- Tirumala Hills and Erra Matti Dibbalu in Andhra Pradesh have been added to UNESCO's Tentative List of World Heritage Sites in 2025.
- The Rabi Abhiyan 2025 Conference began on 15 September in New Delhi to chart India's agricultural strategy for the 2025–26 Rabi season.



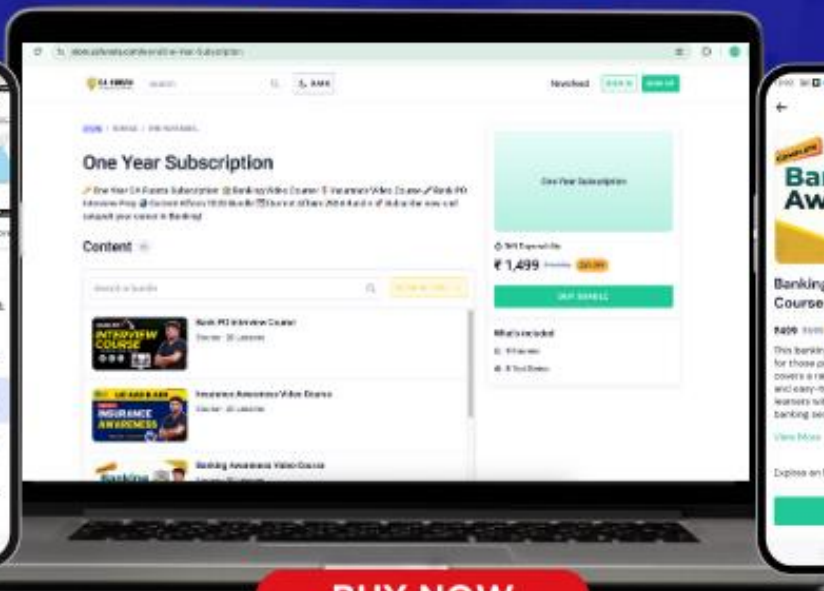
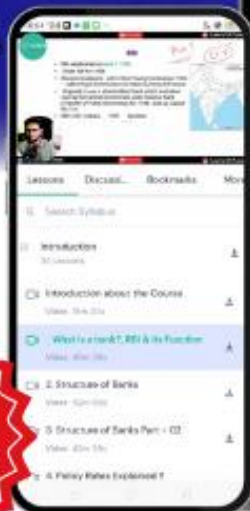


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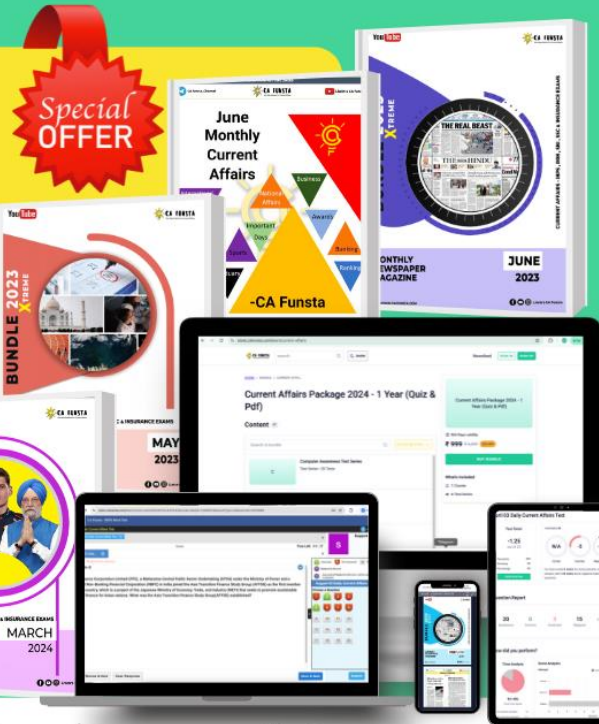


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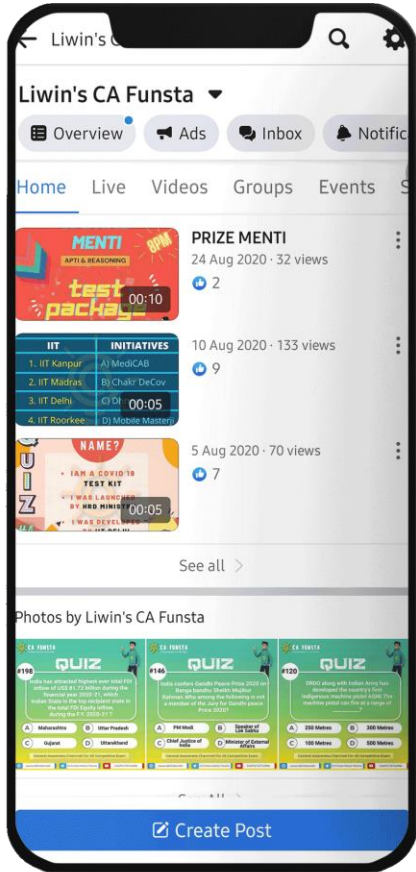
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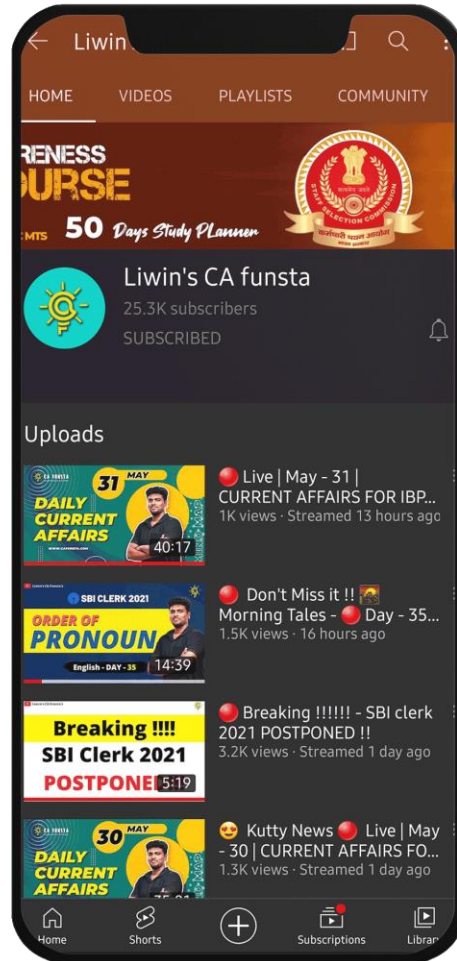


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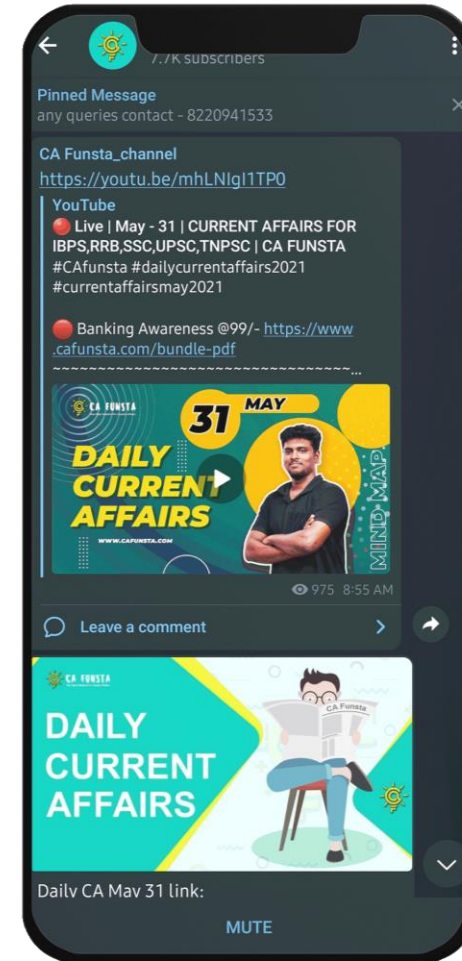
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
