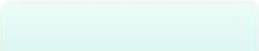

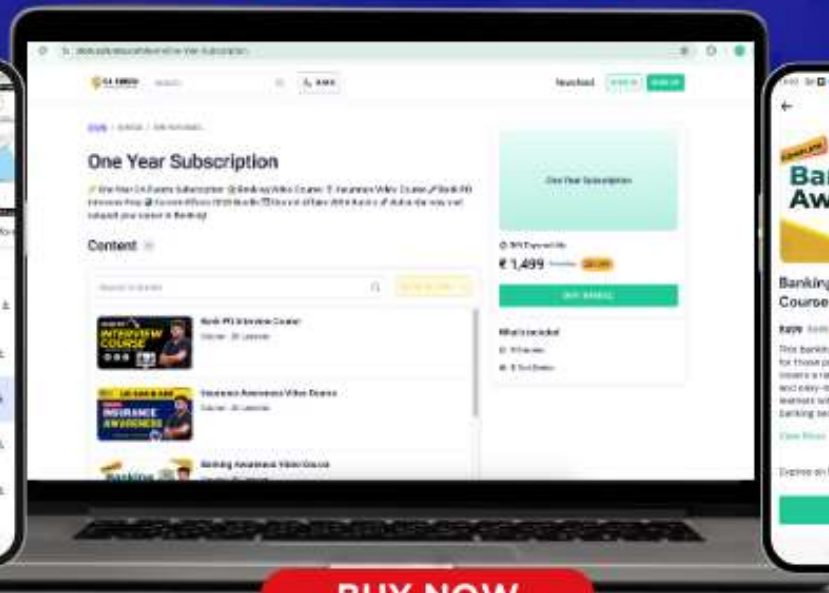

- **Why in the News?**
 - According to IQAir’s World Air Quality Report 2024, 13 out of the 20 most polluted cities in the world are in India, with Bynirhat (Meghalaya) being the most polluted city globally.
 - Delhi remains the most polluted capital for the sixth consecutive year.



RANKING



Global and National Pollution Rankings:

Event and Location:

- **Event:** Ukraine Tops Global Arms Imports, India Ranks Second – SIPRI Report
- **Why in the News?**
 - According to the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) Arms Transfers Report (2020-24), Ukraine became the world's largest arms importer, while India ranked second.
 - Ukraine's arms imports increased nearly 100 times compared to 2015-19, driven by the ongoing Russia-Ukraine war.



Key Findings of SIPRI's Report:

1. Global Arms Import Rankings (2020-24):

- **Ukraine** – World's largest arms importer, accounting for 8.8% of global arms imports.
- **India** – Second-largest arms importer, reflecting security concerns over China and Pakistan.
- **Pakistan** – Ranked among the top 10 importers, with a 61% increase in arms imports from 2015-19 to 2020-24.
- **China** – Dropped out of the top 10 arms importers list for the first time since 1990-94.



Key Findings of SIPRI's Report:

2. Key Trends in Arms Imports:

- European arms imports increased by 155% due to security concerns from Russia's invasion of Ukraine.
- Arms imports by NATO European members more than doubled between 2015-19 and 2020-24.
- East Asian arms imports declined by 22%, with Japan as the only major East Asian state increasing its imports.



Key Findings of SIPRI's Report:

3. India's Arms Imports:

- India's imports declined by 9.3% compared to 2015-19, but it remained the second-largest importer.
- Russia remains India's largest arms supplier, though the share has reduced.
- India received the largest share of France's arms exports, nearly twice the amount received by all European recipients combined.

4. Pakistan's Arms Imports:

- Pakistan's arms imports increased by 61% compared to 2015-19.
- China accounted for 81% of Pakistan's arms imports, up from 74% in 2015-19.



Global Arms Export Rankings (2020-24):

1. Largest Arms Exporters:

- **United States:** Increased its share of global arms exports to 43% (from 35% in 2015-19).
- **France:** Became the second-largest arms exporter, overtaking Russia.
- **Russia:** Fell to third place, with its arms exports declining by 64% due to the Ukraine war and sanctions.
- **China:** Ranked fourth with 5.9% of global arms exports, but faced limited buyers due to political reasons.



Global Arms Export Rankings (2020-24):

2. Key Export Trends:

- France's arms exports to European nations tripled between 2015-19 and 2020-24, mainly due to combat aircraft deliveries to Greece and Croatia.
- The US supplied 64% of NATO Europe's arms imports, reflecting Europe's growing reliance on US defense supplies.



Strategic Impact of the Report:

1. Ukraine's Dependence on Foreign Arms:

- 35+ countries supplied arms to Ukraine after the 2022 Russian invasion.
- US, Germany, and Poland were the top suppliers of weapons to Ukraine.

2. India's Defense Modernization:

- Shift towards diversification in arms procurement, including increased purchases from France, Israel, and the US.
- Continued focus on Atmanirbhar Bharat (Self-Reliant India) in defense production.



Strategic Impact of the Report:

3. Decline of Russia's Arms Exports:

- Russia's declining exports indicate a shift in global defense procurement trends.
- India, China, and Kazakhstan accounted for two-thirds of Russia's exports in 2020-24.

4. China's Declining Arms Imports:

- China dropped out of the top 10 arms importers list for the first time since 1990-94.
- Many nations avoid buying Chinese arms for political reasons.

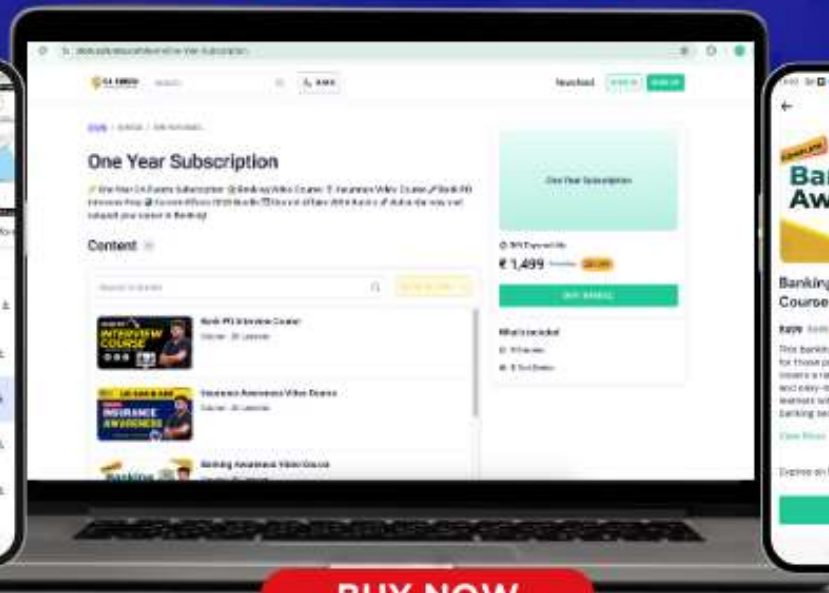
