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






Mandates and Objectives:

- **Mandates:** The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) observed World Food Day 2025 with the theme "Hand in Hand for Better Foods and a Better Future". India also commemorated the day by showcasing its national initiatives and food security achievements.
- **Objectives:** To promote awareness around food security, nutrition, and sustainable agriculture, while encouraging collective action to eliminate hunger and malnutrition globally and within India.







- World Food Day: Observed annually on October 16 to commemorate the founding of the FAO in 1945, aiming to highlight global food and nutrition issues.
- National Food Security Mission (NFSM): Launched in 2007–08 to boost rice, wheat, and pulses production; renamed National Food Security & Nutrition Mission (NFSNM) in 2024–25 to also focus on nutrition.
- National Food Security Act (NFSA), 2013: Provides subsidized food grains to 81.35 crore people in India, covering 75% of the rural and 50% of the urban population.







- Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY): Offers free food grains to NFSA beneficiaries; extended from 2024 to 2028 with an outlay of ₹11.80 lakh crore.
- **PM POSHAN Scheme:** Formerly Mid-Day Meal scheme, provides nutritious cooked meals to children in government and aided schools to boost attendance and nutrition.
- Rice Fortification Initiative: Government-led plan to provide fortified rice (with Iron, Folic Acid, Vitamin B12) through welfare schemes, now universalized under central schemes till December 2028.









- SMART-PDS: Scheme to modernize PDS using technology like biometric authentication, ePoS devices, Aadhaar seeding, and supply chain digitization.
- One Nation, One Ration Card (ONORC): Allows nationwide portability of ration benefits ensuring convenience for migrant workers.
- Open Market Sales Scheme (Domestic) [OMSS-D]:
 Facilitates sale of surplus grains (wheat, rice) in the open market to control prices and ensure affordability.










- Mission for Aatmanirbharta in Pulses: Launched in October 2025 to boost domestic pulse production with an ₹11,440 crore budget to enhance selfreliance and farmer income.
- World Food India 2025: A global event to position India as a food processing and export hub, organized by the Ministry of Food Processing Industries.
- Indian Thali WWF Recognition: Recognized by WWF's Living Planet Report for being nutritious, sustainable, and low in ecological impact.

- Mandates: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) intervened in the foreign exchange market, reportedly selling between \$3 billion and \$5 billion in the spot and non-deliverable forward (NDF) segments to arrest the depreciation of the Indian rupee.
- Objectives: To protect the rupee from excessive volatility, maintain macroeconomic stability, and counter adverse market sentiment driven by factors such as weak equity flows, increased gold import demand, and global trade tensions.









- RBI (Reserve Bank of India): India's central bank, responsible for monetary policy, currency stability, foreign exchange management, and ensuring the health of the country's financial system.
- Non-Deliverable Forward (NDF) Market: An offshore derivative market where two parties agree to exchange the difference between the contracted NDF rate and the spot rate on a notional amount. It is often used to speculate or hedge currency risks when capital controls are present.







- Spot Market: A public financial market where financial instruments or commodities are traded for immediate delivery. In FX markets, it refers to the actual exchange of currencies at current market rates.
- Rupee Appreciation: When the value of the Indian rupee rises relative to the US dollar, making imports cheaper and potentially containing inflation.
- Forex Reserve Intervention: The central bank's action of buying or selling foreign currency (usually USD) from its reserves to stabilize the national currency.
