Reason for action	The move followed controversy over the use of “Jagannath Dham” for a temple complex in Digha, West Bengal.
Legal framework	Trademark protection in India is governed by the Trade Marks Act, 1999 and the Trade Marks Rules, 2017.
Next stage	The accepted applications will be published in the Trademark Journal for possible objections.
Cultural significance	Registration would help prevent commercial exploitation and protect the identity and traditions of the Puri Jagannath Temple.
