the operation name 'Maitri' (2015) and Indonesian Tsunami as part of operation Samudra Maitri (2018).







About winner of the Subhash Chandra Bose Aapda Prabandhan Puraskar:

- Recently, in response to the 7.8 magnitude earthquake in Turkey and Syria in February 2023, the unit rapidly assembled a 99-member team and established India's pioneering level-2 medical facility in Turkey overcoming resource constraints and language barrier to set up a 30 bed hospital in Hatay province's school building.
- The unit provided a wide range of medical services, including rescue, triage, surgery, dental treatment, X Ray and lab facilities and offered care to 3600 patients during a 12 day period as a part of 'Operation Dost'.



- The World Health Organization (WHO) has certified Cabo Verde as a malaria-free country, marking a significant achievement in global health.
- A total of 43 countries and 1 territory have now been certified as malaria-free.
- Cabo Verde is the third country to be certified in the WHO African region, joining Mauritius and Algeria which were certified in 1973 and 2019 respectively.
- Malaria burden is the highest on the African continent, which accounted for approximately 95% of global malaria cases and 96% of related deaths in 2021.



- Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) has received approval from the Petroleum and Natural Gas Ministry for the formation of a subsidiary company for green energy and gas business.
- The subsidiary will engage in businesses related to green hydrogen, hydrogen blending, renewable energy including solar, wind and hybrid, bio-fuels and bio-gas business and liquefied natural gas (LNG).
- The board of directors of ONGC also proposed the name of the subsidiary company as 'ONGC Green Limited'.








- The proposed name of the company is 'ONGC Green Limited' subject to the approval of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Govt. of India.
- The ONGC board also gave its in-principle nod for the formation of a joint venture with NTPC Green Energy Limited (NGEL).
- The joint venture shall be engaged in the business of offshore wind energy and other renewal energy.








Note:

- ONGC's overseas investment unit ONGC Videsh received a five-year \$420 million loan from DBS Bank and Bank of Baroda.
- The new loan is the refinancing of a \$500 million loan ONGC Videsh had received in 2019 for a project in Mozambique.







ONGC:

- The Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) is an Indian central public sector undertaking under the ownership of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Government of India.
- The company is headquartered in New Delhi.
- ONGC was founded on 14 August 1956 by the Government of India.
- It is the largest government-owned-oil and gas explorer and producer in the country and produces around 70 percent of India's domestic production of crude oil and around 84 percent of natural gas.
- In November 2010, the Government of India conferred the Maharatna status to ONGC.

- The Union government has decided to make study materials for all courses under school and higher education available in digital form in Indian languages included in the 8th Schedule of the Indian Constitution to provide an opportunity to students to study in their mother tongue.
- For this, an Artificial Intelligence-based 'Anuvadini' app has been created.
- The University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), and the Department of School Education have also been instructed to take steps in this regard concerning schools and universities in the state.







- Ministry of Education has directed all school and higher education regulators like UGC, AICTE, NCERT, NIOS, IGNOU, and heads of institutions of national importance like IITs, CUs, and NITs to make study materials of all courses available in Indian languages within the next three years.
- The Union and state governments have been working in this direction for the last two years by translating the books of engineering, medical, law, undergraduate, postgraduate, and skill courses through an artificial intelligence-based app called 'Anuvadini'.







- These books are available on the e-Kumbh portal.
- Even in the school education ecosystem, study materials are available in more than 30 Indian languages on the Diksha portal.
- Competitive exams like JEE, NEET, and CUET are also conducted in 13 Indian languages."
















Note:

- As of July 31, 2023, only 2.2 GW (1 GW is 1,000 MW) worth of rooftop installations were reportedly installed in Indian homes, according to information presented to the Lok Sabha.
- The government, since 2010, has been claiming to install 100 GW by 2022 — 60 GW from utility project (mega concentrated solar parks) and 40 GW from rooftop solar.
- So far, about 56 GW has been installed in the utilities (July 2023) and 12 GW in rooftops.


- Rooftop solar installations include panels in offices and homes.
- Of the nearly 12 GW of rooftop solar installations as of July 2023, about 87% are "non-residential", according to a report by JMK Research.
